FROM THE PRESIDENT

PREMIERS & GRADE WINNERS

The 4th Grade had a sensational start to the season, winning their first seven games and finishing the qualifying rounds, with a 10 win / loss record and top spot on the ladder, 11 points clear of second place. Dave Narbey had a fantastic season with the ball and took 29 wickets at an average of 8.76 in the qualifying rounds. Dave's performances included 6/31 against Nedlands and the match figures of 8/39 (5/24 & 3/15) against Thornlie.

The stand-out batting performance in the season was without doubt Justin (Hollywood) Warren's 100 n.o. in round 5 against Grand Final opponents Hamersley Carine. Matt Harmer proved to be a consistent performer with the bat scoring 257 runs in 8 innings before winning promotion to the top side.

Paul (Fat Cat) Warren was superb in the field, he set a very high standard in what proved to be a tremendous fielding team. Paul won the fielding vote count for the side with 144 votes from 10 games and also for the Club overall with 170 votes.

In goes without saying the Team highlight for the season was the magnificent Grand Final victory over Hamersley Carine. In a hard fought game the overall strength of this team was too great a match for Hamersley Carine. The bowling and batting depth combined with unerring fielding paved the way for a 73 run win. Ken Dawson (56), Dion Wilkie (55) and Paul Warren (51) provided the majority of the runs, while Mark Lukan 4/19 and Kirk Spencer 5/38 crashed through the opposition batting. Kirk Spencer in his 50th game won "THE MAN OF THE MATCH AWARD" for his 5/38 and 31 runs.
