## **2ND GRADE**

The top side began the year confidently, following some selective pre-season recruiting, but after a number of indifferent performances eventually faded to finish the season in 11th position with just two wins.

The outstanding debut century by Assistant Coach Dave Berry against Melville, and the equally impressive 6/36 from 20 overs (including a hat-trick) by left arm speedster Rod Duncan in the fixture prior to Christmas, were by far the most impressive individual highlights. Although, from a team point of view the 11th wicket 47 run partnership between Andrew Hayward and Rod Duncan to secure victory against Bedford was sensational.

Coach Steve Shearing was once again the premier batsman and was well supported by the experienced Dave Berry and Pete Smith. All three having excellent seasons and carrying the depleted batting line-up. Rod Duncan was by far the outstanding bowler and although Steve Shearing, Colin Chilcott, Tony Magill and Pete Smith chipped in with valuable wickets a more consistent all round effort was required.

Keeper (and sometimes outfielder) Steve Tagliaferri had a tremendous season to be the Club's top fieldsmen, his performances were first class and set a very high standard throughout the year.

Player unavailability, combined with mediocre performances by a number of key players saw the team finish 7th on the ladder with six wins.

The individual season highlights were undoubtedly Greg Sheppard's fine century against Girrawheen, whilst Ian Dickerson's six wicket haul at High Wycombe was well deserved. The one run victory against Doubleview early in the season, and a spirited 61 run 9th wicket partnership by Andrew Hayward and Paul Murphy to secure victory at Fremantle Mosman Park were both outstanding team efforts.

The batting was ably led by Ace who had an excellent season, but generally received very little consistent support.
