In my final year as coach of the mighty Bentley Blues, I reflect back with some fond memories of my time as coach including having multiple teams play in finals and the banter at training sessions between players. I have thoroughly enjoyed my time and hope to still contribute to the club in a different capacity in the future.

This year presented some challenges for the whole club as we pushed for A grade to be competitive in their return to 1st grade, our 4th grade to continue developing players and make finals again. Whilst 8th grade has been a transition side with many players changing on a weekly basis sometimes, they still strive to make finals. 9th grade was looking to play more consistent cricket and improve on last season. Our one day side keep going to the fountain of youth to keep competing each week and push for another finals appearance.

During the year we had some new players come down to the club and provide some energy and bolstering across all the teams. We had some new Captains across some of the grades and I was happy with the drive we got at training sessions and various drills that we set. I hope this will be the impetus for our younger and new players to continue the good work set around the club and to lead the next generation to represent at the highest levels.

We had some help during the year from PC's contact at South Perth and he was able to set some new drills to sharpen our fielding sessions after the net sessions. We had some mixed performances and success during the year with 3 teams making finals being a great outcome but unfortunately we were not good enough to win a flag. This success was in part at the expense of the other teams with A grade and 8th grade missing out. For A grade, unfortunately a couple of new imports didn't perform as we hoped/anticipated whilst some players did well personally, we didn't have enough contributions from all team members during the year.

I want to thank everyone who has helped me during my time as coach, starting with the Committee members who volunteer their time and effort to continue running the club for all players to enjoy. I know it can be a thankless job sometimes, so on behalf of the players I thank you for your time and efforts to keep this great club going forward. To some other players including the captains of the teams, and PC as chairman of selectors, thanks for your support at times when needed, and a special thank you to Cam McNab and Darren Leng for always helping me out with various tasks and fielding drills.

Finally, I couldn't have run any of the training sessions or been effective without the enormous effort from Stephen Cairns as our Net captain. It's a tough job organising and often yelling at the players to get them through the nets in time but you do it well. 😊

With our five sides in 1st, 4th, 8th, 9th and One Day Div 2 grades in 2017/18 our work was cut out for us to gain any premierships this season. We had an influx of new players from the country (mainly from the Bunbury region) which made the selection process for each game a little easier with good numbers to choose from.

Fab Fanayan organised a comprehensive pre-season regime to get new and old players enthused about the approaching season. Fab worked tirelessly as Club Coach throughout the whole season and his efforts were greatly appreciated by me and other members of this year's committee. Fab also backed up as Captain of our second side and contributed enthusiastically on selection nights after organising and completing another vigorous training session. Fab's fourth grade side was beaten in the grand final after finishing third on the ladder. Good leadership skills were regularly on display.

Tim Horan skippered the firsts till Christmas before club champion Brendan Daye took over.

Former club champion junior cricketer Ujjwal Bhan stepped up as captain of eighth grade.

Jay Smith and Steve Shearing continued as skippers of ninth and one day grades respectively.

I thank all the skippers for their cooperation in the selection process for each game. Most weeks it worked seamlessly and players were usually informed prior to team announcements about demotions to lower grades. On the very few occasions when named players were unavailable on Saturday after being named on Thursday night I thank Jay Smith, in particular, for his communication with captains and players to ensure we had 11 players on the park for each team each week.

I would also like to thank Steve Cairns for his continuing role as Net Captain and Equipment Manager. All Captains were in receipt of new match balls every week, without fail, and Steve was always there to get out the gear (and pack it away) at training sessions twice a week. I believe that batsmen got more time in the nets this year so thanks for that Steve.

Another big thank you to our club statistician Tony Magill. Tony kept well up to date with milestones and achievements throughout the season and I enjoyed conveying those facts on selection nights.

As Cricket Manager can I also thank Ned and his helpers for getting an increasingly better turf track up each week and to Life Members Greg Dart and Len Woodley for superb and consistent ground marking the whole season.

