## T20 Charity Match

*Excerpt from the Canning Examiner*

Two of Wyong Reserve's long-time sporting clubs came together on the weekend to support charitable causes close to both clubs.

Counselor Graham Barry and Mayor Patrick Hall were in attendance to see the Bentley "Legends" team take on the Canning Tigers in a curtain raiser to the WASTCA Division 1 T20 match played in the afternoon between Bentley CC and cross-town rivals Curtin Victoria Park CC

The Canning Tigers fielded a competitive team, whereas Bentley skipper Chris Lockyer selected a more diverse range of current and former players. Indeed, the Tigers went on to prove they can play the "gentleman's game". Having won the toss and electing to bat, the Tigers batsman hit boundaries seemingly at will to amass 140 runs from their allotment of overs. Such a target was always going to be a tough ask for the Legends to chase, particularly with the accurate bowling and superb fielding on display from the young Tigers side. Bentley finished their innings all out for 104. Glenn Hewitt presented the Vaelan Hewitt memorial trophy to the Canning Tigers and congratulated them on their win.

At 3pm the 'real' cricketers commenced their game when Bentley won the toss and elected to bat against Curtin Vic Park. Bentley opener Awais Mehdi proceeded to delight the large contingent of spectators with an explosive display of clean hitting, smashing 123 from 59 balls including 9 fours and 10 sixes. Mehdi's innings saw Bentley finish their 20 overs at 4/189, setting an imposing target of 190 for Curtin Vic Park. Both BCC opening bowlers struck early with Mitchell Crew and Zain Ul-Hassan taking a wicket each and containing the runs to make a hard task for the CVP batsmen look even more difficult. First changers in skipper Brendan Daye and Laurence Paice also struck within a few overs to see Curtin Vic Park in trouble at 4/61. A further bowling change saw spinner Craig Stephenson brought on from the Wyong Road end, who proceeded to confound the opposition's lower order. His figures of 5/9 (4 overs) setting a new best bowling figures record for the club in a T20, matching Mehdi's highest BCC T20 score record set earlier in the afternoon as Curtin Vic Park finished at 9/113.

Charitable funds raised from a bat raffle, sausage sizzle, bouncy castle and afternoon tea will be donated to SIDS and Fight MND, the nominated charities for BCC and CTFC respectively.

Both clubs would like to thank the City of Canning for their ongoing support in this annual event and the attendance by elected representatives is always appreciated. Chris Lockyer as a member of both sporting clubs was instrumental in the success of the day.

Season 2019/20 was certainly 'historic' in more ways than one for the Bentley Cricket Club. The top XI's achievement finishing the regular season minor premiers and 'grade champions' for the first time was within the space of a few days elevated to major premier status and so awarded the coveted 1st grade pennant thanks to the abrupt end of cricket Australia wide. This club proudly nails it's third top grade premiership to the wall but the whistful thoughts linger of 'what could have been' had a grand final win played out on the last Sunday in March, shadows stretching long over a resplendent Wyong late in the golden afternoon.

Our season 2019/20 success can be placed firmly at the feet of our coach, the great man DT. His influence on the group and top side saw training and on-field standards improve to the level required of the team finishing top of the ladder. It was also DT's connections that saw us recruit one of the best overseas imports for a number of years in all-rounder Zain Ul-Hassan, eventual winner of the Peter Gayle Memorial Trophy for best colt's player in the WASTCA 1<sup>st</sup> grade. The recruitment of batsman Manuel Hunwick formerly of Bedford-Morley and opening quick Mitch Crew from South Perth added to the injection of youth for the top side. This with the enormous combined experience of captain Daye, Paice, Fanayan, Shah, Horan, Duffy and Palumbo was the perfect blend and the return of Yahya and Awais for their second season in Bentley colours only strengthened the XI. Bentley's 1<sup>st</sup> grade team was rightly lauded as the benchmark for the competition by WASTCA Chairman Brad Pearce early in the season and with such quality players fronting up week after week it was never in doubt they would find themselves 'in the mix' come the end of the year.

