Our attendance and training format has helped to keep our skills sharp and players developing their games.

On the field, we had some challenges this year in the new format of the competition for all grades being a combination of 7 x 2 day and one day games during the year. New captains across the top 3 grades and some new faces down at the club helped to bring new energy in to the teams and get us going in the right direction.

Cricket Managers Report

Season 2016/17 commenced with Geoff Dart as Cricket Manager. Geoff had filled this role as well as Chairman of Selectors for several years. I thank Geoff for his efforts in the pre-season including training, recruitment of players and organising player contracts before work commitments took their toll and I attempted to fill his big shoes in the role.

One job I did not have this season was looking after any visiting English cricketers. I think the decision by committee to not pursue an overseas player was a good one. BCC should continue a policy of recruiting players from within the Perth region if top-up or specialist players are required for our newly promoted first grade team. This will be a more cost effective and reliable way to improve any perceived inadequacies.

Coaching staff and most Captains were in place when I commenced this position. I thank Steve Paice (8th grade) and Steve Shearing (1 dayers) for stepping up to fill those vital roles when requested, so close to season start.

Fab has done well in his second year as Club Coach and I thank him for that. Steve Cairns does much work for the club, but his role as Net Captain is very significant. Going forward I would suggest an Assistant Coach could help both Net Captain and Coach in further strengthening the structure of our training program.

Ron and Ned should be congratulated on the wicket preparations this season. To be granted the right to host a grand final by the Association is testament to how well the wicket played.

On the field, to get two sides (top two) into grand finals and 8th Grade into a semi, was an improvement on the previous season. The big improvement came from 9th Grade. Under Jay Smith's leadership they just missed the one day final and won their first two day game in three years and in the process won back the Chuck Berry trophy from South Perth. One major reason for the overall improvement came through having sufficient players to choose teams from each fixture. To this end, thanks should be extended to Brian Hayward as Chairman of Selectors.

Off the field the club has been well led by Holly and his committee who supported me well throughout the season. Looking forward to 2017/18, Captains should be appointed early, recruits approached early and all players encouraged to strive for premierships - that's what it is all about.

After being relegated back to 2nd grade and not investing in any overseas players and with an ageing list it was going to be interesting to see how the team would perform this season.

In saying that the club signed 3 young players, Matt Lockyer, Jarryd Kenna and Damon Sheppard all with plenty of talent.

Unfortunately Damon sustained a broken leg playing Ariel ping pong and was ruled out for the season. With Laurence Paice standing down as skipper I was looking forward to the challenge of captaining this very successful and proud club.

With a lot of rain early in the season the first game v Bassendean was a wash out.

Rd 2 v Tuart Hill was also rain affected to 27 overs each (Or so we thought) Tuart Hill won the toss and batted first hitting 9-140 of their 27 overs. Leading wicket takers were B Daye (3/34) and A Ghani (3-15). After leaving the field I was informed that we would only face 25 overs for a slow over rate with no warning during the innings. An absolute disgraceful decision.

After losing early wickets Paicey and Boon put on an 87 run partnership to get us to a winning position but unfortunately we just fell short and ran out of overs!!

Rd 3 v Fremantle away saw us bowl them out for 145. B. Daye 5/72 and H Shah 2/22 were the standouts with the ball. With some brilliant catching from Omo, Paicey and Boon. Once again we struggled with the bat late on day 1 being 4/18 overnight.

When Matt Lockyer was bowled out first ball the following Saturday the writing was on the wall and subsequently we were all out 74. Top score of 28 was B Daye.

Desperate for our first win we had a 1 day game at home against Doubleview Carine. Batting first in very hot conditions we lost two early wickets only to consolidate with Horan and Omo putting on a 113 run partnership and we ended 6/179 of our 40 overs. Horan 84 not out Omo 43.

Our bowlers then did the job dismissing DCCC for 143, Daye 3/25, Patel 2/18, Bart 2/14.

