As my Vice Captain Jos was instrumental in understanding, innovating and enforcing the team values which were so important to us.

There were many individual acts of selflessness that are too numerous to mention here. Well done guys you thoroughly deserved this one! You are an incredible group of people that made a champion team. Remember stick together and continue to celebrate this massive achievement in years to come.

The team cannot exist in isolation and the support of the club was again tremendous. Ninth Grade - Report

A season best forgotten on the basis of results and overall performances.

This team won 3.5 of 13 games (including one forfeit), which did not include a win in any 2 day game. At various times in most games we put ourselves in winning positions but lacked batting depth to chase winning totals.

Three things stand out for me from the season just passed:

- This team lacked a core of players around which the season could be built. This reflected the Club's desire to have a dedicated one day side this season which utilised players who would have been an outstanding success in 9th grade. I appreciate that a number only wanted to play one day cricket but I am sure we could have convinced them to play 2 day cricket. In all, this side had 42 players participate in 9th grade games this season, with only three persons playing in more than 10 games. Unfortunately, on many times during the season we fielded highly uncompetitive teams and were sadly shown to be uncompetitive.
- Our batting skills were deficient. Only two players aggregated more than 200 runs for the season and only 4 players aggregated more than 100 runs for the season. This indicates that a large number of our batsmen are not up to the level of competence required to play 9th grade cricket successfully. When we are unable to chase scores of 86 and 100 to win a cricket match it demonstrates the lack of ability very clearly.
- We did unearth some new young talent who, hopefully, will be a part of the Bentley scene for a number of years to come. I refer specifically to Glen Scholes, Bennet Andrews, Cameron McNab, Daniel Swansson and Luke Johnson. These guys may never play in the top sides, but they have the ability to be a part of successful Bentley teams down the grades.

Unfortunately, from my perspective, the season was not an enjoyable one – not because we lost most of the time, but because we were not competitive for most games throughout the season. My thanks to all 42 players who participated this year, as I know they all tried 110% in every game that they played. A special thanks to Greg Dart, Keith Chapman and Len Woodley for helping us out when we were short during the year. A very special thanks to Jenny Conley for her assistance in scoring duties during the year and in ensuring that yours truly was able to play the last two games; and to the other wives, girlfriends and various spectators during the year who generally supported us when possible.

In closing, the season was not a successful one (in that we finished last and didn't play finals cricket). The Club has a major decision to make as to the future of this side going forward. For what its worth, my view is that we should play 10th grade and concentrate on being competitive. If the side is not competitive, it really doesn't matter whether we play 9th grade, 10th grade or a second one day team because it will continue to be unenjoyable and disappointing.

One Day Side - Report

The 2006/2007 season saw the introduction of a sixth Bentley side for the first time. We entered the "one day competition" with minimal expectations and concluded the year with an outstanding team and a convincing Premiership win. We played 14 preliminary matches for only two losses, both being in the first round of fixtures. We were successful at setting run targets and chasing down totals.

One of the most pleasing aspects of captaining this side was the quality of the fielding from my team mates. Rarely were catches dropped and misfields for the year could be counted on one hand. Many runouts of opposition batsmen were further testament to our ground fielding ability.

Successful teams must have two enduring qualities; one, the individuals in the team must have talent. We had plenty of that. In all games someone stood out and produced an outstanding individual effort. In the batting ten "50's" were scored. In the bowling six times four wickets or more were taken by a bowler. The best was 6 for 14 from Chris Taylor. Bowlers were restricted to a maximum 7 overs per game.

The second quality a successful team must have is team spirit (comradeship, chemistry -call it what you will). We had plenty of that throughout the year and it was particularly strong within the twelve individuals who eventually made up the finals teams. 53 different players went on the scoresheet for my team during this season and the support I received from each of them went a long way towards our success.

Three games stand out during the season. Our second clash with South Perth was the first. Both teams were level on points before the fixture. We got them out for 119 before Shane Lloyd (64) and Steve Shearing (53) put on our highest partnership of the year of 124 for the first wicket to enable an easy victory.

Jamie George and Greg Sheppard became our opening batsmen for the last six games (they also contributed many valuable wickets as bowlers) producing stands of 111 v Bedford Morley, 61 v Western Suburbs, 64 v Whitfords, and then a magnificent 99 against Whitfords in the semi final. Shep scored his first 50 in a final then all the following batsmen scored better than a run a ball before we reached our highest score of the year, 4 for 206 off 35 overs. Tony Magill, who travelled from Collie to play each week, then produced a magical 5 for 22 to rout Whitfords for 88. A special mention to Martin Massee who answered a late SOS for players early in the season, played more games than anyone else and took 2 for 22. Marty opened the bowling in every game he played, with an economy rate of 3.4 and only failed to take a wicket in three games.

The third and most memorable game was the Grand Final. Playing Subi Marist (who had beaten us earlier in the season) we batted first and scored a solid 9 for 190. The highlight for the game and the season was Chris Taylor's blazing 105 from 70 balls. The difference between the two teams was Chris's ability to not only hit five sixes and run superbly between the wickets but to relax and enjoy and dictate the tone of the match. Subi replied with 6 for 170 and gave the huge crowd something to ponder if the Bentley Blues hadn't fielded so well.

Chris Taylor, who hadn't played cricket for 15 years before Shep got him down, won the fielding award easily and finished with a batting average of 82.2. Shane George was my "go to" man with the ball and produced the most wickets (25). Lachie Harris won every game he played during the season and kept wickets with enthusiasm culminating in two important direct hit run outs in the Grand Final. Simon Cleary and Staff Dawson contributed at various stages and Cam McNab was one of the best fielders in the competition. Luke Johnson played his first game of cricket ever at the beginning of the year and finished with a premiership medallion. Well done everyone.

Finally, can I thank the committee for all the work done throughout the year, Staff Dawson for his organizing skills, Verco and the other captains for helping with selections and Holly for great work on the track. A special mention to the young Blue Boys – Damon, Lleyton, Jay & Kieran. The future of the club.