The long arm of Alex 'Turtle' Jerrard seems to have brought more new players to the club than anyone else's in recent years and the Hay Park CC product did not dissappoint in his efforts for 2019/20. Mitch Crew, Jarrod Keron and Rex McCormack this season adding to the likes of Blake Melvin, Rory McGarry and Elliot Barton: an injection of youth the club has been in sore need of. Josh Italiano was also the golden find of the summer, after one net session under the watchful eye of DT the selectors were left in no doubt as to where the young batsman should be making his debut on the following Saturday, a match-winning and supremely composed 43 runs in the second XI justified DT's campaigning. But the best was yet to come as just 4 rounds later Italiano made his maiden BCC century with 105\* v Swan Ath up at Lilac. His and Keron's additions to the second team along with speedser Ish 'Dangerous' Khan and another season from Bentley's favourite perennial English son in Craig Stephenson made the 3rd grade side under captain Fab Fanayan an outfit as feared as our top side. With dilemmas aplenty at the selectors table most Thursdays the third side was beneficiary of the bounty of turf experience available for selection.

Several very handy cricketers with great potential were discovered or 'rediscovered' in the third side under Jason Marlborough this year. Ararjit Singh proved what a good eye he has yet again dispatching bowlers to all parts. Rex McCormack the young Broome talent bamboozled batsmen with his succulent leggies, amazed with fielding agility and stunned team mates and opposition alike with often unorthodox and unpredictable batting. Asher Ammad turned matches with both bat and ball, filling the role of match winning all-rounder with aplomb. Under Don 'Keg' McKeig in the 4th side Ijlal Zubair produced one of the more amazing bowling spells seen for many a year in the Chuck Berry game, bowling a marathon 28 overs on the hottest day of the year to take 7/86 and Khizer Khan with his explosive pace caused all sorts of headaches. Daniel 'Fog of War' Foggo showed moments of sparkling brilliance before moving interstate over Christmas. Rex Raju and Clinton McMurray had great improved as the season went on and were valued additions to their sides. Latecomers in Sanket 'Sunny' Ibhrampurkar and Raj Wanzare added great versatility to the One day side captained by club stalwart PC Smith.

A huge thanks to statisticians Tony Magill and Stew Jefferys who copped the 'Obscure stat of the week' queries throughout the season and spent more time than they could probably afford in compiling spreadsheets to satisfy that eclectic and entertaining selection night segment.

A humble thank you to everyone who answered the phone call at or around 7pm on a Thursday night and were able to help us field sides. Jamie and Stevie Riches, Kizza Smith, Mobin Matthew, the indefatigable Stephen Cairns, Freighter Hewitt, Glenn Davies, Rory McGarry, Michael Bowen, Holly, She She from England at one stage and the trio of Reece Coleman, Gordon Naley and Robert Ellis as orchestrated by Josh Ericson one week single-handedly saved us from a forfeit. 19 debutants for the season keeps us in good shape and the work being put into the juniors program now and for the next few years should see a pathway to seniors established that we have sought for so long.

Another season beckons, here we go now...

After making a Semi Final last season, we were optimistic heading into this season that we could go close by the end. There was still a fair bit of improvement in this group coupled with adding a bit of talent in the form of Manuel Hunwick, Mitch Crew and Zain UI-Hassan. We had the tools to get it done but we needed to work hard to get the best out of the group. David Taylor also sticking around for another year as coach was vital for how our season played out.

We entered round one with a good pre-season under our belt and we faced Applecross away. Normally this side is a bogey side to us for some reason but not this game. We ended up posting a pretty good score of 7/173 but it was a bit disappointing after being 0/115. Tim Horan and Yahya Ali shared in a magnificent 1<sup>st</sup> wicket stand which did set the game up for us. Yahya smacking 60 and Horan supporting him 46. We went out to bowl and the game was over quite quickly with Applecross dismissed for 54. Boom recruit Zain UI-Hassan with 4 poles and Mr Consistent Adam Palumbo also chiming in with 4 and it was a clinical victory and a good start to the season.

Round 2 we ventured up to Lilac Hill to face Swan Athletic who again are another side that seem to be an obstacle for us. UI-Hassan and Palumbo fantastic again with the ball with 3 wickets each which helped us contain a potentially massive score. Still when they posted 174 I thought to myself again that for some reason we just can't beat this side. But this group has some real determined cricketers and I quickly realised that this group don't care who they play. Yahya Ali was the man of the match with an unbelievable 115no from just 108 balls and shared in another 112 run partnership with Horan who ended up making a patient 28. Gun recruit Hunwick came in and iced the game with a quick 23no and we won by 9 wickets with 9 overs to spare. In games gone past we would have faltered but we had a real belief about us that we can beat any team anywhere.