There was no need for our Disputes Tribunal to sit at all this season. That reflects well on the players but also the Captains for maintaining equilibrium in their teams. Winning the Spirit of Cricket Award from the association also shows how well the skippers went with team morale.

Next season the club should embark on a youth policy for our top sides. Promote those with obvious potential and stick with them, as experience is gained and as confidence increases, positive results will ensue.

Matt Lockyer impressed with the gloves after a slow start and improved every week.

Brendan once again led the way with the ball taking 30 wickets at an average of 27.

Adam Chuckie Palumbo took 22 wickets at an average of 26 and Laurence paice took 20 wickets at an average of 29. Hopefully we can recruit some good quality young players and start fresh next season and win a lot more games and start to enjoy our cricket again.

A big thank you to Fab for his efforts as coach and all the work he put in to making training as enjoyable as possible.

In my first year as Captain, I have enjoyed the challenge and responsibility on game day to command a great bunch of guys throughout the year. When I took on the job, I wanted to continue the work of captains before me in developing our players coming up through the grades, but also ensure we have fun and a winning culture.

The year didn't start as most would like as we batted first in a One day game against High Wycombe to be all out 113 and losing by 9 wickets. With new players down to the club we had some new faces join the team and we played Balcatta in Round 2, another batting collapse in the only toss I won away for the year we made 111 with Sib0 hitting a lovely counter attack to make 41. Some quick wickets to start with Mitch Duncan and Smit Patel had them 4/29 but they won from there leaving the captain worried about the year ahead.

Round 3 we played Ocean Ridge at home and another raft of changes had a new look team at Wyong. Ocean Ridge batted first and on an "interesting" deck we had them 4/6 then 7/90 before late order hitting and missed opportunities saw them reach 174. Pick of the bowlers being M Duncan with 4, Solanki 2, and the captain 2. But another batting collapse and with rain around we lost badly all out 86.

Sitting 0-3 for the start of the year, I was hoping our fortunes would change if we got the batting right. Playing Swan Athletic at home, they won the toss and sent us in (seeing our last batting efforts). We managed to get 193 on the board thanks to a huge 99 run partnership by Jai 45 and Sib0 52 and Cheeseman 31 finishing off the innings. Next week we started with Solanki taking a wicket in the first over, but Mitch injured himself second ball! Down a bowler, Mauneek and Cheesey put on a bowling show taking 5 and 4 respectively to put the first win on the board and get our season under way!

We travelled to Whitfords for another 2 day game and batting first we put 201 on the board thanks in most part to Duffy 57, Sib0 40, and Solanki 41 with great patience shown by all batsmen to get set then hit boundaries to lift the run rate. Solanki and Cheesey bowled very well but unlucky to not get more wickets both getting 2/33 & 2/39 off 16 overs. Alex Jerrard bowled well to keep us in the game and taking regular wickets (3) to keep the pressure on. With their batsman set, the captain brought himself on with success taking the last 2 and a run out to win by 14 runs!

In the final 2 day game before Xmas, we took on Bedford at home, won the toss and batted first. We had a solid start with S Daye and S Saxon 38 linking up with the middle order to bat out the overs and make 211. Jai 32, Fanayan 45 and Duffy 41 no the big contributors and J Riches finishing with 24. The following week S Patel had early wickets (3) before they consolidated and built a partnership. Thomas Horan introduced to the attack taking a breakthrough wicket with Cheesey coming back for the second spell to finish with 5/46 of 19overs to help close out the match and give us another vital win.

Final game before Xmas and we wanted to consolidate our good form against Doubleview in a One day game at Wyong. Batting first they had a great start with an 80 run partnership setting up a big platform for them. New bowler Matt (Robbie) McEwen starting with 2 wickets, and Fanayan with 4 to bring them under 200, chasing 192. Needing nearly 5 an over for the whole day, we started a little slower than we liked, but S Daye 28, Pritchard 20 kept the rate manageable. Duffy (39) batting at 4 had some power hitting to lift the rate and joined others to keep hitting boundaries. Fanayan 39 no joined to help steer to victory with 1 ball to spare! We finished with 4 wins in a row to be back in the top 4.

