## 60th Anniversary Report

Season 2012/13 saw the Bentley Cricket Club celebrate its 60th Anniversary, after joining the W.A. Senior Matting Association in 1953.

From humble beginnings in 1953 the Bentley Cricket Club presently fields five senior teams in the W.A. Suburban Turf Cricket Association and two teams in the Capture Sport T20 competition, which is played on Sundays.

The Bentley Cricket Club is the oldest non-amalgamated club in the WASTCA.

The first formal meeting took place on 7 September 1953, with local shopkeeper J McKinnon being the first President, Jack Thomas the Secretary and Dennis Tobin the Vice President. A fortnight later at a meeting held at the shop of J McKinnon, it was moved by George Warner that the fledgling club's colours be Navy Blue. The "Bentley Blues" had been created.

Bentley Park CC had been accepted into the West Australian Senior Matting Cricket Association in "B" Grade, a 10-team competition. Due to a shortage of grounds for "B" grade, four games were played on two Saturdays, with the remaining games being played as all day fixtures on Sundays on a fortnightly basis.

A study of early minutes and correspondence reveals that the club had approached the Canning Road Board in an effort to obtain the recreation ground in Wyong Road. However it was not until season 1962/63 that Bentley Park CC was to play a home game at Wyong Reserve. Bentley Park CC finally tasted Premiership success in 1958/59, winning "B" Grade in what was by now the West Australian Minor Cricket Association.

#### **Highlights of Our 60 Years**

- In 1959/60 Bentley Park Cricket Club enters a second team into the West Australian Minor Cricket Association.
   At this time only one other club has more than one team.
- On Sunday 17 June 1962 the newly constructed Merv McIntosh Pavilion is opened and finally the Bentley Blues have a home.
- Season 1973/74 first premiership in 15 years Grade 3 with Wayne Pulver as Captain/Coach.
- Season 1985/86 Second Grade premiership Peter Taylor as Captain/Coach.
- Season 1998/99 Second and Fourth Grades win premierships Second Grade promoted to A Grade.
- In 2004 a Turf Wicket is installed and in November of the same year the first game is played on the new wicket.
- Seventh Grade four premierships in succession 2005/6, 2006/7, 2007/8 & 2008/9.
- Season 2008/09 the Bentley Cricket Club celebrates the winning of its first "A" Grade Premiership.
- E J Ireland & P J Pearce trophy, "Spirit of the Game", awarded to Bentley for season 2008/9.
- In 2011 Lloyd Dungey plays his 500th game. Steve Cairns plays his 400th game, joining Geoff Farrall who reached the 400 game milestone during the 1993/94 season.
- In 2012 Christopher Cairns became Player # 1000 for the club.
- Season 2012/13 Bentley wins its second "A" grade premiership as well as winning Division 1 of The Capture Sport T20 competition.
- 25 Premierships have now been won by the "Bentley Blues".

To celebrate the Club's 60th Anniversary two well-attended functions were organised, with the first being our "Season Launch" held at the Bentley Hotel on 2 October 2012. A highlight of this evening was the attendance of Player #2, Colin Fitzpatrick, who was a member of the first Bentley Park Cricket Club to compete in a fixture on 17 and 24 October 1953.

Graeme Verco and Len Woodley were presented with their Life Member's medals bringing the total to 30 across the club's 60 years.

The second function was held on 3 March 2013. The 30 Life Members of the club were honoured and presented with framed certificates in recognition of their service to the Bentley Cricket Club.

We can be proud of our first 60 years and confidently move on as a respected, successful club within the West Australian Suburban Turf Cricket Association, but well aware of the challenges that lie ahead of us as a club.

Finally may I offer my special thanks to the members of the 60th Anniversary Sub Committee in Keith Chapman, Brian Hayward, Stafford Dawson, Steve Shearing and Chris Lockyer for their help in a somewhat onerous but nevertheless enjoyable task, and also for the drinks and laughs that we had on many a Wednesday afternoon.

Hopefully we will all be helping out again in 10 years time.

# Head Coach & 1st Grade Report

There was a bitter taste in the mouth of every person involved with the A Grade squad after the heartbreaking end to 2011-2012. We were beaten in the last round by High Wycombe, who as a result took our rightful spot in 4th place and 3 weeks later, they were holding a Premiership flag, wowee, 12 months is a long time in cricket.

