

In addition, the blend of experienced players like Geoff Farrall, Steve King, John Williams etc gives this team the balance it needs to remain competitive.

In these objectives the club has been very successful - this being due to the efforts of a very-committed management committee and the support of members of BCC. One can never lose sight of the fact that it is an expensive business to run a cricket club and the participation of most members in all our fund raising activities was appreciated.

What for the future? Bentley must continue to strive to better itself and improve on recent playing performances. Recruitment of specific strength players is a priority and must be attended to early by the new committee. In conjunction with this, it is also vital that we retain all players from the current season (myself excepted) so that the core developed this year is around to further develop in 1993/94.

In closing, I would like to congratulate all players who achieved personal milestones and personal best performances during the season, especially Lloyd Dungey on playing his 300th game. I would also like to thank each and every committee member for their superb effort and support throughout the season, and congratulations to all trophy winners.