After Xmas we sought revenge against Ocean Ridge in a One day game, enter a new bowler for our team with some outs and he had immediate impact. Batting first Ocean ridge lost early wickets trying to hit aggressive shots with Solanki and Stace 1 each. Josh Ericson then bowled 8 straight to bring the game under our control taking 3/27 and getting the ball to seam off the deck! Jai Thomas turned back the clock and bowled well to take 3/13 with Fanayan wrapping things up with another 2. Ocean Ridge all out 129. Run chase was positive with Riches and Saxon 40 taking charge, with Fanayan 39 no and J Thomas finishing the run chase with plenty of balls to spare.

Next game we had the return leg against Doubleview at their home ground. Losing the toss again, they batted first and scrambled to 160 after a 50 run opening partnership. Solanki bowled without luck but young rising star Thomas Horan changed the game bowling controlled, line and perfect flight to have 5 wickets with Ericson taking another 3. Coming back after the tea break he finished their innings with 2 more to take 7/49 off 29.5! Low totals can be a tricky run chase and we lost some early wickets before Cam Daw 32 and J Thomas 81 combined to guide us home (before a couple of late scares).

Back on Wyong and playing Whitfords for 7 wins in a row, we won a rare toss and batted first in this One day game. After some early wickets lost, S Daye 40 combined with Fanayan 39 to steady to score before another clump of wickets lost brought us back with J Thomas 32 batting with tail to get us 149 which was defendable. We never looked like taking a wicket with the bowlers having an off day and Whitfords winning easily.

With some players out and others playing A grade, the challenge was for us to take on 2nd placed Bedford in a One dayer that would suit them. Batting first Bedford had a steady start and aggressive batting we couldn't respond with our bowling giving away regular boundaries. McEwen and Horan taking 2 each but giving more runs than they would like. Some quick wickets and run outs at the end kept the score to 216. The pressure was on and a couple of close LBW decisions to our openers put us behind the 8 ball. Cam Daw batting most of the innings to compile 48, with the tail helping but it wasn't enough Ericson 23no and Bentley finished 184.

After 2 losses in a row we had to play High Wycombe who were top of the ladder at Scott Reserve. They batted first and what ensued was a fiery spell from Ish Khan, keen to get back to A grade along with youngsters Ericson and McEwen supporting. They ended up with 3 wickets each as High Wycombe tried to hit their way out of trouble but ended up all out 72. A difficult 30 overs to negotiate by our batters on day one, but Saxon 52 and Thyer 18 helped to get us past the first innings score and some quick loss of wickets after had us finish 111 on day 2. They came out to bat again hoping to pass our score and go for an unrealistic outright win, but our bowlers were up to the fight and had them 7/70 before time ran out with Ericson 2 and McEwen 3/12 and 6 for the match!

We needed to keep winning to stay in the 4 and had the final 2 day game against Balcatta who we were keen to beat given our first showing. Balcatta batted first and lost a steady stream of wickets, the damage being done by Ish Khan 3/25, Ericson 3/46 and Solanki 2 returning to the side. They were all out 140 and another low run chase started. Surviving the first day we lost 4 with Ish as night watchman. A gritty batting display by Duffy 41 and Ericson 28 on the second day had us close with 20 runs to go. Thomas Horan and McEwen getting us over the line as we lost our 9th wicket run out on 141! Balcatta batted again and finished 4/87 and we had snuck home with the win!

Our final game of qualifying saw us lose to Swan Athletic at Lilac Hill 3. In a game that couldn't change our ladder position we lacked some of the killer instinct and our batting was poor seeing another collapse, and worse still Duffy injured his hand to be out for the remainder of the season!