We then had a tough fixture coming up with Murdoch. They were probably the best team in the comp on paper and this was a really good test for us to see how we were truly going. Having won the toss against Murdoch I decided to bowl first. We had Murdoch 4/35 at one stage but with the class they have ended up scrounging to 150. UI-Hassan again with 3 wickets to continue his great form. It was a tricky chase as Murdoch have a very good bowling side. We had a quick start but were 2/37 when Hunwick and Medhi came in. They combined for a partnership of 56 to get us into a winnable position. With even contributions we passed them 5 down to remain undefeated.

Round 4 we cruised past Kalamunda who would go on to not win a single game for the season. Kalamunda making 179 was a little disappointing as we knew they were probably going to be one of the bottom sides. But we made light work of the chase with another 73 run opening stand from Ali and Horan with Ali making 68 and Hunwick and Mehdi coming in to finish off the game with a 58 run unbeaten partnership as we passed them 2 down. Hunwick not out on 48 to assure the victory.

Wembley were next away from home. Another very tough assignment. I won the toss and decided to bat. We then witnessed two of the greatest innings in this clubs history with Yahya Ali making a dominant 136 and Zain UI-Hassan showing what he can do with the bat with a brilliant 100. We posted 301 and although it was a very good deck and a lightning outfield, I was always confident we could defend this. We ended up restricting them to 235 in a very good display of disciplined bowling. Star recruit Mitch Crew was the star ripping through the top order with 3 early wickets including the ball of the season to Suresh Perera and setting up the victory. 5 games and 5 wins and we were on top of the table and playing some really good cricket.

Round 6 saw us venture out to Swan Valley who were the runners up from the previous season. They weren't playing as consistently as they would have liked but are too dangerous to under rate. Swan Valley won the toss and batted first. Zain picked up the prize wicket of captain Phil Adams which got us off to a nice start. But that's when the wheels fell off and Swan Valley got going to be 2/140 after about 30 overs. We were staring down a massive total to chase but to our credit fought back well and ended up dismissing them for 250. Mitch Crew the pick of the bowlers with another 3 wickets. With rain interrupting our chase the week after, we ended up 9/212 to salvage a draw. We probably should have won the match with 6 guys scoring between 20 and 39. But in the end we didn't lose and still remained on top of the table.

Last game before Christmas we were back at home to face Applecross again. They batted first and posted a decent 158 after their 40 overs. L Paice the pick of the bowlers with 2/23 off his 8 overs. He was quietly building a very good season as an all-rounder and being our "Mr fix it" when required. We stumbled in our chase early with Horan, Ali and Hunwick all dismissed very early and at 3/12 for the first time this season we had our backs up against the wall. But again, this group responded with Awais Mehdi leading the charge with a quick 34 and then UI-Hassan and Omo Fanayan combining for 64 runs which then put us in a very good position. Fanayan ending up with 35 and man of match UI Hassan with 55. L Paice ensured the victory with 18no and we were the only team in the competition that were undefeated at Xmas. A magnificent effort from all involved.

We came back after Christmas with a fantastic win over Swan Athletic. We posted 5/215 after 40 overs with even contributions from Hunwick, UI-Hassan, Fanayan and Medhi who also scored very quickly. It was always going to be too much for Swan Athletic who ended up with 8/155. Hiten Shah finding some form with 2/24 and last years Hayward medallist Awais Mehdi with Man of the match honours with 3 wickets.



Round 9 and up against Murdoch who were starting to hit their straps. We lost our first game in a thriller by 3 runs. Murdoch posting a decent 5/180 after their 40 overs but we had our chances to really reduce that score but let ourselves down in the field. We got into a pretty good position at 3/122 with Horan 47 and Ul Hassan continuing his form with 42 but we were a bit behind the run rate and ultimately couldn't get there in the end. Still a very good effort and plenty of improvement to be had.

We then dropped another game against High Wycombe after again being in a winnable position. Horan winding back the clock with a sublime 80 out of our 165. We had High Wycombe 4/60 and on the ropes but this time I was the culprit dropping a simple catch which led to High Wycombe chasing our score. Two losses in a row and more was needed to not throw away what we had built.