The next three games were Jekyll and Hyde performances. We bowled Vic Park out for 127, E Britton 5/16 outstanding and were skittled for 103. We then bowled Ocean Ridge out for 239 dropping 7 catches and chased it down 2/256. M Lockyer 109 not out, Omo 69 not out and (Horan the night watchman) 47.

Then a one day fixture against Applecross where we batted first and were all out 103. Applecross 4/107 cruised to victory.

So I am scratching my head trying to work us out.

Needing a win desperately we made a pack to beat the teams who had defeated us in the first fixture and we started against Fremantle round 8 in a 1 day game at Wyong. Batting first we hit 7/176, Horan 58 Lockyer a patient 29, Paicey a solid 31 and C Daw 25 not out.

Our bowlers were patient and fielding was very good with two run outs and a stumping. We eventually bowled them out for 153. Pick of the bowlers was Richie (H Shah) with 4/20.

First game after Christmas was a 1 day fixture against Curtain Vic Park away. With a sick daughter I could not play and the team was led brilliantly by Laurence Paice. We had the arrival of Ish Khan who was a breath of fresh air and has a brilliant and positive attitude towards his cricket.

Batting first Fab and Locks put on a 47 run opening stand and JK chipped in with a quick fire 21 at number 3. After losing a couple of quick wickets in the middle order Boon batted patiently for 43 taking the score to 7/188. H Shah 3/29 and the plan (Solanki 4/11) were outstanding. CVP all out 82.

Next on the revenge list was Applecross in a 2 day fixture. In hot conditions once again we batted first at home and put on 8/263. Horan 132 not out but more importantly Paicey with a very patient 50 when we were in trouble at 3-49 and Kenna with a solid 21 in even time. On a flat deck 263 was par so we needed to bowl and field well. Applecross started well and were 3/146 but some brilliant partnership bowling from Hiten 4/48 and Paice 3/18 saw us bowl them out for 185. Our fielding was outstanding and probably the difference.

Round 11 was a home game against a very good one day team Ocean Ridge. We batted first on a tricky deck. Locks with a solid 35, Paicey once again when needed 42 in the middle order and Tilbury with 21 valuable runs at the death steering us to 8/151 from 40 overs. With the best bat in the comp and an aggressive opener we needed early wickets and that we got. Ish Khan with the catch of the season to dismiss their Captain and opener started the rot and we skittled them for 97. The bowling was led by Ish Khan 4/20, S Patel 2/13, Locks 2/25 and Hiten 1/6.

Rd 12 was away to Bassendean and once again on a tough deck doing plenty we were once again in trouble at 2/21. Omo and Locks put on 59. Omo 33 and Locks 57 then we had good contributions from the middle order. Paicey 27, Boon 32, Kenna 47 giving us a total of 9/242 from our 80 overs.

Unfortunately Bassendean decided that 242 was too many to chase and didn't bother following the WASTCA rules or by laws and the game was the only fixture called off due to rain. We were once again cheated of an opportunity for victory.

Rd 13 was the grudge match against Tuart Hill after the heated Rd 2 fixture. Bowling first they got off to a good start and were 1/80 but once we got 1 wicket we applied the Bentley squeeze on them and a devastating spell from Ish Khan and master class left arm in swing bowling from Boon and controlled length bowling from Richie saw them all out for 141. Khan 5/21, Daye 3/56 and Shah 2/47.

141 was going to be a tricky total to chase especially against a quality bowling attack. After losing 2 for 1 Leigh Martin night watchman and Omo settled and we ended 2/13 overnight. We lost Leigh early week two and were 4/67 at one stage then 6/109 before Kenna 39 and Omo 62 saw us pass the score 7 down eventually all out 189. Another revenge scalp to the Blues.

Looking for an outright victory to try and secure top spot on the home and away ladder we decided to bowl first against DCCC. A long slow day we bowled them out for 144 on a good batting wicket and very slow outfield. Pick of the bowlers were Daye 5/57 and Shah 2/27.