Throughout the pre-season, we were well represented at training and were primed for Round 1. We had 3 major inclusions to the squad in 2012-2013. English gun recruit Tom Allin, former Rockingham-Mandurah 1st Grade Captain Shane Saxon, and youngest member of our 2008-2009 premiership side Jack Duffy. Everything was in order for a great season.

Round 1 was against the elevated Tuart Hill, who would later go on to win the Minor Premiership. We were sent in on a flat Charles Veryard wicket and found ourselves reeling at 8/158. A gritty 9th wicket stand of 70 between our bowling all-rounder Tom Allin (61) and the best number 10 around Mouneek Solanki (16) saw us to a total of 236. After only 5 overs on day 2, we were washed out and had our first points on the board courtesy of a draw.

We then entered a 'soft' part of the draw in which we beat Western Suburbs by 111 runs, Whitfords by 8 wickets and Swanbourne outright. These 3 sides finished 10th, 11th and 12th respectively. All players performed at a high level through these 6 matches, highlighted by Brendan Daye amassing 111 runs and 8 wickets, Omo Fanayan with 91 runs, Shane Saxon with 11 wickets and Hiten Shah with 8 wickets. Lusty hitting from Tom Allin and Christopher Bradbury was also key component to these wins.

Then to some real opposition. Round 5 saw us take on the runners up from 2011/2012 Bassendean. The match was reduced to a 40/40 as a result of rain. We batted first and posted a very respectable 6/200 with Brendan Daye again the star with 53no. Omo Fanayan also posted 38 in good time. Bassendean began their chase very well and at one stage were 2/86 off 18 overs. We rallied well, mainly due to the "spin twins in Daye" (3/21) and ever reliable Jai 'Daddy' Thomas (3/27) and dismissed Bassendean for 124.

The last fixture before Christmas held the biggest challenge for our group to date. High Wycombe at Scott Reserve. We were inserted on a lively pitch and after being in a good position at 1/54 (Smith 22 and Paice 44) we again stumbled and found ourselves at 7/145. Enter Jack Duffy (79) and Jai Thomas (17) who compiled a brilliant 68 run partnership to swing the match back in our favour. We posted 236 for the second time in 6 matches.

We were then clinical with the ball and in the field, without our champion seamer in Hiten Shah, rolling the reigning premiers for 128 on their home deck (which was substantially flatter on the second day). Bowling honours were shared with Daye (4/19), Saxon (2/38), Allin (2/17) and Solanki (2/27) doing the damage. This win was monumental. We now believed we could beat any side at any ground.

Round 7 took us to Pat Goodridge to tackle the star studded Wembley side. Batting first, we AGAIN stumbled to 8/107, a trend that was becoming a worry for the captain. Late order heroics from Thomas (26no) Solanki (21) and Shah (18) allowed us to get to 176 a total that we could defend. 65 runs from our bottom 3 batsman. A sign that the side had character that it would later need in spades. Having to bowl 19 overs on Day 1, we rattled Wembley's top order to have them on the ropes at 4/37 at stumps. Shah continued his stellar season picking up 3 wickets, and Tommy Allin taking 1. We continued to take wickets regularly on day 2 and dismissed Wembley for 131. Four Wickets for Shah, 2 for Allin, 2 for Daye and 1 to Saxon. Another win on the board. Unbeaten after 7 games.

Questionable fixture programing meant a captains' agreement between the Doubleview's skipper and myself to play a one day 40/40 game instead of playing on Australia Day. We bowled first and restricted DC to 150 from their 40 overs, which was a respectable score considering we were playing on the slowest outfield in cricket history. Wickets were evenly spread, and we had a good chase on our hands. Saxon was out in the first over. We then steadied up with a 77 run stand between Smith (49) and Paice (25) to be 1/77 off 18 overs. A few wickets fell, but we eventually got the job done reasonably comfortably in 35.5 overs with 5 wickets in hand. Unbeaten after 8 rounds. No games at Wyong as yet. Every game on the oppositions home turf. How easy is this? And then boom. A reality check!

