From The President

Season 2001/02 loomed as an exciting one for the club with the signing of a star recruit in Hudson Trevenen, a revamped coaching structure, and the acquisition of a turf wicket at Harold Rossiter Reserve. The club had it's sight firmly set on gaining promotion to 1st Grade to coincide with our 50th Anniversary next year.

History will show this season to be a disappointing one. Not only was the club unsuccessful in achieving it's major objective, it failed to win a premiership. In many respects however, this outcome does not reflect the effort put in to what was otherwise a very competitive performance by most grades.

The club, in my opinion, fielded it's most powerful 'A' team in many years which was superbly captained by Hudson. An indifferent batting performance in the semi finals cost the side a finals berth and the opportunity to gain promotion. The lessons learnt this year and the new talent unearthed in the top side augers well for the future. Our second and third sides (4th & 5th Grades) narrowly missed the final four. Lack of consistency and the inability to win those crucial games cost these sides dearly. The 6th Grade was competitive all year and the 7th Grade struggled with just two wins for the season.

The efforts of the coaching team, superbly led by Brian Hayward and well supported by Steve Shearing and Hudson Trevenen, must be recognised and applauded. A vote of thanks also goes to Cricket Manager, Greg Dart, first year Chairman of Selectors, Steve Henshall and Nets Captain Staffy Dawson for their tireless efforts over the season.

Off the field the club faced a very trying and challenging year. The shock theft of club funds prior to the start of the season left us in a very precarious situation. However, this did not deter the strong 'spirit' of the mighty Bentley Blues. Life members and club stalwarts rallied to the cause, strong fund raising support from all members and supporters and strong support from Sponsors ensured the club was able to pursue it's goals and finish the season in a satisfactory financial position.

The tireless efforts of committee members, Stewart and Natalie Jefferys, Steve Shearing, Greg Dart, Steve Cairns and Tony Magill must be acknowledged. Other club supporters who contributed strongly over the season include Jo Sheppard, Latoya, Lesley Magill (Quiz Nite), Kirk Spencer and Warren Blake. New committee members are desperately needed to ensure a successful 50th Anniversary season.

Next season marks the club's 50th Anniversary in what promises to be a huge year. The club's history and pride will be on display. Success on the field is paramount and winning premierships become a priority. The club's executive with the coaching team will be doing a lot of hard work off-season to ensure the club remains a formidable force capable of winning flags. A separate 50th Anniversary planning sub-committee has been set up to make sure next season is a memorable one.

I look forward to a successful 50th Anniversary season and the celebrations that go with it.

Looking back on season 2001/02 I now consider it a rebuilding time for Bentley's 5th Grade. If we'd said at the start of the season that only 3 players from last years premiership 12 would play more than 5 games, with a new and untried captain, a mid range finish would have been a reasonable result. So to be 5th and still in with a chance coming into the last game of the year, with a number of players showing they have what it takes to be mainstream contributors, I predict some good times ahead.

As a captain I have learnt more this year than any other year as a player and I know I will be better for the experience. For my team, I can only hope that what I saw from a promising 5th Grade squad will also progress and together we will become a side that takes that next step.

Individual performances are always rewarded at the end of the season, but I would like to thank everyone who played 5th Grade this year for their hard work and effort and mostly for standing by me and always giving me 100% regardless of what I asked.

Unfortunately, there is not a lot to say about our batting this year. We made over 200 runs only 3 times as a side and only 6 batsmen passed 50 once each. Our tail stood tall in all bar 1 game, but in general, our batting let us down not only individually, but in partnerships as well. We had only one partnership over 100, against Shenton Park where Steve Withnell (34) and myself (96) put on 106 for the 4th wicket and only 9 fifty run stands all year. But as they say, behind every dark cloud there is a silver lining and even our disappointing year with the bat had some very good individual performances.

My 96 versus Shenton Park was our highest score for the year and Glen "Freighttrain" Hewitt's 72 versus Applecross was a superb knock. Jos Welsh made 56 against Swanbourne with his one and only innings for the season and Jamie George smashed Hamersly Carine around for 54 off only 25-30 odd balls in the last game of the year. But there was none better (possibly no better innings I have ever seen) than Andrew "Beags" McLevie's 83no versus Balcatta. At 7/36 chasing 115 for victory, Beags showed tremendous concentration and shot selection to win the game off his own bat. With an 8th wicket partnership of 57 with Dean Scott (15) we were eventually all out for 160.