The Semi Final, we played a High Wycombe side that was stumbling at the wrong part of the season. Losing the toss they batted first and we rolled them for 80 in a repeat of our previous game. The wickets led by Cheesy 3/19 Cam Daw 3/13 and Ericson & Solanki 2 each. Needing to have a strong start, S Daye 31 batting well but ran out of partners as we finished 4/72 overnight. Fanayan 40 making sure we had a shot at the Grand Final! Not as convincing as we would have liked but we had made it.

The Grand Final, unfortunately we lost to a better side on the day. I won't recount the events as it is still too raw for us. At the end of the season, I was proud of the guys to come back from a poor start and to get into the Grand Final playing a good brand of cricket. I hope to see some of our players take the next step and player higher for the club and to also see all the team come back to go one better for next season.

To the players who played with us this season, if there is one thing I would say to you it would be: Never give up. Cricket is like a girl, she'll tease you and surprise you. So, enjoy every moment alongside your Blue brothers. We will come back better and stronger next year. Thank you all for making this a memorable season.

I would like to thank the Bentley Cricket Club for giving me this opportunity to captain the 3rd side, and to everyone who gave me a bit of input along the way to help me understand my role, I know I still have a lot to learn but it was a great experience and what made it more cherishable is that I had a playing XI that would give it their all and would never give up no matter how hard it got. Our first win is something I will never forget and singing our club song, that sweet taste of victory.

At the end of 2016/17, this report defined a *successful season* as playing finals cricket.

I am proud to say that the Bentley 4th Side finished third on the ladder this season, playing a final for the first time in four years.

It's hard to look back and reflect on that semi-final - as everyone does with close losses - without the bittersweet feeling of "what could have been."

Our semi-final opponent was Fremantle Mosman, a side the majority of whom were very recently turf players. Despite being outmatched 'on paper', you make your own luck on the day and the fact of the matter is we took it to the wire and provided the toughest contest they had faced all season. Match-defining performances from the Smith's along with some extraordinary fielding efforts and bowling spells were not quite enough to get us over the line, going down by 2 wickets very late on the second day. This, dear reader, is the allure of finals cricket: you feel that effervescent passion burn more than in any regular season game. Nine of our twelve had never experienced that, and all will be far better cricketers for it. Let's hold our heads high boys, we did far better than most - even ourselves - would have predicted.

But in summarising a season one must look further than the final game. Upon reflection the regular season matches were as enjoyable as ever in the 4th side. Perhaps a touch more as we did sing the song more often than not. In doing so we introduced ten Bentley debutants to our Club's proud culture.

Batting this season was dominated by our two openers...

Chris Lockyer, the sly old veteran that he is, confirmed a long-held suspicion that he can still do far more than "just hold a (wonder) bat". He was nothing short of a revelation opening the batting, filling a role that's been long vacant and winding back the years in a true renaissance of style and form. 303 runs for 10 dismissals placed him with the best in the grade, vital runs at the top of the innings that got us the all-important early advantage and momentum along with his partner in crime Michael Bowen.

The first game is always a nervous one and with quite a few debutants it can be difficult to arrive at a batting order. In chatting with our new guys, Mike said something along the lines of liking to hit a new hard ball but would be good for 20 quick runs or nothing. Thinking we were up against it chasing Kalamunda's 164 it sounded like a risk worth taking. Was it ever. In his first over Bowen helped himself to 13, but it was just a taster as everyone present witnessed a freakish innings of the kind you might see firsthand only a few times every decade. His 94 off 50 balls was the most recklessly aggressive opening innings both teams had ever seen, everything somehow going to the rope or over it; The very definition of 'agricultural' it was glorious to behold. Proving it was no beginners luck he continued to follow up throughout the season, finishing with 266 @ 29.56 in a similar style to his first knock it's fair to say the "20 odd or nothing" prediction was a major undersell.