After being in trouble early losing 5/27, JK and Boon batted patiently, Kenna 38 and Daye 58 not out with a lower order contribution from Leigh Martin with 12. We needed 11 to win with 1 wicket in hand. Hiten and Ish at the crease. DCCC needing 1 wicket to save relegation to 3 grade the boys got us over the line ending 9/146. Brendan saves the Daye!!

We finished 2nd on the table after the home and away season which was a good effort especially after our slow start. Our semifinal was against Tuart Hill who we had just beaten in Rd 13 and were seeking revenge. After a wet week and overcast conditions we won the toss and bowled first. Ish got an early caught and bowled then it was the Mr March show who else then Brendan Daye. In a spell that had to be seen to be believed Boon ripped through the Tuart Hill top and middle order claiming 7/32. Shah 1/23 and Ish 2/38 also bowled well. Tuart Hill all out 98.

Excellent fielding and catches from Omo, Leigh Martin and Fab Fanayan.

Fab and Locks got us off to a positive start 0/31 before locks was run out at the non-strikers end. Fab hit a solid 39 then contributions from Paicey 17, Lethal 18, JK 17, Tilbury 16 and Khan 14 saw us end up on 162.

Tuart Hill batted for 21 overs hitting 131 a lead of 65. We had 24 nervous overs to face and got the job done.

This took us into the GF against Applecross the minor premiers. After winning the toss and batting first we unfortunately left our worst performance for the big day and were all out 112. Simply not enough even with our bowling attack. Early on Sunday they passed the total, game over. A disappointing way to end the season especially after not dropping a game after Christmas but a very good effort to make the Grand final and achieve promotion back up to first grade.

It was a pleasure to Captain the side for the first time and a big thank you must go out to the coach Fab and the senior players, Paicey, Boon and Omo. Your help and support was greatly appreciated.

A big thank you to Cairnsy for running the nets.

To Justin Hollywood Warren and the committee thank you for your support throughout the season. You do a fantastic job.

To Karen and Gards for their work on game day doing the scoring. You both do a fantastic job and it is also greatly appreciated.

To Karen and Chris for doing the afternoon tea's brilliant work and great food. To Lesley for the hard work in the kitchen thank you and well done.

To the player's wives or girlfriends thank you for your support, I know it takes up a lot of time during the season. To the Curator Ned great work and thank you.

To the bar staff and helpers around the club thank you and hopefully we see you all back next season. Hopefully I have not forgotten anybody but if I did thank you.

Doing a pre-season is something that becomes harder and harder as the years' pass, so I had expected the phone call from P.C.Smith a few weeks before the season started was to remind me that training had started! Instead, it ended with me accepting the 8th grade captaincy – it is a job I have enjoyed immensely when I have done it previously so I was rapt to get the job. Due to me having to miss a few games, Geoff Dart become my loyal vice-captain and a guy on whom the side relied during the season. Darty, it was a pleasure having you by my side mate and it would have been great to get you that elusive flag!

Round 1 saw a washout against High Wycombe, and in Round 2 we tackled the competition trend-setters Applecross at Shirley Strickland, the first of three games we would play there during the season. We bowled and fielded very well, with young quick Matt Robson a standout and Cal McMulkin taking three wickets. 130 was very gettable, but we blew the chase, falling 10 runs short despite the best efforts of Glen Hewitt and Matt Harmer. 'Freighter' could have been a pillar of the top order, but injury caused this to be his only game for the season – this was a cruel blow to the side.

Weather played a part again in Round 3, as we posted a competitive 6/203 against Subi-Marist with Jamey Riches and Blair Chapman putting on 96 for the first wicket, the first of many strong contributions for these two reliable players. A team effort followed, but rain ruined the second week which left us with two draws from the first three games.