Round 11 was against Subiaco Marist at home who were also desperate to win as they were just outside the 4. I won the toss and elected to bowl on a tricky deck. We dismissed Subi for 100 and were pretty happy with our effort. Hiten Shah with 4/29 to continue bowling extremely well. We then went out thinking it was just going to happen for us and be an easy victory. That all changed when we were 6/33 and at that moment in real strife of potentially not even playing finals after we were undefeated up until Round 8. Jack Duffy came in and gave us momentum hitting a quick 24 to get us within reach at 7/65 and then Palumbo and Paice got us to 8/85. At the end of the day we ended up 8/86 and our season hinged on getting the 15 runs the week after. Paice was dismissed for 21 and we required 8 for the win when Shah walked in. He did what was required and after a few nervous moments, we got the job done. We ended up getting 42 ahead of them after their first innings and after a strange declaration from the opposition skipper, we ended up winning outright which secured our finals spot.

Round 12 we faced Balcatta who were also on the brink of the 4. We ended up losing our first game at home by 3 runs. Again we let ourselves down in the field and Balcatta posted a good total of 6/177 after 40 overs. Adam Palumbo excellent with 5/36 and Hiten Shah unbelievable figures going for just 9 runs off his 8 overs. In our chase we had a lot of even contributions but were always behind the run rate. Jack Duffy producing a brilliant innings nearly getting us home with an unbeaten 31 off 27 balls. Still we were playing pretty good cricket and our 3 losses for the season had come against quality opposition.

Our last game of the season against Kalamunda ended up being a defining game for our season but at the start of the match we didn't know it. Kalamunda won the toss and smashed 8/199 after their 40 overs in a very disappointing effort in the field. Adam Palumbo was good with 2/24 but it was a big total to be chasing. We got off to a fast start and were 2/44 after 6 overs with Ali hitting 22 off just 11 balls. Hunwick kept the momentum going with a nice 30 but we stumbled to 6/113. Omo and I then shared in an 83 run partnership to get us home. Omo with a brilliant 35 under pressure and again stepping up when required. In the end winning that game catapulted us to the top of the ladder which in turn handed us our 3<sup>rd</sup> premiership in First grade.

It was an indifferent end to the season with the Corona Virus ending it prematurely before finals could start. But in the end we were the best team throughout the season and deservedly were crowned PREMIERS! A lot of hard work over the last few seasons by the group had finally paid off. Winning one premiership is extremely hard but to now have won 3 throughout my first grade career and sharing it with some of my best mates is something that I will always be proud of. A huge thank you to the playing group for letting me captain an unbelievable bunch of players and a brilliant bunch of blokes and for always putting the team first. A personal thank you to Laurence Paice, Timmy Horan and Omid Fanayan for always helping when I need them to on and off the field. Makes my life a lot easier.

Obviously this all doesn't happen without everyone involved at the club putting in the hard work that is required behind the scenes to create a successful environment. Everyone knows who they are and I want to thank them all for everything they have done for me and the group. Bentley has been a part of my life for so long because it is the greatest club of all. We are premiers for the 2019/2020 season!

It was an honour and privilege to be able to Captain the Bentley 3<sup>rd</sup> XI for the 2019/20 season. Over the off-season, the committee had done some excellent work bringing in some new players which ultimately would add depth to our playing ranks and in turn improve our results on the field.

Round 1 and winning the toss we posted a good first-up score of 171 against Bedford-Morley with yours truly 90\*, Freighter 20 and Leng knocking up a quick 17 to post a good total. We had Bedford-Morley in trouble at 4/64 with D. Leng doing the damage (4/21) swinging a web thru their top order but ultimately dropped catches and 30 wides meant we missed out on the chocolates.

Our first win came in Round 2 against Applecross, where an injection of youth, some excellent fielding/catching and an all-round bowling display held Applecross to a reasonable score. Tommy with 3/29 and Jay with 3/34 capped off a good bowling effort. In return we were going well at 2/112 before a collapse of 5/8 sent some shivers through the team. Chappy and Stace lead us across the line with 2 wickets and a few balls to spare, making it 1 and 1 for the season.

An early indication of our season would come in Round 3 against the form team Balcatta. Once again, our inability to bowl line and length saw the opposition rack up 223 in their 40 overs with wides (25) and dropped catches adding to our pain. Our season's young star was born with Rex McCormack returning 4/31 and showing a glimpse of what he was to offer the side. In return, the total proved too much and whilst Singha started his rich vein of form with 37, no one else was able to make a substantial score to overhaul Balcatta. The ability to string together 2 or more wins was becoming our Achilles heel.

