Coaching Staff Reports

As I assess the 2005/06 season the main thing I can see is a lot of development. I think of the many challenges the coaching team had to overcome this season and I can see a lot of positives for 2006/07. There were lessons to be learnt, but we have done that and we have begun putting plans in place to ensure we move forward in time for the coming season.

When I was first appointed to the position I made a list of possible x-players we could contact, to fill spots in our lower sides due to unavailability. With about two weeks to go in the pre-season I threw that list out, as we had to start thinking of options to find the abundance of players we had training a game. There were 89 players to wear the Baggie Blue this season, with another 22 who trained regularly during the pre-season but did not play a game, and of course we can't forget Trev. That's 112 players over the season!

One of the things that I am most proud of the coaching team is that there was only 22 people decided not to stay. It's a great reflection on the club and what we have to offer, that so many players stayed and worked through the "Rotation Policy" and it's something that will not be forgotten next season when we have our 6th side.

If you look at ladder positions then 1st Grade went from 7th to 9th this season and, as has been said, we went backwards. I won't argue with that, as I have told the players many times this season, you finish on the ladder where you deserve to finish. I will, however, ask you all to look at the development of the side, the changes in personnel and the changes to the coaching structure and I will ask you to understand that sometimes you have to take a step backwards, to take that step forwards.

Michael Scholefield, Tim Woodruff, Brendan Daye, Shaun Kelly, Stuart McKenna, Stuart Hartley and Geoff Dart all played their first 1st Grade games for the club this season. It is not an excuse to say players need time to develop and learn to play together, but with 4 of the above players included in the first game for the season, it was always going to be a test as to how we went. We failed the test and unfortunately we didn't find the right mix for most of the season and it cost us any chance of being a part of the finals. Now, what would be an excuse would be to say we would still need time next season to get it right, but I can guarantee you that won't be happening. The coaching team will work hard over the off-season and the players will work even harder in the pre-season and we will get it right before the first game begins.

Our 3rd, 5th & 7th Grade teams all had success this season. Even though we didn't win the premierships we thought we could, it's still a successful season to play in the finals and we shouldn't forget the positives we had over the season. The highlight was obviously 7th Grade's one day premiership over the typically confident Whitfords, but the improvement shown in both 7th & 9th Grade sides was one of the biggest positives of the season for me.

The most improved side of the season was without doubt our 9th Grade. It was really disappointing not to be playing in either final, but it was just as satisfying to see us improve to at least be in contention well into the New Year. It's about taking steps and we've certainly taken some big steps this season both as individuals and as a team. With another team coming in next season, it's important we continue to develop and improve and set a good standard for them to follow.

The season itself was a successful one as we achieved a lot of the goals we set. But we can improve and I am confident that we can achieve all of our goals, if we are prepared to work that much harder and commit to each other 100%.

Thanks to the committee for being willing to take a risk in me. I hope I have done an acceptable job in your eyes and we can take another step together next season. Thanks to everyone who helped out over the season, Len in the kitchen, Shane George & Stew Jeffery's with the interclub one-day game, Steve Paice, Michael Scholefield, & Geoff Dart with the Twenty20 days, Simon Magill with the bus trip. Thanks to Stafford Dawson, Colin Carnichan, Steve Shearing, Ace and Brian Hayward, Keith Chapman and Peter Smith for your non-stop support and advice. A big thanks to the Captains for standing by me all season, as I'm sure at times it wasn't easy.

To my Assistant Coach/Chairman of Selectors Graeme Verco, thank you for pretty much everything, from your knowledge and attention to detail in all of your responsibilities, to just keeping me sane. You were there every step of the way and I am really looking forward to what we can achieve together in the future.

Third Grade - Report

In reflecting on the 05/06 season that has just passed I remind myself of the goals that were set at the beginning of the season: to make the finals then win a premiership flag and assist first grade in reaching their goals. We did make the finals which was a great achievement but fell short of winning the flag. Many people have said that this will provide the fuel for winning next year. Although that is the case a Grand Final loss the previous year should have been motivation enough for this year. In fact we were a step further back by being knocked out at the semi final stage. The first grade did avoid relegation but again this was achieved last season and there weren't any serious threats made on making the final four.

