## Cricket Managers Report

Over the off season the club began work on the priorities of returning A grade to 1st Grade immediately and replacing departing Captain/Coach Laurence Paice, who after 3 years of service enjoyed the season in a playing role only. As always, the club wanted for the rest of our sides to be well captained, balanced and competitive.

In Shane Saxon the club was able to appoint an excellent Captain/Coach from within. Shane has an impressive cricketing resume and from the first training session he impressed in his role as Coach. The playing group responded very well to his leadership and it is to his credit he was able to make the most of this enthusiasm by coaching 4 of the clubs 5 sides to the finals, with 2 winning Premierships.

As Captain Shane led A grade to a very successful season, winning games comprehensively and confirming the Minor Premiership (and automatic promotion to 1st Grade) with 2 rounds remaining before leading the side to a Premiership and completing a dominant season. With a group of players who are 1st grade quality and have tasted 1st grade success we should look to have another successful season next year.

4th Grade was led by first year Captain Jai Thomas who excelled in the role, guiding the side into the finals. Whilst unfortunate to go out in the manner in which they did this was the best year our 2nd side has had for a few years and there were numerous excellent individual performances. 6th Grade made the finals after a slow start to the season before also losing out in the semi-final.

## Gards Year in Review

When asked to summarise our season 2014/15, the common consensus amongst the group after our premiership success & the 4<sup>th</sup> grade's brave effort in coming so close in their semi final.

Hopefully the second grade win was a little bit of comfort for Jai & his boys, given we beat their tormentors Freo-Mossy Park in the 2<sup>nd</sup> grade grand final.

The season was always going to be a challenge to see if we were motivated enough to get up from last season's disappointment.

In other comps where sides are relegated, it isn't always a given that you'll be promoted again after going down a rung. Look at EPL for instance. Many sides remain vanquished & even suffer further relegation through player losses & loss of revenue.

Our challenge was to find someone who could lead us back to the top & find them we did. Shane Saxon is a hardnosed competitor who hates losing & he bought that to our training and preparation on game day. Many a time, I'd arrive for games and see our boys going through warmup drills, with total emphasis on doing it properly. Other clubs are still mucking around or still waiting on blokes to arrive. The Blue Boys work on the old theory – the seven P's – Proper Prior Preparation Prevents Piss Poor Performance!!! We were the best prepared side & it showed with the little things on the field.

As well as Shane, we had other great club leaders in Fab, Hoovs & Daysie, combined with consistent seasoned performers in Omo & Hiten. We got great contributions from new recruit Coatesy who made a couple of great 70's – one at Ocean Ridge after his return from a hammy, when we were chasing a challenging target of 230 plus. He batted with a cool head & kept his partners going to reach the target quite easily. Those sorts of wins set you up, especially after a slightly precarious start when we lost the opening two games to Curtin Vic Park and Swanbourne (the latter game almost resulting in a miracle win, with a makeshift side with several players away at Steve Paice's wedding).

We managed to overcome that hiccup & string several wins together, including an outright at home v Nollamara & near outright wins v FMP & Subi-Marist leaving us top at Christmas and giving ourselves a real foundation to be there at the business end. With Daysie just steamrolling sides & cameo efforts here and there, even when in strife (Sacko a couple of handy 49's down the list, particularly the South Perth game on a shocker of a deck) & the top order all having led by a rejuvenated Fabby opening and getting us off to a flyer a couple of times, enabled us to lay the foundations for solid scores, without being outstanding with the bat. The bowling then answered to the call and Daysie & Hiten were so miserly at times, the opposition simply tried to swing at other bowlers and nicked or found fielders. Timmy, Sacko & new lad Burbs all played their role beautifully and the team harmony was tremendous. With Boat & Stevo swooping on the crumbs like Nat Fyfe swooping on the loose ball in the middle of the MCG, there were no easy runs in the outfield.