Round 4 our game was reduced to the one day format after rain week 1, week 2 by contrast was a real hot and windy day. It was an easy decision to bat first after winning the toss. The first few overs were tricky on the grass of Veryard Reserve, but we posted a respectable score of 151 with Marlborough (77\*) and Freighter (29) making a 54-run partnership to provide the backbone to the innings. The fielding innings will go down as our best bowling and fielding display all season. All 5 bowlers contributed 2 wickets each and of the 9 catches in total, 3 to Marlborough, 2 to McNab and 2 to McCormack. Rexy's catch running back the best part of 40m with the flight of the ball over his head and catching the ball with an outstretched reach was catch of the year and capped off rolling North Perth for 96.

Round 5 was our 2<sup>nd</sup> week on the turf at the road called Belridge and we were treated to Singha's unique style of counterpunching with an entertaining 69, his highest score for the club. Blair kept the runs coming with an excellent 50, his 2<sup>nd</sup> fifty for the club and first in a few years. Lengy (26) added some great runs at the end to post a respectable score of 225. Unfortunately, we were unable to back up the bowling performance from the previous round and did not make enough inroads early to keep Ocean Ridge in check, they passed our score 7 wickets down. I was pleased with the effort of the boys who gave it their all, if it was not for missing out on wickets in those early overs, we could have pulled this one off. Being 3 wins and 2 losses verses 2 wins and 3 losses could have changed our whole season. It was good to have Cheesy in the team who put on a fielding masterclass which almost got us over the line.

Round 6 we were back at Centenary playing Swanbourne. Solanki 2/27 put on a metronomic masterclass to restrict a stubborn Swanbourne to 137. We were in early trouble at 1/1 and so Bhan was sent in as nightwatchmen to see off the day. On his return in week 2, Bhan slogged, edged and played some pretty good shots to make 57, his maiden 50. He couldn't repeat the effort some rounds later but in conjunction with Solanki (47) and Singh (30) we passed the total easily.

Rounds 7 – 9 were captained by my more than able vice-captain, club treasurer and long-time friend, Darren Leng. Winning 1 out of 3 games continuing our up and down season but managing to knock off the top team Balcatta in the process. Against Bedford-Morley in the return fixture, what could have been with Asher (35) and Cheesy (26\*) putting on a 55 run partnership but ultimately we fell 2 runs short: another example of what could have been this season. Asher (34\*) and Cheesy (25\*) repeated the dose against Balcatta with another 55 run partnership which did get us over the line.

Round 10 was the low point of the season, almost being rolled outright and failing to deal with the Subiaco -Marist spin attack. We did well to restrict the then ladder leaders to 149. Jay Smith with 4/45 and some good fielding from the team set what I thought was a reachable target on a fast outfield. Unfortunately, things started off poorly and after a couple of nightwatchmen were lost and being 3/8 at stumps, we capitulated to 49 all out. Sent back in we were 8/75 in the 2<sup>nd</sup> dig and thankfully to Smith and Stace we avoided the outright.

Our season was pretty much over from then and so we hoped with the final 3 games to salvage some pride from the season. We managed 2 wins and 1 loss; to see us through with 6 wins and 7 losses for the season. A few call outs over the last few games was the president's 62 in Round 11, Tommy Horan's 6/52 in Round 12 and Stace opening the batting for his second BCC half-century in round 13.



Overall, it was a pleasure to captain the team this year. I cannot thank enough Lengy for being a great support and clubman and the committee who worked magnificently as they always do behind the scenes. To the volunteers as well who keep the club running from the bar, to canteen, to marking the grounds, preparing pitches, helping with training (Cairnsy and Stevo) I cannot thank you enough.

To the 30 or so players who played in the 3's this year, thanks again. I was really proud of the effort we put in and that we gave it our best shot. To Singha with the bat, Rexy and Lengy with the ball and to the young guys for improving our fielding out of sight this year.

As for me, well every season could be my last but hopefully the body allows me to go around at least one more time. It would be good to see many of the boys back next year.

PS. Well Done to Brendon and the 1's on being premiers. History has been made and that cannot be taken away from any of you. Well done to Fab and the 2's for making the finals and what could have been if you were able to play. Well done to Kegga on leading by example in the 4's and unlucky to the One Day side who gave it a red hot go and just missed out on finals of their own.

The thirteenth installment of the Bentley vs South Perth "Chuck" Berry Game was played in 7<sup>th</sup> grade, on the only occasion the two teams were fixtured to meet in the grade: a 2 dayer in round 5.

A fortuitous call for South Perth's stand-in skipper (captain Garner was not yet at the ground) saw the visiting team elect to bat on what turned out to be the hottest November day ever recorded in Perth.