Round 4 was a must-win game against Murdoch-Melville, and they posted a very competitive 7/171 from their 40 overs. Youngster Tom Horan has a big future ahead of him, playing with poise that defies his youth – he took 3/44 in this game and showed an ability to vary his line and length and tie down and end with his off-spin. Jamey Riches and Leigh Martin anchored an even response, and we chased the runs with five wickets in hand, winning in the last over. In Round 5 we travelled to Tuart Hill and batted first, making 216. Tom Horan batted at 10, which in retrospect was a shocking call by the skipper as Tom made a composed, and sometimes classy 44 not out, putting on a tenth wicket stand of 45 with the ever-reliable Darren Leng. The side lost its way after a strong second wicket stand between Chappy and Darty, getting bogged down against what was really a weak opposition. Tuart Hill batted with patience in the chase, and despite us not doing much wrong they passed our score with four overs and three wickets in hand. Youngsters Robson and Horan performed well, but the side was at the crossroads with just one win from the first five rounds.

Round 6 saw our strongest performance for the year, as a very even bowling effort restricted Doubleview-Carine to 131. McMulkin, Leng, Ujay Bhan and Horan contributed well, and a dominant batting performance saw us pass the opponent score just two wickets down and bat for more than 80 overs in making 257. Chappy yet again did the job as an opener, and was fast becoming the most reliable bat in the team while Leigh Martin proved to be a class above the opposition as he made 62. It was going to be important to ensure this win wasn't a one-off, and a massive game against Balcatta followed the next week.

We batted first and amassed 7/248 from 40 overs, with a strong batting performance highlighted by 48 from Mike Vlismas, 44* from Tommy Horan and a whirlwind 28 from Jamie George. We lost two wickets in the first over of the innings, but the positivity in the batting ensured we were never really on the back foot. With the ball, Daniel Cheeseman and young Lachie Henderson were as quick as I have seen at this level, and despite some issues controlling the two-piece ball both performed very strongly and moved up the grades before too long. Both have a future as top grade players at the club, and should continue to go from strength to strength. Horan took four wickets and despite not bowling the opposition out, we were never challenged in a dominant performance.

A three-game stretch at Maniana followed, with Shelley Reserve undergoing a well-overdue facelift. We faced Subi-Marist in a one-dayer, and bowled and fielded poorly as they made 7/214. Aside from Ujay and Jamie George, this was a poor effort and we were soon 4/51, 6/74 and 8/129 in reply. Cometh the hour, cometh the man – Cal McMulkin is as consistent a cricketer as I have played with recently, but what he did with the bat in this game was something special. Despite a rising run-rate and virtually no hope, he hit the ball in the middle of the bat time after time and with Ujay, put on 88 runs off 61 balls to win us the game in amazing circumstances. This ranked to be as good a win as I have been involved in during my 19 years at the club – we were down and almost out before Cal and Ujay took over. Winning this game gave the side a massive confidence and we headed to Xmas in style, smashing Tuart Hill by 8 wickets behind class bowling from Tom Horan and a swashbuckling 81* from Jamey Riches, who put on 114 unbeaten runs with Blair Chapman, the highest partnership in the grade for the season.

The first game after the break was a bad sign of things to come, as the batting crumbled under pressure. We restricted the opposition to 151, led by the universally underrated bowling of Stevie Daye who took four wickets before succumbing to cramp after a marathon spell. Mitch Duncan, Bhan and Cheeseman bowled well without luck as they proved to be too good to find the edge of the bat. This should have been a simple chase against a poor side, but the batting wilted with just one player tallying double figures as we made just 70. The sooner we left the ground, the better on this occasion.

The next week saw a one-dayer against Doubleview, with a win crucial to solidify our spot in the finals. We were miles better than the opposition, and Mitch and Ujay were able to restrict them to 6/22 with an opening spell that would have destroyed much better batsmen. The opposition avoided total embarrassment and took the game past tea, but only by a handful of overs as the openers chased the runs without loss in less than 20 overs. To put our dominance in perspective - we flew across the road to the Carine Tavern to see the third over of the Perth Scorchers final, a game that started at 4:20pm.

Our first clash with High Wycombe had been rained out and they were a game ahead of us in second spot on the ladder, so any chance we had of competing for a home semi-final relied on us winning. They batted first, and showed patience above all else as they ground out 210 on a very slow outfield. Ujay Bhan took 3/48 from 23 high-class overs, toiling away in oppressive conditions and proving he was the spearhead of this attack. Unfortunately, Darty suffered a hamstring injury late in the day, ruling him out of the one-day Grand Final the next day.