The rest of the batting order made only sporadic contributions but it behoves me to mention Andrew Stace's match-winning 58 v Doubleview-Carine. I'll say no more, he'll mention it himself soon enough. Kieran when present was all class and as per usual was the prized wicket for the opposition. Others like Blake Melvin, Jess Little, Jordan Dynon and latecomer Nazir Ahmed showed great potential with the bat, I hope they take that confidence into next season. My thanks to Mobin Mathew for caving into harassment and returning to the team a few games in, hope to see you at the first preseason in 2018.

With the ball it's fair to say rolling the arm over in all games and captain's prerogative won the trophy but I was well supported by a wide talent pool of bowlers. Robbie Campbell-Clause made an explosive 4th team debut, ripping through Doubleview-Carine with the best individual figures of the season taking 6/12. PC with 15 @ 18.87 was under-bowled as often the games were finished before he got the chance. Lockyer and Stace were proven performers and again put in solid efforts throughout the season taking key wickets. As is the case across the lower grades the difference between good and bad bowling is not pace or turn but consistency outside off stump. To everyone who wants to bowl more remember that simple adage.

Another notable mention goes to Derryn Rive, having played more than 60 games for Bentley he earns his first ever trophy for his glove work during the year. It continues to improve through hard work and he volunteered multiple times to bat up the order when we were in tough circumstances, acquitting himself well in that role on most occasions. Dazzle's sometimes comical-controversial and finger-pointing scoring session partner, Bryn 'AJ' Evans was a great bloke to have around the team and provided some ying to the yang of other team dynamics, always good for a laugh and leaving his shoes behind after the game.

My thanks to the selection committee with Captains Bhan and Shearing, UJ particularly for consenting to 'priority picks' in the back end of the season to get enough qualified for the 4th and 5th side's finals campaigns. Rest assured, your lamentations were not lost on us.

Most importantly I need to thank those guys who fill in, often at short notice only to play a minimal (but often memorable) role in the game. It was our ability to field 11 when the opposition was short that made an enormous difference to our psyche out in the field and in the sheds. They too often go unnamed but to indulge a grateful skipper: Josh Ericson (bullied into it in those early weeks), Stevie 'Tigerblood' Riches, Pat Carbone, Jordan Dynon, Cairns (Snr & Jnr), Taylor Daw, 'Shammy' Sumanasinghe, Ben Hale, Holly, Pritchey (A/B). You are the guys keeping our side going.

On a further indulgence I want to thank Dad for his service and tutelage over the last three seasons, his contribution to myself and other 'youth' team members has seen us grow as cricketers and dare I say, men. His 'retirement' from the fourth to OD team is well and truly deserved. The dream of the Triple Smith flag may never eventuate but to play three seasons alongside family is truly special regardless.

For the third time in as many years the Dave Berry match was played between the Bentley 4th XI and the South Perth 3rd XI. In keeping with tradition it was the second of the two occasions these two teams met in the season, the first being a rather one-sided 2 day match where South Perth had cruised to victory at George Burnett before Christmas.

South Perth skipper Andrews called correctly at the toss and elected to bat. Bentley's preparation was not ideal with pace spearhead Andrew Stace summarily forgetting the 12.30 start time and missing the first three overs of the match. This saw Lockyer and Captain Smith engage the South Perth openers of Palmer and Hampson, and in testament to their bowling accuracy it took 31 balls for the first run to be scored. Stace was brought on for the 10th over and immediately made the breakthrough, a healthy edge into the hands of second slip and Palmer's resistance was brought to an end without score. The score was at this point was 1/13 from 10 overs and the run rate was becoming a concern for the visiting team. A partnership formed but number three bat Malhi was caught brilliantly down the leg side by a diving keeper in Derryn Rive off an errant wide ball from Campbell-Clause which was glanced off the bat. The score was 2/66 at drinks and the South Perth intent was clear, Evans at the crease was on the counter-attack with Hampson opening his shoulders before one Mobin Mathew snared arguably the season's most "Classic Catch" leaping at full extension to snare an absolute tracer-bullet above his head from an across the line whack by Hampson off PC.