The slips cordon held everything, with Hoovs showing lightening reflexes alongside Fabby & Coatesy & Dayesy also good in close. Boat was also Boonie like at short leg all season – if he didn't catch them, he ran blokes out.

We hosted a semi final at Wyong vs Curtin Vic Park and won the all important toss & batted. Important to have runs on the board as Hiten was missing from our attack & we needed to give our bowlers a good target to defend. A tremendous opening stand of 84 between Hoovs & Fabby saw us get off to a flyer, before 3 wickets fell quickly for 98. The experience of Daysie showed when he put together a handy partnership with Smithy who made only 4, but hung in there with his partner. We were 5/177 when Stevo was run out and then lost Sacko for 2. Daysie was out for 49 before Burbs fell on the final ball of the innings after he and Maunee both had a swing and we ended up 9/200 from our 80 overs.

CVP got off to a cautious start before we struck three quick blows through Daysie & Sacko to have the Redbacks 3/26. They were 4/55 when Maunek got Brookes LBW and when Daysie removed top scorer De Silva for 38 they were a precarious 5/89. Pontague then nicked Daysie to Hoovs & they were rapidly disintegrating under our great pressure. We got them 9 down quickly, before their skipper Worthy tried to smash his opposite number Sacko on to Leach Hwy and holed out to super sub Lengy. CVP all out 133 in 57.3 overs – Blues into GF. Daysie 49 & 4/33 – the Gold Tray & Goblets recipient was not difficult to decide on. Special mention to Sacko 3/28 & Timmy 2/18 at great economy.

Without the risk of sounding like bragging, this was my 4<sup>th</sup> top grade GF I'd been involved in at this club and we were going for flag No 3 in 6 years.

As irony would have it we ended up getting Freo Mossy Park in GF. After the events of 4<sup>th</sup> grade we felt we owed it to Jai & his boys to bring this one home for everyone.

We played at Veryard West and won the toss yet again. We were a little under par with the batting on a pitch that did a little. We overcame early wickets to post a few handy partnerships, Fabby the mainstay at the top again with 28 & Daysie continuing on with the bat from semi final to post a top score of 42. We managed a moderate score of 164 in 76.5 overs.

The FMP innings mirrored our's in some ways with wickets going early. Burbs struck second ball to remove Ringsell before Daysie bowled Duffy to have them 2/8. Caddy was hitting everything he could and was trying to win it on his own. He was 61 out of his team score of 66 when he tried to take on Sacko's bullet like arm and was run out.

The boys knew how crucial that was. We quickly had them 5/74 with Daysie & Sacko ripping through the middle & lower order to reduce them to 8/79. Chopping's cameo ended on 28 & then Sacko ripped Smith's middle stump out sparking wild jubilation from our boys. FMP all out 118. Daysie 5/52 – what a finals series. We were cock-a-hoop before they doused the celebrations, saying they were putting us back in. We survived a nervous 43 overs with Caddy delivering a mixture of deliveries to have us 6/64. We were not only going back up, we were taking another flag home with us. Tremendous team effort, led by Daysie as always, but supported by great leaders in Sacko & Fabby, who stood in for a few games as well as leading our T20 side. Hoovs was steady at the top without the burden of the captaincy. We also had Omo, the energy of the team in the field and when running between wickets. Add Stevo in there in his second stint at the club – a more experienced player this time around & a great clubman. Coatesy is a solid no 3 who can hit gaps & prove difficult to bowl to. Matty Smith also overcame injury to give us a few handy innings late in the season. Burbs came off the bench late to prove a real find – a bloke we hope will be opening the bowling with us for years to come. Add Hiten's usual guile (& warped sense of humour), Timmy's handy offies & his great work on the deck again and Maunek – handy allround cricketer who bobbed up with handy wickets & late order hitting in finals.

All in all, it's been a great season. Thanks to all the boys for having us on board again. I'll be back to enjoy us playing in top flight again and to see us show we can still be a force in the WASTCA.