There were a number of players missing from the previous season's final side (9) and it is a credit to all the players that took the step up from playing fifth grade to establish themselves as third grade players. In the first half of the season we had 3 losses (from 6 games) and suffered from major unforced team changes (up to 6 players per game). The side managed to settle somewhat after Christmas and a 4 game winning streak was enough to put us into finals.

Some of the highlights of the season for me were the tight win that we achieved playing at Wyong against High Wycombe in Matt Harmer's 200th game for the club. The following week Matt scored his first century for the club in yet another close win against eventual premiers Swan Valley. Beating Whitfords at McDonald Park is always satisfying especially when there is a finals spot on the line for both sides.

Although it means that you are losing a quality player it is pleasurable to see guys get promoted into the club's number one side. Matt Harmer, Jos Welsh, Brendan Daye, Steven Paice, Justin Warren, Geoff Dart and Stuart Hartley were all able to make this step on the back of good performances in third grade. Tony Magill, Glenn Hewitt, Stewart Jefferys and Damien Hewitt also made useful contributions with the bat throughout the season. Dave Barry, Matt Harmer, Brad Fleet and Damien Hewitt were all consistently good at the bowling crease. Geoff Dart and Dave Barry set the standard in the field.

The support I have received this year once again has been tremendous. The president Steve Shearing and his committee have simply made things happen. First time coach Justin Warren has been amazing in the way he has grown into his role and the work load he has taken on. All the captains and selectors worked well together in the tough job of selecting sides. Within the team I had my Vice Captain in Jos Welsh who contributed in many ways and this was all much appreciated. With Jos's first team duties there were some others that stepped into the VC role - Justin Warren, Steven Paice, Dave Barry and Damien Hewitt.

The 27 players that played in 3rd Grade this year are the people I also have to thank and the reason why I continued captaining each week. Whether it is the attempt at facial hair growth to avoid a fine or bringing down a spectator to collect a rebate it is the enjoyment element that makes it special. The camaraderie and attitude of the players meant that the time spent together out in the sun or having a beer in the change rooms after the game was fun and keeps us coming back.

Fifth Grade - Report

The season for 5th Grade that culminated in a semi-final loss was nothing short of being both satisfying, yet frustrating. By this I mean that whilst we proved to some opposition teams our right to be in the finals, to others (and sometimes, to ourselves) we showed our lack of commitment to individual goals and team and club objectives. We certainly had some this year, but I believe we did not have enough for our calibre of cricket, and when they were needed most (as in the semi-final), they were only partially delivered.

To harp on critically, however, would be to do an injustice to the positive aspects of the season, with each match providing highlights of individual efforts contributing to team performance. At an individual level, the bowling efforts of Jamie Hendry (32 wickets), myself (33 wickets) and Jamie George (11 wickets late in the season) were worthy notables. With the bat, the chief contributors being Jamie Hendry (281 runs @ 28.10), Paul "Fat Cat" Warren (208 runs @ 34.67) and Teddy Thomas (206 runs @ 20.60).

The specific performances that for me, signify all that was inspired about our year were most definitely:

- myself and Simon Retallack's unbeaten 77-run 10th wicket partnership that got us over the line and completely demoralised a fired-up Wembley Districts,
- Jamie Hendry's 'big' hauls of 6 for 53 (vs High Wycombe), 7 for 35 (vs Freo/Mosman Park, 2nd innings) and 6 for 55 (vs Balcatta),
- Teddy Thomas and Steve "Dutchy" Henshall's 112-run partnership against Swan Valley (with Teddy scoring his 2nd century for the club and the only one for the side all year),
- Paul "Fat Cat" Warren's magnificent 90 versus Balcatta,
- Teddy Thomas and Jamie George's 52-run partnership against Applecross that took us from 6 for 112 to 7 for 164 and ultimately, from impending defeat to glorious victory, and
- beating Applecross in the final game to make the finals, with Wade "Swimmer" McKay and Timmy "Passions" D'Souza getting the required runs for victory in my 100th game.

