FROM THE PRESIDENT

As yet another season ends, and as President I prepare yet another article for the Bentley Cricketer Yearbook, it has struck me that this year's article will be in sharp contrast to previous themes. In essence, in previous years I was always obliged to look optimistically to the future. I would focus on the young cricketers with potential at the club, or on our reasonably healthy financial position that would be a springboard to the future. Whilst this optimism for the future is still valid, this year I am happily able to reflect more on the very real achievements of the past season, rather than on what might be in the future. Certainly a nice change!

On the field the club has been brilliantly led by Steve Shearing and the respective Grade Captains. A telling statistic that we can all take pride in is Bentley's performance in finishing 3rd of 24 clubs in the Association Champion Club Award. What makes this statistic all the more remarkable is that the club finished 24th in 1992/93 & 21st in 1993/94.

History will record that in 1994/95 Bentley's senior team won its most games in a season for 9 years, whilst the 2nd and 3rd teams were both Minor Premiers. Added to this our 4th team, finished runner-up after finishing a tantalising 7 runs short of Grand Final success. All in all a year to be proud of, but one that has no doubt increased the resolve of all players to take that next step next year.

Off the field the achievements may not have been as dramatic as those on field, but they augur well for the future. The Management Committee underwent its first major structural change since the 1970's and now reflects an organisation which is able to deal quickly with the issues that confront it. In addition a 3rd training net was built at Wyong Oval and further ground improvements are under consideration.

Also of significance is that our club now plays a central role in the administration of the Canning Sports Club and I expect some very real benefits to flow on to us from that participation. During the season a close working relationship was forged for the first time with the Canning Football Club and I am hopeful that this relationship will be mutually beneficial in the future.

All in all, not quite a great year, but a very good year all the same. In closing I would like to pass on my thanks to everyone who has made a contribution to the Administration of the club this year. I look forward to seeing you all again in August.

Grade Winners

The 4th Grade began the season in emphatic fashion by winning their first 8 games and subsequently finished on top of the ladder at the conclusion of the qualifying fixtures. An end of season slump saw the team struggle over the last 4 games, culminating in a disappointing semi-final loss.

The highlight of the season, was undoubtedly the 229 run opening partnership between Greg Sheppard and Simon Magill against Girrawheen. With both players scoring centuries, Sheppy 154 and Simon 111, the partnership was the highest for any Grade in the 41 year history of the Club.

Batting was the strength of this team and apart from the century makers six others scored in excess of 200 runs for the season. Ian Dickerson batting in the lower order was outstanding and received solid support from Steve Thorpe, Brian Hayward, Andrew Hayward, Matt Harmer and Ron Fernandez.

All-rounders Ace and Dicko completed a fine season by being the leading wicket takers in a steady 4th Grade attack. They were ably supported by medium pacers Paul Murphy and Mark Lukan, whilst spinner Greg Sheppard from limited opportunities was also prominent.

In the field keeper Matt Harmer was solid and consistent whilst out fielder Steve Thorpe pulled off a number of sensational catches.

Grade Winners

Three outright victories and a string of first innings wins saw the 8th Grade finish clearly (about 17 points) on top of the ladder and earn promotion to 7th Grade next season. Defeat in the semi-final saw an early and surprise exit from the team that had played so consistantly throughout the year.

There were two outstanding highlights for the season, one the maiden century by the veteran Lloyd Dungey (after 316 games) against Melville and the other by rookie Jamie George with the sensational bowling figures of 10/26 (5/14 and 5/12) in the match against Applecross.

Skipper Peter Quartermaine led the batting (over 300 runs) throughout the season, whilst newcomers Rob Bennett and Kirk Spencer and middle order batsman Brendon Kelly were consistant performers.
