Head Coach & 1st Grade Report

After finishing 7th in 2010/11, improvement was the theme for the 2011/12 season. From an A grade point of view, our numbers in the preseason were very good. The mood amongst our group was a great one from our first session at courtside all the way to the last day of the season at Scott Reserve.

Round one saw us 'squeeze' out a win against a finals side from the season before in Whitfords. Batting first in a 40 over match we amassed 196 with both Adam Rouse and Omo Fanayan making 50's. Despite being a little rusty in the field, we held Whitfords to 9-171. Brendan Daye, Shaun O'Shea and Jai Thomas all taking 2 wickets a piece.

Round 2 and 3 bought us 8 points in total. 4 from each as they were both drawn. We were then unlucky not to pick up full points against Western Suburbs in Round 2. After bowling them out for 130, we went to stumps 0-18 and in complete control of the contest. The 2nd week was 'rained out' as all other games within 5 kilometres resumed with a full days play. We were frustrated, but heartened by another strong performance. Round 3 was against Swan Valley. After making 157, we had the reigning Grand Finalists 2-48 ex English Test All Rounder Chris Schofield in the shed. The 2nd week of all fixtures were then washed out in A Grade.

We won our next 3 matches leading into the break. A solid win against Ocean Ridge defending 240 and winning by 50 runs. A thriller against Applecross where we won 8 wickets down chasing 135. And another rock solid win against Doubleview, making 240 and dismissing them for 191. Best performers over this period being Brendan Daye and recruits Matty Smith and Adam 'arouse' Rouse.

We then dropped a game against the eventual wooden spooners in Balcatta. Despite a phenomenal lone hand of 104no from Matt Smith, we were horrendous in the field and unable to defend our 181. Bowling honours clearly went to Matt Greenwood with an explosive 5/37.

Round 8 was an incredible game of cricket. Having bowled Bassendean out for 141 (on the back of 5 wickets from B Daye), we stumbled with the bat to be 6/64 at stumps on day one. L Martin then fell in the 2nd over of day 2 to leave us 7/66 on a bowler friendly Wyong deck. The following 3 hours were occupied by the best partnership I have seen in my 6 seasons at Bentley. Jai Thomas (60) and Matt Greenwood (88) put on a 109 for the 8th wicket in a match winning display of tough batting against a class attack under huge pressure. The team highlight for us in my eyes.

We then accounted for Swanbourne in an even team performance, winning by 6 wickets in a one dayer due to a washout on the first week. Arch nemesis Wembley were then too good for us in Round 10. Stand out performers were B Daye with 6/60 and Mounseek Solanki with 36no.

We were left with a simple task. Having lost 8 points for 2 days of failed play at Wyong Park during the season, we sacrificed a home game to play reigning premiers High Wycombe at Scott Reserve. We win, we play finals. We lose, and we finished best of the rest.

We amassed 230 on the back of another majestic ton from Matt Smith. On a fast ground against a good batting team, we felt that whilst 20 runs less than we thought was par for the ground, we had a winning total.

At 5/83, we felt we were one wicket away from taking complete control of the game. The prize pole was ex state cricket Peter Worthington. His class showed through as he compiled 93no and steered his team to a controversial finals birth as we were left to rue what could have been. For the record, High Wycombe went on to win the premiership. One they will remember for a lot of reasons, and one they can thank an element of luck for.

Individual highlights for me were the 2 'lone hand' hundreds from Matty Smith, and the week in week out bowling genius of Brendan Daye. Two great leaders and two steely competitors.

Team highlight was undoubtedly the Bassendean win. Tail runs against a great attack on a poor deck on a 40 degree day are always a recipe for a memorable win. JT and The Hulk will no doubt remember it for many years to come.

Last season we finished 7th. This season our ladder position was 5th, although we earned enough points to finish 4th. We have improved and can compete with every team in the competition, but anything less than finals next season will be a failure.

Firstly I'd like to thank Fab Fanayan for stepping and captaining the team in my absence for 4 matches. You seamlessly took the reins at training and game day and your leadership is first class. We know we are on the right track and building towards the ultimate prize. Cheers Blanka!!

To Veracs, or the Last Standing Muppet as we always say, thanks mate for your continued support and the wise words you always offer to a young and sometimes green captain. You are the unofficial 12th man of our side and we fell privileged to have you there every weekend.

Jarrad Sibson, in your first year as skipper, I could see that you probably aged more this year that you had in your previous 20! But well done mate. You stepped up when others wouldn't and you took over in the toughest time for any captain to step up to the plate. That takes character and spirit, both qualities that you have in spades. Can't wait to have a few beers with you over winter, and for the Crows to take care of West Coast in Round 17.

Lachie Harris, thanks for the endless emails and phone calls to the association trying to save us points and money mate. Again, as a young bloke, you've probably had more headaches than hot dinners this season. But you've handled all without frustration and anger. Will be a shame if we lose your services next year. Cheers mate.

Steve Shearing, thanks for everything. Couldn't get through a season without you. Holly, Staff, Gards, Darty, you're all legends and your help is never taken for granted. See you ALL again next season.

As a coach, I wanted to see improvement, to create a culture amongst the top 2 teams of never giving in and to build a game plan of tough, competitive, ruthless cricket. 3rd Grade Report

Bentley Cricket Club lost one of its favourite sons on 8 March 2012, with the passing of Life Member, & former President, George Woodhead. George had been battling a rare form of cancer for some time, however the suddenness of his passing, left both family & friends, in shock.

George began his Bentley CC journey with his best friend, & fellow Mighty Blue, Tony Malins, in 1968. They had played football together at Wyong for Canning, and it seemed quite natural to play for the local cricket club as well. George was born with great leadership, & communication skills, & it was not long before he progressed through the Blues, both on & off the field. A very friendly, & gregarious person, George initially took on the presidency of the club's social committee. These were the wonderful days, of cabarets, car rallies, BBQ's & finishing off the keg with all your mates, the next morning. Bentley may not have been the most successful club in the competition in those days, but it was during this period that the club's current strong bonds of loyalty & mateship were forged.

Off the field, a bloke couldn't have had a better mate than George. As a group, we enjoyed not just cricket, but footy, golf, fishing, card nights, trots, dogs, holidays & so on. George was always there, & with his charismatic personality, everyone enjoyed his company.

On the field he played 231 games in our top 2 sides, of which he captained both for a total of 40 games. His wily off breaks took 524 wickets, including two 7 wicket hauls, & a hat-trick. George's batting was not unlike Glenn McGrath's, & would often cause some merriment amongst team mates in the sheds.

George served 3 years as Club President as well as many, many other years as a committee member. Perhaps his finest legacy is the work he did with Canning Football Club to co-ordinate the establishment of the Canning Sports Club.

George was last seen at the Club just 12 months ago, as we celebrated Lloyd Dungey's 500th game. He appeared fit & well, and was clearly enjoying life.

It is fair to say that the Club's current players stand tall, on the shoulders of Club giant's, like George.

George was survived by his much loved wife Barb, & a host of extended family.