I topped the runs this year with 254 at 25.40, but our most consistent batsman was without question Stewart Jefferys. His 216 runs at 19.64 may not hit the record books, but when we were losing 3-4 wickets while having to face the last 15-20 overs of the day, Stewy showed the mental toughness required to become a great 5th Grade opening bat. He had partnerships of 92 against Swanbourne for the 5th wicket with Jos and 81 against Hamersly Carine for the 2nd wicket with Jamie and he capped off his good year with 51 (his first 50 for 5th Grade) in the same game. Stewy and myself were the only two to make over 200.

Our fielding was of a standard well above 5th Grade level, but I will not single out individuals because it would take too long and I would not want to leave anyone out.

Our bowling this season was always of a very high standard. We went for over 200 only once and I put that down to our one bad day in the field more than with the ball. Our main strike bowlers Jamie George (14 wickets at 17.79), Geoff "Bar" Crogan (8 wickets at 9.50) and earlier on George Boulazeris (6 wickets at 15.00) all did a great job, but with none of them playing more than 5 games we needed others to take on the workload.

Mike Warren returned from the country this season with the aim of getting back into cricket and finding his feet again. With 14 wickets at 15.64 he not only found his feet, but he's another player who knows he can play at a 5th Grade level. I've spent a few seasons wondering if I could play as an allrounder and being captain this year I knew I would get my chance to find out. I finished the year with 21 wickets at 16.19.

One player I haven't mentioned is, in my opinion 5th Grades "Player of the Year", Dean Scott. Dean's main job was with the ball and in taking 27 wickets at 14.78 he was our best bowler for the year which was a tremendous effort in itself. But on top of that, he made his highest score for the club (36) and twice was involved in partnerships to get us across the line for victory. His fielding was of our topside standard, which was rewarded at the fielding vote count. After missing last years 5th Grade finals due to weight of numbers, he bounced back to have a season he should remember for a long time.

I'd like to thank the committee and the coaching staff for backing me and allowing me the honor of being a Bentley captain this season. Thanks to Brian and GD for their words of wisdom and encouragement, my Vice Captain Geoff "Mookie" Dart and my senior players for their advice on and off the field and everyone else who has helped in any way. A special thankyou to Christie and Ella for allowing me the time I needed to adjust this year and I promise it won't be so bad next time.

For all those players looking at playing 5th Grade next season, I leave you with a quote from our National Socceroo's coach Frank Farina, "I consider this job far from finished", I hope you guys do too!

2001/2002 will go down as a season of missed opportunities for the sixth grade side. Although promoted from seventh grade the previous year we acquitted ourselves quite well and won 5 of 11 games and finished 7th. Considering more than half the 37 players used in this grade during the season were new to the club or played in a lower grade in previous seasons this finish is commendable. We were well beaten in only 3 games. Lost opportunities with the bat in chasing mediocre scores between 144 and 163 cost us the other 3 games. We did however finish with a convincing outright victory against Balcatta and knocked them out of the top four for the first time in the season.

Our strength was the bowling/fielding throughout the year. In this regard Gary "Gus" Edmonds deserves special praise. After playing last year in 9th grade Gus stepped up very well. He bowled 50% more overs than any other bowler, took double the number of wickets to his nearest rival (now has 200 wickets for the club), was the most economical bowler for the team and just missed out on the bowling average to Derek "Des" Gascoigne. Gus and Des produced the only 5 wicket hauls during the season. Gus with 6 for 56 versus South Perth and Des 6 for 35 in the Balcatta win. Five bowlers took 10 or more wickets for the year.

The fielding was generally sharp and enthusiastic with many fine catches but alas not many runouts. Adrian Nation only took 3 catches but won the fielding award which is an excellent result considering he relinquished the keeping gloves after 2 games.

The batting was generally disappointing with exception of "The Legend" Lloyd Dungey. He proved he has many years left still by producing the only 200 plus aggregate of 228 at an average of 38. This year Lloyd passed the 8000 run milestone for the club, which is an amazing achievement in nearly 400 games. His season run total was 52 better than his nearest rival. The only century stand for the year was Lloyd Dungey and Dave Sykes' 110 versus South Perth. Dave Berry filled in for us at short notice early in the year and scored the only individual century with 116 versus Nollamara. Six fifty's were scored with no one scoring more than one.

Finally I would like to thank Gus Edmonds, Greg Sheppard and Dave Sykes. For filling the captaincy role during the many absences I suffered during the season.