Bentley's bogey side in Applecross was next on the agenda away from home, for a change. Batting first, one ball before tea, we were 2/156 with Omo Fanayan (62no) and Paice (63no) in cruise control. Omo was then dismissed just before tea, Paice just after, and a horrendous collapse saw us all out for 204 having lost 8/48. Had we blinked and could we be made to pay? You bet your bottom dollar we were made to pay. Applecross passed the target 6 down and then proceeded to pile on 9/287. Given, we were without two of our front line seamers in Hiten Shah and Shane Saxon, however this was a game that we had in complete control with the bat. We left the door open for a good side to capitalise, and capitalise they did. The first dropped game. We'd come back and win the next game right? Wrong!!!

We ventured to Wyong for the first time all season to play Swan Athletic. The skipper won the toss and, incorrectly, batted first. We were then skittled for 69 in just 31 overs, with the only resistance coming from Matty Smith with 22. We rallied pretty well and bowled Swan Athletic out for 130 to end day one. Day 2 started horribly again. 3/12 and still 49 runs behind Swan Athletics first innings score. A crunch 37 from iceman Omo Fanayan and a timely 40 from Shane Saxon saw us out of immediate danger. 4/100 and we as a side were simply looking to bat the day and restore something from the match and some form heading into the finals. Dismissed for 172, we then had 12 overs to bowl with Swan Athletic needing 111 off 12 overs to pull off an outright win and restore their finals hopes. We weren't going to let that happen, and ended the match positively taking 4/47. Still we had gone from being unbeaten after 8 rounds, to losing 2 straight games and needing to win the last fixture against Swan Valley to finish in the top 2 and secure a home final.

To "The Valley" we travelled. Batting first, we knocked up 8/245. Elevated to the top of the order, Jai Thomas started with a rock solid 20. Omo Fanayan was again the star with 65, Brendan Daye made a stylish 55, and 42 from 58 balls from Leigh Martin at the end helped lift the score to a respectable total. Brendan Daye, elevated to the role of taking the new ball, was fantabulous with 5/61 from 27.3 overs. Two wickets for Shane Saxon, 1 each for Hiten Shan and Jai Thomas and a run-out from the evergreen Matty Harmer rounded off a very good all round matches for the side.

Finals time. Wyong the ground. Applecross the opponent. A tough week at the selection table saw Matt Harmer and Chris Bradbury left out of the XI for the semi-final. The fact that two guys of this ilk were left out of the team was a reflection of the quality of the squad rather than the form of the two individuals. Heavy rain leading up to the game had meant that pitches were slightly soft around the metro area. Stand-in and stand-out groundsman Tim D'Souza had done a remarkable job to get the wicket up and despite the midweek rain, the pitch at Wyong was fit for play (unlike 5 other pitches around the competition, tip of my hat to you Timmy)

We were inserted and ground our way to 141, mainly on the back of a master class 49 from Brendan Daye, and cameos from Laurence Paice (26) and Omo Fanayan (19). Not many sides would back themselves to defend 141 on a featherbed, and something extraordinary was needed from the group to get the job done. Fortunately, this is an extraordinary group of blokes, and we had earned our Grand Final spot in the most incredible manner. At 3:40 on Day 2, Applecross were skittled for 122. Brendan Daye, again, was the star with the ball, with figures of 4/60 from 30 overs straight. Hiten Shah was amazing with 2/14 from 13, Shane Saxon with 2/31 from 8, and Mouneek Solanki 2/12 from 8 in a match turning spell. What a time to bowl the spell of your life hey!!

Grand Final time. Fate had pitted us against High Wycombe. The side that knocked us out of the finals race some 12 months earlier. Hold onto your hats, this is going to be big.

We won the toss and batted first at Pat Goodridge. After assessing that the opening spell from HW's front line bowlers was the key to the match, Matt Smith and Jai Thomas went out and got to work, and what a job they did. A 51 run opening stand had us away to a flier before Smith was cruelly run out for a majestic 29. Paice then came and went quicker than a B Daye in ducker and we were 2/63. Another 50 run stand from Jai and Omo had us in a great position. JT's dig came to an end at 37 off 130 balls. A terrific job done. Daye came and went quickly, before a 75 run stand between Omo and Shane Saxon (35) swung the match heavily in our favour. We batted the day out to be 9/244 at stumps. Omo Fanayan, continuing his Grand Final heroics, scored the most beautiful 86 to steer us to a great score.