Captain Garner and Buurman faced the Bentley openers: club legend Tony Magill and newcomer Ijlal Zubiar. After some overs of watchful batting Magill was the first to strike, Garner spooning an easy chance to McMurray who gladly accepted his first catch for Bentley. Ijlal from the Leach Highway end had his first of the day soon after, Buurman hitting one directly to Smith at point.

Zubair seemingly impervious to the heat of the day at this stage was into his work and the South Perth middle order fell in quick succession. His inswinging Yorker was called upon seemingly at will and twice devastated the base of leg stump. The score was 5/38, and the ball was not leaving Ij's hand anytime soon. McKeig had been rotating through his bowlers at the other end as the South Perth batting style had turned to wicket preservation. Spells to Liddle and McMurray had conceded just 19 runs in 9 overs. It was 5 for Zubiar when he had Barrett caught Magill for 12 as the scoreboard read 6/62.

This brought Joey Dunn to the crease, notable for his association with Bentley through the Canning Tigers Football Club and having acted as a sub fielder for Bentley the season prior. Having bowled a mammoth 14 over spell Ijlal was given a rest to facilitate the long hyped match-up: Wingnut vs. Joey. It's fair to say Joey had the better of early exchanges, pulling Lockyer to the square leg boundary on multiple occasions, much to the delight of a number of CFC affiliated spectators. With Wingy getting pumped the run-up was increasing in both length and ferocity, to a point not seen for many a year. But Joe went to the well one too many times, blasting a ball into the hands of Mobin stretched above his head, leaving South Perth 7/97.

However, the heat of the day was taking its toll on the fielding team, some dropped chances off the next pair of batsman in Parker and Coughlan proving costly as their partnership stretched the day and the South Perth score. Ijlal returned to the attack after tea, having relieved Lockyer. Eventually he had 6, Parker caught Smith for a very well compiled 58. The 57 run partnership taking South Perth from a position of danger to one of comfort with fresh batsmen in the sheds and a bowling unit best described as ragged. Finally, after a litany of dropped chances and more than 25 overs of toil Zubair had 7 with Coughlan's wicket for 41, the other cornerstone of the South Perth inning caught by Keyte running out to square leg taking the skied catch. The last wicket partnership between Forward and Kent saw the score to 196 before Foggo claimed the final wicket at the close of play.

A much cooler Saturday greeted the teams on day 2, as McKeig opted for the defensive opening pair of Liddle and Smith. Suhasaria with new ball in hand was recalling memories of his last match against Bentley two seasons ago with enormous movement in the air and off the seam, eventually jaggng one past the inside edge of Smith to disturb the top of off stump, ending 48 minutes of stubborn resistance from the 17 run opening stand. Foggo came to the crease at three, a masterstroke from McKeig as the left to right movement of Suhasaria was not effecting the left handed batting of the Bentley No. 3 as the score slowly grew.

Liddle was caught behind by an excellent diving catch from Dunn, Suhasaria having found the inside edge. McKeig then Magill came to the crease for extended battles against the movement and edged the scores forwards with Foggo but both were eventually felled leg before wicket. Foggo was Parker's first wicket of the day, the leg spinner having him caught at mid on with the board grim reading at 5/68.

Suhasaria was still on from the Leach Highway end when Lockyer strode to the crease, and once the stumps had been reset to his satisfaction, took guard almost 2m away from them in an attempt to negate the movement and the LBW Law. With Keyte working hard on defense at last Suhasaria was rested after a mammoth 22 over spell, resulting in figures of 4/22 and 11 maidens. The other opener in L. Forward commenced his second spell and had Keyte caught behind. Ijlal followed Austin and was bowled shortly thereafter by Parker, before Lockyer came down the wicket and mistimed his drive, caught at mid-off for Parker's third and with the score at 8/94 an early stumps seemed likely.



But the two remaining batsmen had other ideas, McMurry and Hewitt (batting with a broken rib from injuries sustained on-stage the night before) dug in for a partnership lasting 30 minutes and taking the match into the final session, the scoring was slow as McMurray carefully saw off the pace and bounce of Forward before falling to Kent. Matthews came to the crease at 11 suffering a broken toe and requiring the services of a runner, but was bowled shortly thereafter by Parker to end the match and finalise Bentley's total at 125.

Man of the match honours were awarded to S. Parker of South Perth for his 58 and 4/27 as South Perth reclaimed the trophy, fulfilling a pattern of alternating winners now stretching back 6 seasons.
