## EDITORIAL

The end of the 1977/78 season marked the end of Bentley's 25th year as a club. Unfortunately, our teams' performances on the field weren't good enough to make our Silver Jubilee celebrations particularly notable. Nevertheless, although our three sides each failed to make the finals, there were several promising features to emerge from the Bentley sides' efforts on the field.

The top side, although relegated, were not disgraced. Their position on the ladder far from reflects their performances in matches. After they won their first game quite comfortably, they failed to win another match yet were in a winning position on no fewer than six occasions. Maybe this reflects the team's inability to lift under pressure, but I rather think that luck, which plays such a big part in cricket, turned against our A Grade side this season. Captain-coach, GRAHAM VERCO, certainly had an unhappy initiation to Suburban Turf cricket, but his performances with the bat showed that he will play a big part in the Bentley revival that we all hope for next year. Another satisfying aspect which makes our prospects more promising next year, is the number of young players who have been blooded this season. The form shown by PETER QUARTERMAINE and KEN HOCKING suggests that our batting will have a degree of depth that has been often lacking in the past. The bowling this season was steady but far from penetrating, especially when compared with sides in the past, but the potential shown by JIM LEINASARS suggests that he could develop into valuable pace bowler. No doubt the bowlers will appreciate playing in a lower grade next year as they won't have the likes of Gillies, Marose, Pecker and Kickett to contend with. The aforementioned players, together with experienced and capable campaigners such as BRIAN HAYWARD, STU RANKIN and LLOYD DUNGEY should provide the nucleus of a side which is capable of lifting Bentley back into A Grade.

Our second side, after looking final round contenders throughout the season, didn't quite measure up when the moment of truth arrived. It was a big disappointment, especially for GEORGE WOODHEAD who captained the side for the bulk of the season. Given the same players next season, this team is capable of making up for their disappointment. There were some fine individual performances with both bat and ball that were more than pleasing. Collectively, KEN RITCHIE, BILL HARPER, TONY MALINS, PETER ROACH, LLOYD DUNGEY and JOHN WILLIAMS scored 1033 runs at an average of 21, whilst GEORGE WOODHEAD, TONY MALINS, LAURIE PRICE and JOHN WILLIAMS took 109 wickets at an average of 11.7. These statistics show that there is the basis of a highly competitive side for next season.

The efforts of our third side in winning half their games when they could never field the same side from week to week was highly commendable. Once again, GEOFF FARRALL carried the bowling almost single handed (how he must long for a genuine quickie to be operating from the other end!) but the batting performances were more evenly spread. In this latter department, newcomers BRIAN BOATER and JOHN HAM each had a fine debut season, whilst more experienced players such as JOHN ATSON and KEITH CHAPMAN lent solid support. Given two things, stability and a paco bowler, our number three side would be formidable opposition to most 5th Grade sides next season.

Off the field, the season can be regarded as a success. The committee had two priorities this season. The first was to upgrade the playing and training conditions we have had to endure in the past. With the relaying of the pitches and the improvements to the surrounds of the practice nets this objective has been more than partially achieved. It is only to be hoped that the association will now allocate Bentley a game each round on our home ground. The second priority was to provide the members with a more varied social calendar. Judging by the favourable comments received from those in attendance at these functions (especially from the ladies) this aim was satisfactorily achieved. The highlights were, no doubt, the canoe day, the Christmas dinner, the car rally (despite the weather), the golf night and the double wicket.

Finally a word about the current financial position of the club. The above objectives cost considerable money with little outlay for the club member. Without the bingo nights and the untiring efforts of the committee Bentley could be well and truly in the red. Next season there may have to be an increase in fees (inflation catches up with all!) and, no doubt, the new committee will be looking for the support of all members in fund raising activities.