For this Grand Final, we travelled to Shirley Strickland again, where Applecross won the toss and batted first, moving to 3/147 with ease. Enter P.C.Smith and Mike Vlismas, who bowled brilliantly in tandem to trigger a collapse of 7/24 and we were left chasing a very gettable 171. Unfortunately, we were never in the chase compiling just 78. The lack of application against a very good bowling side would come back to haunt us on more than one occasion later in the season.

The first time was against High Wycombe, where we fought hard and batted for more than 50 overs but failed to get close, finishing with just 87. A handful of players made double-figures, but none passed 15 – the bowling was again consistent rather than outstanding, but we were a fair way behind the top two sides and left with a fight on our hands to play finals.

Things got no easier as we faced Applecross again in a two-dayer, batting first and fighting for a full day in squeezing out a score of 130. Chappy batted for most of the innings in oppressive conditions, once again showing the application the rest of us lacked while youngster Michael Dawson showed some of his quite considerable natural talent in a short, impressive innings. The tail fought hard, but the WASTCA heat policy meant that the game finished in a draw – we were none the wiser as to whether we had improved against the top two sides.

In the week before the Applecross game, Cal McMulkin was injured playing indoor soccer and subsequently needed a full knee reconstruction after tearing his ACL. This was a cruel blow for such a vibrant teammate and critical team member, and Cal's loss was felt as the season went on.

In the final game of the regular season, we faced off against Murdoch-Melville with a reasonably simple equation – win and we finish third, lose and we might sneak into fourth but could just as well miss out altogether. To lose and miss finals would have been a brutal blow, and Murdoch won the toss and batted first and were 3/166 midway through the third hour which meant we were staring down the barrel of 300+. We turned the game around, dismissing them for 215 as Mike Vlismas bowled an outstanding spell in very hot conditions. The chase was all too familiar unfortunately, with plenty of batsmen getting a start but none going on with it other than the evergreen Justin Warren, who played a lone hand in striking 44 not out to reaffirm his well-deserved status as a big game player. Luckily Applecross did us a favour, smashing Subi-Marist which meant we finished fourth and would take on Applecross in the semi-final. We deserved our spot in the finals, and went into the semi-final with an experienced, skilled team that knew what was needed in a big game.

We won the toss and batted, with Jamey Riches and Blair Chapman starting well before Chappy and Sibbo went in close succession. Myself and Jamey then put on 50, getting to a position of strength and control before a woeful umpiring decision turned the game. I am not one to bash umpires, but let's call this what it was – a terrible decision by a sub-par official. A team like Applecross jumps on every chance in a game, and they turned the pressure on the middle and lower order and we quite simply weren't up to the task. Jamey was gallant, striking 53 and proving he has a massive future at the club – with a bit more luck he could have had that many at first drinks, as his clean ball striking was foiled only by a very good fielding side. We scrambled to 114, and knew that we need to create chances and put the batting side and umpires under pressure. Unfortunately, despite lion-hearted performances by Mitch, Ujay and Vlissy we were unable to make inroads and lost by seven wickets; to keep Applecross out there for 53 overs showed great heart, but ultimately, we were a level below the top two sides all season and this result proved as much.

Veterans like Vlissy, Hollywood and Damo Hewitt all showed glimpses of the talent, class and toughness we have come to know and it was great to have those older heads to bounce ideas off.

To Jay Smith, you have done an outstanding job as skipper but also carrying a massive burden on the Committee and I hope your work is appreciated by all, as it was by me. To Timmy Horan, the GF result was a shame but congrats for taking us back to 1st grade mate and I hope you stick around to take us back to premiership glory. To my old mate, Timmy D'Souza, it gutted me to see you lose the GF knowing how much this meant to you but come back stronger next season man – if anyone deserves to captain a flag at Bentley, it's you!