Well done to Steve & the one day boys on their flag—great to share it with you that night. A great effort by all!

It was largely a season of significant highlights for the 4<sup>th</sup> grade side as we had set two key goals in the beginning of the season – to play finals and to be a source of player promotion into the first side. And ultimately we achieved both, but unfortunately still fell short of a dream grand final appearance. The season started with a comfortable victory in a one-dayer against Curtin Vic-Park, in which wily veteran Matty Harmer shone with 4 wickets, and 1<sup>st</sup> grade premiership player Jack Duffy dominated with the bat, and following this the first major test awaited in round 2.

The game against Swanbourne would feature a replacement XI, courtesy of Steve Paice's wedding. With 9 players out and essentially the 6<sup>th</sup> grade side plus Jarrad Sibson playing, the step up for Geoff Dart and co would prove to be a natural one. Batting first and putting up a competitive 185, the highlight was Sibbo's late hitting, featuring some massive sixes in a classy 58 not out, whilst Freigha Hewitt's opening 39 set the platform. Swanbourne lost wickets consistently but rallied in the middle overs to set up a decent finish. Up stepped Sibbo again, this time with the ball, taking two critical wickets and the match-winning catch to have a sensational day on his beloved Wyong Oval. Full credit to Darty and the 6<sup>th</sup> grade team for stepping up without hesitation, and setting up our season with the win.

Round 3 featured a trip to the hapless Nollamara, and early on it became apparent an outright victory was a possibility. We had bowled them out for 55, however shortly after the mother of all hail storms hit the field late on the first day, and the outright from here seemed unlikely. However with a team established game plan on the second day we quickly went 8- runs ahead and sent them back in with 45 overs to bowl. We again took wickets at regular intervals however needed some heroics with overs running tight. Up stepped Mitch Duncan for 3 critical wickets and when the last wicket fell the celebrations were well earned and hearty. A perfect start to the year, but a monumental clash at Wyong the next week loomed.

Ocean Ridge fronted up as a known contender, and winning the toss and electing to bat on a cracking Wyong pitch, what happened next was nothing short of extraordinary. An incredible innings of 117 by the white Brian Lara himself in Christopher Pritchard featured some of the most exquisite stroke play seen at Wyong in recent years. A cameo late innings performance from the man in form Jarrad Sibson got us to 304, his 81 featuring another memorable barrage of sixes. Unfortunately the second day got away from us and we truly felt Ocean Ridge's credentials, as they chased down our score in a major lesson.

The next match away at Fremantle Mosman Park was memorable for only one reason. A club record last wicket partnership between Mitch Duncan and Mauneeek Solanki. When they came together we were 9 for 68, and when Mauneeek was finally dismissed for 64 they had put on 113 runs and regained our lost credibility. Mitch's 42 not out being a career high and full of class.

So 2 losses in a row and the 4s needed to respond. Things were not going to plan away to Subi Marist, slumping to 6/62 at tea. Being not out at the break, I was able to deliver a stinging assessment of the situation and to the boys credit we rallied to 130, myself scratching around for 63. Subi Marist had shown fight to get to 3 for 80 and we needed to find hero. The man that stood up was none other than Mauneeek Solanki, an incredible spell of stump to stump bowling earning him 5 lbws in his 6/32 and once again celebrations at taking the final wicket were simply remarkable. Debutant Yagan Walley lit up the second innings with a whirlwind 44 not out.

Back at home to South Perth, the match would feature the debut of two cracking new recruits, fast bowler Pete Burbridge and batsman Richard Walley. Electing to bowl first, Dan Cheeseman and Pistol Pete got us off to a great start and whilst they laboured through their innings we were able to dismiss them late for 112. A solid 42 from Steven Daye got us close to their target, and when Richard Walley joined me with the win sealed we were able to cash in in junk time, Richard smashing a quick 55 not out and myself finishing 100 not out. We were starting to sense that there was something special about the group we had assembled.