We were confident that if we bowled and fielded at the standard we had all season that we would win this game. Could we do it? Never in doubt!!!

Before any of us could really blink, we'd reduced HW to 7/104 due to 4 wickets from Brendan Daye (3/53 from 25) 3 wickets to Shane Saxon (3/44 from 12) and 1 wicket to Hiten. However, HW hadn't fluked the last two premierships in first grade and battled to be 7/174 with 16 overs left in the day. 70 runs off 96 balls. 3 wickets to get. Was this going to be a Grandstand finish? No it wasn't.

Hiten Shah then bowled a magical spell to take the last 3 wickets in the space of 14 runs to give him match figures of 4/52 from 23.4.

#### WE'D DONE IT. THE PREMIERSHIP WAS BACK WHERE IT BELONGED!

Man of the Match was Omo Fanayan for his spectacular 86 and 3 catches. To highlight what an amazing big game player Omo is, take this in. Bentley have played in 3 A-grade grand finals in the last 6 seasons. 2 of those we've won, and Omo has top scored for Bentley in all 3 games!! Now that's a big game player folks.

#### **Steve Shearing 200 Games**

So much has been said about Steve Shearing during his 20 year career with the Bentley Cricket Club. Outstanding administrator, purposeful leader, solid accumulator or runs, reliable fielder to name a few however almost every club member would call him mate. Steve fittingly lead the 1 day side to victory in his 200<sup>th</sup> game this season on the 12<sup>th</sup> January 2013 against Subiaco Marist topping off the day with 50 not out. Steve came to the club in the 1993/94 season to be the Club Captain/Coach. Steve better known as a bowling all-rounder at that time soon showed his skills with the bat and ball during his early career with the Mighty Blues. Steve is player number 443 he debuted for Bentley alongside many of the greats and soon to be greats of the Bentley Cricket Club. The side that day contained no less than 8 life members of the club. In his first game he lead from the front against Bedford at Wyong scoring 53 on Debut however the team went down in the game. Over his 1<sup>st</sup> 3 seasons will the club Steve scored his first 1000 runs at an average of 31.48, he also took 62 wickets at 14.48. His Career batting average has remained almost the same ever since with it still remaining above 30 at the time of his 200<sup>th</sup> game for the club. Steve went on to Captain the 1<sup>st</sup> side for 7 straight seasons securing the 1998/99 2<sup>nd</sup> Grade Grand final which elevated the club to the premier grade. Steve has captained more 1<sup>st</sup> grade games than any other player with 76 games as captain with a winning percentage of 42% one of the best in the club records. Steve was the inaugural winner of the Hayward medal backing it up with a 2<sup>nd</sup> win in his 2<sup>nd</sup> season with the club. He has continued to take on the role as captain in the lower grades captaining a total of over 110 games maintaining a win percentage of over 40%.

Steve was awarded life membership of the club in 2001 after only 8 seasons with the club highlighting the regard he is held in by his fellow members he is probably more recognised for his off field efforts for the club. Steve went on to be president of the club for 6 years being elected President of the club in 2003/04 season a position he held until the 2009/10 season when he stood down and took up the role of Treasurer for 2 seasons.

Steve had one of the longest waits of any great player at Bentley to secure his first ton being achieved in his 142 game for the club in the season 2006/07 with 108\* against Balcatta in 4<sup>th</sup> side. He then got moving in the 100 club ranks scoring his 2<sup>nd</sup> ton only one month later and now has three to his name his last coming in the 2010/11 season which is his highest score of 114\*. Steve holds the Club Record partnership for the 4<sup>th</sup> wicket, with the late great David Berry. The great mates put on 156 in the 1<sup>st</sup> side against Melville in 1995/96 season. Steve was honoured with selection in the team of the 1<sup>st</sup> 50 years of the club in the 2003/04 season along with his great mate David Berry. Steve has played in a number of grade finals over his career being the winning Captain of the 1998/99 season and including 3 wins in the 7<sup>th</sup> grade side from 2005/06, 06/07 and 08/09.

Below is a brief summary of Steve's record across the five sides which he has played in in his career to date for the Bentley Blues. We all hope there are a few more good seasons in those dodgy calves yet so we can see 1 more majestic ton or reflex catch in the gully or to lead a premiership version of "Everywhere We Go!!!" as has been traditional done.