I was humbled, privileged and honoured to be asked to lead this side at such a great club and I hope I did the position justice – it was shattering to lose at the semi-final side again, but I know that every bloke in that side walked off the ground having given all they could and there is not much more you can ask than that.

What does a 'successful' season look like?

As we reflect on the season that was, I am drawn to last season's summary of the 4th team. For the second time in as many seasons we were going to be demoted on the back of a bottom two finish, player numbers were poor and putting eleven on the field each Saturday was the biggest challenge the team faced. Ironically, lacking five bowlers was one of our main weaknesses. I foreshadowed that, "demotion next season will not be a great improvement to our prospects."

What a contrast to season 2016/17.

It was a season of unimagined highs and all-too familiar lows, at round 6 we were bottom of the ladder and unbackable, before putting on a 4-game streak and regaining the Chuck Berry trophy in our first 2 day win since 2013/14. Some of the cricket played around Christmas was simply brilliant. Our bowling in those one-dayers was exemplary as we defended modest targets of around 150 against top batting sides. Then a disastrous loss to bottom team Murdoch in a 2-dayer ruled us out of finals contention. We finished 2 wins and hefty percentage outside the 4, but a 5-7 record meant we finished 5th and avoided relegation.

The dramatic revival of fortune for the team can be placed firmly at the feet of the fresh talent that blossomed this season, and the old hands that performed match-winning cameos.

Mobin Matthew scored 34 runs last season @ 8.50. This season he made 229 @ 25.44, winning the average award in what can only be described as a remarkable transformation. He was instrumental in anchoring our innings on multiple occasions when the rest of the order fell over. None more so than his 51 against Bassendean out of a team total of 153 when 'extras' was the next highest scorer.

Josh Ericson put in some mighty performances opening the batting, taking home the aggregate award and anchoring the innings on several occasions as well. Josh was the best pick of the fielders, rarely dropping a catch and taking out the award by a comfortable margin. His new ball bowling produced 16 wickets and a bevy of dropped catches he can recall with vivid imagery.

Andrew Stace, third generation Bentley Cricketer, new ball weapon, exuberant fielder, hard hitting bat, and all-round self-proclaimed flog made an indelible impact on the team and is the deserved winner of the bowling aggregate, taking 19 @ 18.95. His ability to take key wickets in tight games was match-winning on more than one occasion and his presence added great spice on and off the field.

Old hands Chris Lockyer and PC Smith both had great performances throughout the year. Chris' full-toss wicket balls that begun the rot against South Perth to win us the Chuck Berry was one of his finest spells this season, and the great job he and PC did in the middle overs of the one day games to dry up the scoring created so much pressure that most middle orders simply collapsed in pursuit of our modest targets with the overs dwindling away.

Winning the toss 10/13 times certainly served us well in the one-dayers as our batting gave us something to bowl at. However, in the two-dayers we only put in one glowing performance with the bat, making 9/248 against Swan Athletic. I don't include the Chuck Berry win as a 'great' performance with the bat, for reasons that can be read about elsewhere. Batting out 72 overs is something that needs to be improved on next season, we only won a single 2 day game in 2016/17.

There were match-winning performances from the likes of Cam McNab, Kieran Smith, Jesse Liddle, Shaminda Sumanasinghe and others to add to the names above. I hope to see all of them return next year to give the 4th team some serious depth. Derryn Rive did a marvellous job in the field, whether wearing the gloves or not, he picked up an average 8.60 votes per game he played - not enough to win the fielding trophy - but a higher average than anyone else in the club.

Most captains define a successful season by making the top 4 and playing finals. So do I. But next season if the numbers hold up in the top grades and we continue to unearth talented cricketers in the squad, success is just around the corner for the 4th team 'Battler' Blues.

The 10th Dave Berry game between Bentley and South Perth was always going to be a hotly contested affair with the overall tally at 5-4 to Bentley and crucial points on offer to push for a spot in the top 4 in 9th grade.

The Bentley 4's were running hot too, putting three wins together from the last 3 games with South Perth winless since November. This would be the Bentley 4's best chance of winning a 2 dayer for the first time since 2013/14.