An excellent one day win against Kalamunda featured an unbroken 130 run partnership with Chris Pritchard (77 not out) and Steven Paice (44 not out), whilst a week later victory was much tighter, Yagan Walley hitting 50 but needing late runs from Dan Cheeseman, himself having taken 4 wickets including an amazing feat of two wickets of the first two balls of the match. Another win in the bag and we were away to Swanbourne.

In another incredible bowling display, they went from 0-19 to all out 43, Mauneek and myself with 4 wickets each and eyeing a win on the first day. Richard Walley stepped up with 58 and we again declared, this time 100 runs ahead. Swanbourne put up a much better fight in the second innings, but Mauneek Solanki taking 5 for the dig to total 9 for the match reduced them to a lead of only 13, something we polished off in under two overs. Another outright in the bag and home again to Curtin Vic Park.

An unremarkable match, we got the job done, the highlight being Leigh Martin's amazing one handed catch at short cover. In all we rolled them for 89, but needed Dan Cheeseman to again hit the winning runs, this time at 9 down. The final two rounds would feature a trip to Kalamunda and a visit from Western Suburbs. We took care of Kalamunda with ease, myself bowling way too many overs for 6 wickets and cashing in for 61 runs. Other highlights included Chris Pritchard's fine 49 and Yagan Walley hitting a brilliant 54. The next match against Western Suburbs saw us bat first in fine conditions, posting 184 on a tricky pitch with 88 from the captain and a great cameo from Cal McMulkin. However a major storm the next week prevented a result, and we went into finals in second place.

Unfortunately, disappointing and unclear rules from the Association had us playing the final away to third placed Fremantle Mosman Park, instead of a neutral venue as we had expected. Still backing ourselves in we had elected to bat and a very good early partnership from Steven Daye and Steven Paice had us in a reasonable position. Unfortunately regular wickets on a woefully slow outfield had us dismissed for 100. In true style we fought out the day, taking 2 late wickets to give ourselves a chance. The next day's bowling was very close to perfect, reducing them to 9/83 with victory insight. Unfortunately a brazen innings from their number 11 proved the hardest wicket to get, FMP taking victory by the narrowest of margins.

It was a very bitter loss, with the difficulty in dealing with the association during the week sapping our energy before the match had begun and unsavoury on field incidents further marring the event. In all, what had been such an overwhelmingly positive season had come to an end in a way that was undeserving, however at the end of the day an extra 30 runs with the bat would have been the difference.

In reflecting on the season, I have to say it was a missed opportunity. Early on I had felt that we had assembled a special group of players, with the belief and enjoyment in playing as a side the key ingredient to our on field success. We simply relished the contest as a group and I can say I am truly proud of the way we went about each match. A variety of characters, we were indebted to the experience of Matty Harmer and Tony Magill, two legendary club members that we were truly privileged to play alongside.

A major reason for our success was the input of the senior group, led by Steven Daye and Jarrad Sibson and supported by Chris Pritchard, Leigh Martin and Steve Paice. These guys have played in winning flags together and as a group were the heart and soul of the side, incredible mates to play alongside and a great foundation for our side. To Stevie D and Sibbo particularly, as my vice captain and deputy vice captain, their passion for the side and enthusiasm for tactical discussions made captaincy a joy. If we can group together in 2015/16, then further success will be likely.

A massive thanks to all the guys that gave their all for the side when required, Mauneek Solanki, Cal McMulkin and Dan Cheeseman especially.



Finally, it would be remiss of me to not thank the support base through the year and the people behind the scenes. To Timmy for preparing the pitch with countless hours, and to Michelle for tolerating it, we are all indebted. To Peta Paice, for attending week after week regardless of the temperature gauge, your support was invaluable. To Brian Hayward, Geoff Dart and Shane Saxon as the section committee, I always enjoyed selection meetings and the ability to test each other's thinking was a huge bonus as captain. And to Greg Dart as president, and Ace as secretary, you guys did a great job supporting us through the year.