Number 5 bat Tierney was dismissed for nought by Ahmed caught behind, who had been brought on after drinks to bowl in partnership with PC. However, Evans at the other end was doing the majority of the carnage at one stage hitting 6,4,6 in consecutive balls.

Derryn Rive then displayed his second exceptional piece of glovework for the day, snagging a caught behind standing up to the wicket off a top-edged cut shot by Best to PC, the score was 5/95 from 27 overs.

The next nine overs was attempted containment as Evans continued making powerful stokes as Andrews rotated the strike with ease. Ahmed finally ended his innings in the 36th over caught Campbell-Clause at straight cover for a score of 68 including 9x fours and 2x sixes.

Stace and Smith returned to bowl the last 4 overs and Stace had Andrews dismissed C&B off a leading edge. The final 4 overs cost 11 runs post-dismissal of Evans, Smith unlucky not to claim a wicket but finishing with figures 0/8 from 6 with Stace, Ahmed and PC claiming 2 apiece.

The afternoon tea catered by Smith family matriarch Ms. Lauk was widely acclaimed by both teams as the best all season with a selection of cakes, scones, sandwiches, sausage rolls and rissoles on offer.

The Bentley chase did not begin well with Bowen popping a catch to cover on the first ball of the innings bowled by Andrews. This bought Mathews to the crease who an over later was caught unawares outside his crease after a not out LBW decision and run out for 2.

Yet an over after that and Lockyer misjudged a misfield to be run out direct hit at the non-strikers end and the score was 3/5.

Ahmed and K Smith steadied the ship for a few overs before one of Ahmed's powerful lofted on-drives was caught brilliantly a ground level to see his innings over for 4. K Smith had launched a six so massive it shattered a tile on the roof of the Shelley pavilion but misjudged his next pull to be caught for 21. The score was 5/39 and the top 5 batsmen had made 29 between them. Victory from this point was a very remote possibility indeed, PC, Stace and J Smith falling for 11, 19 and 6 bringing the score to 8/80 before B. Evans and Rive came together to bat out the remaining 11 overs. Bentley finished with a score 8/101 and Josh Evans deservedly awarded the Chuck Berry man of the match for his 68.

Captain Smith described the match "the most amicable played all year" and a good way to end the season with the match otherwise being a dead rubber, both teams having secured their ladder positions the week before.

With the possibility of a grand-final rematch in two weeks' time both teams wished each other luck in the upcoming semis, and the Chuck Berry trophy returned to South Perth for another season with the overall tally at 6-5 to Bentley.

It was with great sadness that this year we said goodbye to a founding father and club legend, Geoff Farrall, player #19 and Life Member #1.

Geoff's legacy at Bentley and within the WASTCA puts him in rare company in the echelons of WA cricket. His career is rich with Bentley's history some of which is described below:

His first match for Bentley was in 1954 just our second season, at a time when the Association was known as the WA Senior Matting Association, and the club named Bentley Park. There were 3 grades in the Association of 6 teams each using 4 grounds. His second season saw him elected club secretary in 1955 at a time when club membership was 21/6 (\$2.15) and ball fees 6/- (60c). His emergence in 1955/56 as a quality player was evident with his 266runs @14 and 34 wickets @10.

1956 he was elected secretary, treasurer and club captain and continued to grow his reputation with the bat and ball, bringing up 100 wickets in the 1957/58 season and 1000 runs in 1959/60.