On a notoriously hot day Lizzie did not smile up on captain Smith and South Perth elected to bat. Chris Lockyer was wearing the #503 shirt as he was thrown the new ball for the first time all year. After a superb display of slow, accurate, swing bowling with the full toss wicket ball Lockyer had claimed 3/8 off 7 overs. Stace at the other end up the hill and into the breeze took a reaching C&B to have 1/18 off his 6. When Ericson was the sole appellant for the snick of captain Snow, the umpire was sympathetic and South Perth were 5/32.

A 33 run partnership then ensued between Best and Salter before deRozario pinged a throw to McNab who eventually found the stumps for a run out. Captain Smith then brought himself on and took 1/8 off his 7 before another run out from K Smith at fine leg saw the score at 8/69. The last 2 wickets were taken by Sumanasinghe bowling his confounding spin, 2/8 off 5 and South Perth were dismissed for a total of 83.

Captain Smith was determined if Bentley batted their overs they would win. He proceeded to install himself no. 1 in the batting order and faced the South Perth attack. Captain Snow led from the front too, opening the attack and claiming the wicket of Ericson nicking behind on day 1. Sumanasinghe was put in at no. 3 for his defensive abilities and playing some very dry cricket Bentley got to stumps on day 1 at 1/25 off 23 overs, a mere 59 runs short of victory.

Week 2 was again a hot affair but the day did not go per script, Sumanasinghe LBW to another wicket ball full toss at the score of 31. This brought Matthew to the wicket who was summarily barbecued by Smith before Smith himself gloved one and walked, the 121 minute resistance yielding just 12 runs. K Smith was at the other end watching the carnage get worse as Liddle was bowled and the score line was on life support at 5/35, Bentley had lost 4/4 and the 84 run target looked far way indeed.

No. 7 bat Khan fell to the swing of Snow, caught behind and the score was 6/45. Stace swiped at a wide one nicking off having survived some close LBW shouts and the card read 7/65. The dire situation called for a Donald Trump inspired move, 'Let's Build A Wall.'

Into the cauldron strode McNab. A masterclass of concentration and hawk-like ball watching ensued. K Smith steadied at the other end before hitting the winning runs, a boundary pulled in front of square. A 3-wicket win chasing 84 was not what either team expected at the start of the day's play.

Captain Snow finally took himself off bowling, having bowled a marathon 24 over spell to get his team so close to the most unlikely of victories.

Some South Perth players were anticipating an early finish, the likely time being tea. Bentley was having none of that. K Smith and McNab settled down into a powerful partnership, taking advantage of the second and third string attack to flay boundaries in front and behind the wicket. K Smith went to 5 o'clock drinks at 91 and although all Bentley players were under order not to tell him his score, South Perth could see it in the score book and wasted no time in telling him all about it the moment play resumed. Some tense overs ensued but Smith got to his ton pulling a short one behind square to bring up the 100 with a boundary. He holed out to square leg a few overs later, a total of 106 and a partnership of 106 breaking the Bentley 4th team 8th wicket record.

But there was one last chapter in the day, as Captain Smith informed South Perth that one more wicket would bring stumps.

deRozario came to the crease and McNab hit out, the final wicket hadn't come as the last over of the day was bowled by Snow, some boundary side yelling informing McNab he was 5 short of his maiden half century.

The last over was something to behold, deRozario almost coming back for the 2 but McNab sent him back to the non-strikers ensuring with one ball to go he needed a boundary to bring it up. The heaved slog to long on was deflected off the bounce but it got over the rope somehow and celebrations ensued.

Bentley finished the day 8/215 after South Perth used all 12 bowlers including an over from the keeper with pads still donned. Without a doubt the Chuck Berry medallist was Kieran Smith who got Bentley out of a big hole and brought up his second ton. McNab had the best batting performance of his career to date, sureing up the innings when the end was looming all too swiftly. The Chuck Berry trophy was regained by Bentley and the all-time score line 6-4 to BCC.