Last of all I would like to thank my lovely wife Candice, and my little man Flynn, for supporting me to take on the captaincy and being an incredible cricket wife, at times cricket widow, for the summer. Your support for me to be able to captain a side for the club that I love, with patience and tolerance, was amazing and truly appreciated. I will now hand over the reins of captaincy to the next candidate, a growing family and bowling myself too many overs this year will see my role reduce in 15/16, but my enthusiasm shall remain.

The next round we played the team above us and a solid display with bat, ball and in the field saw us get the win. Batting first we made 255 before bowling the opposition out for 150 and then hitting 1/50 in the second innings.

Buoyed by this we headed into the game before the break knowing that we needed to win to stay in touch with the top four. This game was played in tribute to the memory of Vaelen Hewitt and it was an honour for all of the guys, especially close friends, to be able play with Glen Hewitt in this game. After a respectable effort with the ball we batted to our game plan and were able to comfortably chase down 185 on a long, slow ground.

Resuming after the break we began with a dominant 7 wicket win setup by Chris Lockyer's 5/7 before losing in the last over after an excellent effort defending 125.

By this point in the season the side was starting to settle and we were playing consistently good cricket as we took on 3rd placed Subiaco Marist. However, we had our worst day of the season in the field as we struggled to get wickets regularly and ended up going for 235. The following week Ed Daquino led the way with a brilliant 124, easily our best individual performance this season, as we chased their score 6 wickets down and exercised some demons after our loss to them in last years Grand Final.

We won our next 2 one day games comprehensively, the second of which put us in to the four before losing to top of the ladder Bedford Morley in a tight game. Heading into the last round we were all but guaranteed finals and after making 155 we bowled the opposition out for 130 to finish the season in 3rd, winning 7 from 9 at the end of the season to do so.

Due to our recent good form we were quietly confident heading into the semi final against Curtin Vic Park. Bowling first we restricted them to 4/69 from 42 overs before they pressed on to 196. After the first day both sides would have been happy with their effort, we had bowled and fielded to a finals level and they had batted solidly against our attack.

Going into day 2 we knew that if we batted in partnerships and kept wickets in hand we would be able to chase down their score toward the end of our innings. Unfortunately we were unable to do this as Curtin Vic Park rose to the occasion and played to a level we hadn't faced throughout the season, having us 5/40 before dismissing us for 130. To know that we didn't bat to our potential as a team and as individuals is incredibly frustrating and shows the difference in pressure from a regular game to finals.

Whilst no consolation Curtin Vic Park were the better side throughout the 2 days cricket and were ultimately Premiers of our grade. Throughout the season we were able to beat the sides around us but never managed to knock off the top 2 so to finish 3rd was a fair reflection of our performance. All things considered, finishing strongly and playing finals after a slow start provided a satisfying end to the season.

There were numerous notable individual performances over the season, in particular Ed Daquino's 386 runs @ 42.89 and Chris Lockyer's 33 wickets @ 10.64. Along with his ever reliable bowling Blair Chapman emerged as a solid opener and should look to continue next season, he and Ed averaged 39 as a pair and set the side up in numerous games. Cam McNab also impressed, he filled holes in the batting order from week to week with no fuss and was able to contribute consistently while his bowling improved greatly over the season. UJ Bahn was another who did well, his continual improvement over the season saw his best performance come in the semi final and he has shown he can lead an attack. Regular contributors Justin and Paul Warren, Glen Hewitt, Culver Chappelle, Mike Vlismas and Tony Magill all did their things at various stages and played the solid, reliable roles the side has come to expect from them.

To finish off I'd like to thank all the guys that played in the team for their efforts and to say I hope you enjoyed the season as much as I did. I'd also like to thank Justin and Paul Warren for their input and support both on and off the field this season, as always you made my job a lot easier.