Milestones continued to fall for Farrall, taking his 200th wicket in 1960/61, his 42wickets @ 8.1 saw with win the A grade Association bowling award, the following season he was in just as fine a form, taking 41 @ 8.7

March 1962 saw the construction of the Merv MacIntosh Pavilion (which the club still calls home) and the laying of a 'malthoid' wicket at Wyong Reserve in Bentley, Bentley Park CC had a home ground, 1962/63 Farrall brought up his 300th wicket as he returned 49@ 10.3 these first 10 seasons had seen a golden era for Bentley, the Club's top side had won a "B" Grade Premiership, three "A" Grade Minor Premierships and played in an "A" Grade Grand Final.

1964/65 Bentley Park CC became Bentley CC and the Association the WASTCA and Geoff was made Life Member #1 courtesy of his 100 games the season previous and the club adopted it's first Constitution. 1965/66 and Geoff continued into unchartered territory, reaching 2000 runs and 400 wickets. Throughout this time Geoff had also been a key administrator for the club, 1967/68 he had served 10 years on the club executive and joined the WASTCA where he served the next 8 seasons as vice-president. Although Geoff's returns with the ball had fallen from the heady days of the 50's he was still returning 30 odd wickets a season in the club's top side.

He continued to play and administer in the competition, being made a WASTCA life member in 1968 and returning his best season to date, 50 wickets @ 9.7. By 1969/70 Geoff's son Peter was leading the attack in the top side and Geoff decided to captain the 2nd XI. Perhaps a premature retirement from the top XI after 162 games there saw him make 263 @14.9 and take an astonishing [70@7.5](#) in the 2nd XI.

1972/73 saw Geoff elected club president for the first of three consecutive years in the role and the first Bentley player to reach 200 matches. In 1973/74 Geoff returned to the 1st XI to see Bentley win their second premiership, his season haul of 65 @9.3 a significant factor in the flag winning effort.

By 1975 Farrall was ready to retire as increasing player numbers were seeing younger men miss out on spots in the two teams. Retirement was short lived though, as Bentley added a third side in 1976/77 where Geoff proved he still had even past his half-century, taking [86@7.2](#) in 7th grade including a grand final, and his 800th wicket.

After another dominant season in the third side Geoff returned to the second side in 1978/79, continuing his halls and bringing up his 4000th run a season later. By 1980/81 he had 1000 wickets for Bentley as he was back in the 3rd XI, and in 1982/83 in the third side Geoff played his 300th for Bentley.

1984/85 and Geoff was playing on past the retirement of one of his sons, where he was again the best bowler in the 3rd XI, returning [32@11.8](#). 1987/88 and Geoff was still a force in 7th grade, 24@ 15.5 saw him past 1200 wickets. By 1992/93 Geoff continued to play on past the retirement of his sons and reached the 400 game milestone.

By 1993/94 Bentley was well and truly in the 'modern age' with 4 sides now representing and this saw the permanent retirement of Geoffrey Farrall. Farrall played a total of 408 games, scoring 4727 runs and taking 145 catches. But his biggest statistical record (and almost unsurmountable) is his efforts

with the ball, with 1286 wickets to his name at an average of just 11.8, taking 10 wickets in a match on ten separate occasions and an outstanding 67 five wicket haul in an innings. He bowled 34,219 deliveries (equivalent to 5,703.1 6-ball overs).

Post-retirement he continued to support his beloved Blues and was a regular spectator at matches into the 2000's. Geoff was a walk-up starter when the Bentley Team of the First 50 years was selected in 2003, his wife Norma awarded life membership in 2006, with sons Peter, Michael and Stephen all enjoying careers of their own with Bentley, playing alongside their father on many a match day. In 2016 he was inaugurated into the BCC Life Members Hall of Fame and the Wall of Honour in the Canning Sports Club is named after him.

To this day Geoff holds a plethora of cricket records which will never be surpassed, his 21 years on the club executive proof he was a legendary clubman both on and off the field. No other Bentley player holds claim over a career as extraordinary or influential as Geoffrey Farrell, and precious few others in the State of WA could also be held to such a level.

His records are unpassable, his legacy is pantheonic.