Credit must also be given to the 'core' players in the side this year - Shane Amato, Tony "Ice-Tea" Groube, Chris Pritchard, Jamie Hendry, Chris "Asian" Scott, Tim "Passions" D'Souza, Teddy Thomas, Pete "PC" Smith and to those others who either featured in the latter part of the year or intermittently throughout such as Paul "Fat Cat" Warren, Stew Jefferys, Jamie George, Steve Shearing and Ed "Wilbur" Daquino - my thanks to you all and to anyone else who took the field for 5th Grade this year.

But for them, and for all others who came so close to tasting sweeter success for 5th Grade, or in any Grade for that matter this year, consider this: have a think about your own performances, your own contributions and efforts and ask yourself what the major disappointments were for you as an individual and where you feel you could have added more to the team. Whatever the answers may be, use those disappointments as a starting point for your focus at training next year, or as motivation to improve by x%, or as fuel to work hard so you can say "I know where I went wrong, and I've done everything I can to become a better cricketer, a better club-man, and a better person".

To Justin "Hollywood" Warren, thanks for being a good friend and a fantastic coach in your first year in the job - you have, and will, continue to achieve great things at the helm of our club. Trying to take over the captaincy from you this year was like putting on shoes ten sizes too big - they could never be filled, as you are, and will remain, one of the best captains to ever lead 5th Grade in the history of that side.

On a personal note, I had already indicated throughout the season my indefinite retirement from cricket. It doesn't really sadden me that I was never able to win a Premiership whilst at the Club - that is not what I'll remember about playing cricket at Bentley. What I will remember is the good times on the field, the great times off the field, but most importantly, I'll remember the lifelong bonds of friendship I made with a bunch of terrific blokes forged in sweat, tears, and a nice cold beer at the end of a day's play. Go the mighty Bentley Blues, forever.

Ninth Grade - Report

A very disappointing season in the end that promised so much and delivered so little. We were only out of the 4 twice – after the first and last games of the season.

This team won 6 of 14 games, although this only included 2 of 7 one day games. Our performances in the 2 day format were strong, but in the end, our inability to win one day games cost us a place in the finals. This is highlighted by the fact that we lost 2 one day games by 2 runs and 3 runs when we were in seemingly unlosable positions. The other disappointing aspect was the fact that we lost our last 6 games of the season.

Three things stand out for me from the season just passed:

- This team lacked a core of players around which the season could be built. This reflected the coaching team desire to operate a rotation policy whereby all persons at the Club played cricket on a rotating basis. In all, this side had 34 players participate in 9th grade games this season, with only two persons playing in all 14 games. Although not necessarily impacting on the competitiveness of the team throughout the season, this lack of continuity of core players certainly impacted on our ability to win at crucial times throughout the season.
- Our batting skills were again shown to be deficient. We only bettered the Club and team target of 150 runs on five occasions and only two players aggregated more than 200 runs for the season. This indicates that batsmen do not place a high enough value on their wicket and are content to continue to play unwarranted “big” shots that gets them out. Unfortunately, undisciplined batting in the nets at training was often indicative of the approach taken in matches.
- We did unearth some new young talent who, hopefully, will be a part of the Bentley scene for a number of years to come. I refer specifically to Gary Mullins, Simon Cleary and Owen Conley. Joshua Nairn and Dave Randolph matured as bowlers with some ability and Colin Durham matured as a number 3 batsman.

Notwithstanding the above, the season was an enjoyable one and one that the Club as a whole can learn from. My thanks to all 34 players who participated this year, with special thanks to Steve Cairns and Lloyd Dungey for their assistance during the year. A very special thanks to Helen Cairns, Jenny Conley and Mark Conley for their assistance during the year and to the other wives, girlfriends and various spectators during the year who helped us with afternoon teas and generally supported us when possible.

In closing, the season was not a successful one (in that we didn't play finals cricket) and we can do better. I will be back next season and look forward to seeing you all back to finally win the premiership that we aspire to win.
