#### **EDITORIAL**

In addition, the blend of experienced players like Geoff Farrall, Steve King, John Williams etc gives this team the balance it needs to remain competitive.

In these objectives the club has been very successful - this being due to the efforts of a very-committed management committee and the support of members of BCC. In closing, I would like to congratulate all players who achieved personal milestones and personal best performances during the season, especially Lloyd Dungey on playing his 300th game. I would also like to thank each and every committee member for their superb effort and support throughout the season, and congratulations to all trophy winners.
