## 1<sup>st</sup> Grade Report

Expectation for the First Grade side was high on the back of a premiership in 2012-2013. The side we had assembled over 3 years had gone all the way and it was time to get back to business and concentrate on getting into the finals again. Little did we know the turn that 2013-2014 would take.

Tom Allin decided to move down the road to play with his good English mate at Western Suburbs. He was the only loss from our squad of the Premiership Year. We also added the services of former club champion Chris Prescott as Head Coach/Leader of our Bowling attack, and Michael Bates as our English Import. On paper, our side looked tremendous.

Round 1 saw us pitted against newly elevated Bedford Morley. We bowled first and reduced them to a respectable 192 in a rain affected game. In tough batting conditions, we were rolled for 115 with Brendan Daye leading the charge with a tough 32. A heavy first up loss against an eventual finalist.

Round 2 sent us to Rosalie to play Western Suburbs in a 40/40 match. We bowled the opposition out for a low score of 76. Hiten Shah starred with an unbelievable spell of 8 over's, 5 maidens 3 for 3 with 3 wides..... so not one run off the bat! Incredible scenes! We chased the runs 4 down within 21 overs with Bates scoring an unbeaten 40.

In a horror run of losses, we then proceeded to lose the next 4 games leading into Christmas. This all but destroyed our finals chances and turned our attention from Premiership Defence to avoiding relegation. A goal we would not succeed in achieving. Mentions must go to Bates, who was our top scorer in 3 of these 4 matches, Hiten Shah, Prescott, and Brendan Daye.

Our problems were compounded significantly at Christmas as Club Coach and Leading Bowler Chris Prescott quit under questionable circumstances and was cleared to play for Midland Guildford. A loss we desperately didn't need considering our poor standing. Further, All Rounder Shane Saxon would not play any further part in First Grade cricket after sustaining a knee injury. He was only able to bowl in one match leading into Christmas. This robbed us of two of our best 3 seam bowlers. A void nearly impossible to fill.

We fought our way to a commanding position against Tuart Hill in Round 7. After rolling them for 193 (Shah 3 wickets, Daye 3 wickets, D'Souza 2) we were cruising with the bat at 4/151 with Matty Smith (51) and Omo Fanayan (42) dominating the attack on a delicious Wyong pitch. However, 20 minutes of bad cricket saw us stumble horribly and be all out for 170. A heartbreaking loss on our home deck.

The close losses would continue to come as we lost to arch rival and eventual premier High Wycombe in Round 8. Batting first, we posted a respectable 218 on the back of a brilliant 71 from Matty Smith. On Day 2, we reduced HW to 6/123 and had the game by the scruff of the neck. Minus Hiten Shah, we were putting in a brave performance against a class opposition. The next hour twisted and turned and in the end, HW passed our score 9 down with ex state champion Peter Worthington simply brilliant with 88no.

Mitch Duncan announced himself as a genuine First Grade bowler with 3/27 in his debut match. 31 overs from Daye saw him net a well earned 4 wicket haul and Timmy D'Souza bowled brilliantly for his 3/57 from 24 overs.

We then had our second win of the season against Wembley. Batting first, we hit our batting target of 240+ for the first time in the season. A stat in itself that outlines the poor showing by our batting group. An amazingly even contribution from Bates (41) Daye (39) O Fanayan (49) and F Fanayan (49) guided us to 9/254. We were on top for the entirety of Day 2 and bowled WD out for 144. Hiten Shah the chief destroyer with 4/49, supported by two wickets each for Daye, Duncan and Thomas. Mitch Duncan followed this up with another 2 wickets in the second innings, where we attempted to push for an unlikely outright result.

Murdoch Melville was our opponent in Round 10. Bowling first, we restricted the eventual runner up to 206. B. Daye spun his magic for a simply magical 4/54 from 29 over's. Shah added another 2 wickets to his growing tally and Duncan added 1.

We then had to bat on a wet wicket on day 2 and were reeling at 3-4, 4-43 and 5-58. Smith was magnificent again with 68 as we went down by 81 runs in a match that we would later unsuccessfully appeal.

The final match was a win at Wyong against Bassendean. We posted 173 batting first, led again by 47 from Smith. 30 each from Duffy and Daye saw us post a competitive score.

We delivered with the ball, on the back of 5-36 from Hiten Shah, 2-25 from Mitch Duncan and 2-41 from Brendan Daye. Bowling Bassendean out for 109, we had ended the season on a good note. However, it was not enough for us to sneak into 10<sup>th</sup> spot and avoid relegation. Bentley will be playing 2<sup>nd</sup> Division in 2014-2015.

In any season, there are always outstanding performances. Michael Bates' 273 runs in 9 matches carried our batting pre Christmas and although he would have liked a few more 'big scores', his contributions stood out whilst he was here.

Matty Smiths 335 runs were also outstanding. The thing about Smithys season is that 261 of these runs came in the 5 games after Christmas at an average of 52. Talk about standing up in the crunch! Well done big man.

Hiten Shah and Brendan Daye both ended up with 25 wickets for the season. These two have toiled away for this club for nearly 10 seasons now and their efforts this year were huge. Outstanding.

However, the highlight of the season for mine was the emergence of Mitch Duncan as a new ball bowler in the top grade. Mitch took 13 wickets in his 4 first grade games and brought a spirit and energy to the side that was lacking before his introduction. His outswingers baffled some of the competitions best players and whilst he is only a youngster, his future at Bentley is very bright. Well done youngster!!!

I'll also take the opportunity to congratulate Steve Shearing on captaining his side to a premiership this season. You assembled and led the side seamlessly Stevo. Congrats!

To Geoff Dart, congrats on a very good season. As tough as the season ended, it will prime your group for the next time you are there and you will prosper as a result mate. Well done.

It's with sadness that this will be my last report as club captain. It feels wrong to stand down following such a poor season, however I can categorically say that the decision was made well before the season ended. After 4 seasons, it's time for someone else to step up and have a dip at leading this great club into the next exciting phase, and I'll be there as a soldier to whoever is appointed to fill my boots. Hopefully I can contribute with a few runs next season!

The 'Thank You's' are almost endless and I'll look to do these personally. The people that have helped me will all know who they are, and I'll never forget the 4 years we have shared together. It's been a ride I'll never forget.

In closing, let's tackle the next phase as a chance to take stock, consolidate, develop our batch of talented youngsters, and come back into First Grade a stronger, more intimidating cricket club! We will come out the end of this a stronger unit, and a unit equipped to conquer any challenge thrown our way. True character shines through when times are at their toughest. And no one can question the character of this great club
