Cricket Managers Report

The 2010/11 season was an interesting year for the Cricket Department, with new Coaches and Captains leading our club. We were caught off guard at the start of the season losing key personnel and this meant we didn't get the results on the field, but we did learn a lot from the year and will move forward towards next season.

Being without last season's Club Coach Paul Coverdale was a big loss for the club. In addition, losing Darren Solomn, Bentley Cricket Club's only 1st Grade Premiership Captain, was painful for the club. Chris Prescott, our Denis McInerney medallist who took 57 wickets last season, headed to Perth in the WACA, as did Greg Sheppard, our Lower Grade Coach. Contracted players Jack Duffy and Arden Wittensledger also left the club after last season. These losses hurt the club dearly.

Laurence Paice was honoured to be appointed 1st Grade captain and Club Coach for the 2010/11 season. The extra workload did not affect Laurence's performances on the field as he scored 439 runs at an average of 39.90, with a top score of 116 against High Wycombe in Round 7. Laurence has been a great captain/ coach this year and has flown the flag high for the Mighty Blues.

This season saw big SOS and Timmy D'Souza introduced into coaching roles, SOS being the Bowling Coach and Timmy the Fielding Coach. Stephen Cairns also did a fantastic job as Nets Captain and Chairman of Selectors. Hollywood was appointed Lower Grade Coach and he did a great job juggling coaching, captaining and running the bar. Well done Gents.

Having lost so many players before the season began, The Recruitment Committee signed up Michael Bates and James Haggaty from the UK. Batesy a very talented Wicketkeeper Batsman and Hags a sharp left arm opening bowler. These 2 Poms represented The Mighty Blues well with some good performances. Batesy even joining the hundred club notching 118 against Swan Valley in Round 3.

Another player we picked up from the UK was Craig Stephenson, brother of Martin Stephenson who came out a number of seasons back and stayed with Robin and the great Chuck Berry. Again robin was kind enough o put Stevo up for the period. Craig performed well in 3rd Grade for the majority of the season as an all rounder. His standout performances came in the T20 format of the game as he dominated with both the bat and the ball. In our Grand Final win against Balcatta, Stevo hit 57 and took 4/13, an absolutely outstanding effort.

All in all, having lost as many important players and coaches as we did, we have to be proud as a cricket club that we got through the season and avoided relegation. We stay in 1st Grade and will build on this season for next season. Another positive from the season is the T20 Premiership in Division 2 of the Tasman Civil boys, an excellent prize for hard work throughout the year.

I am already looking forward to next season and the challenge the Bentley Cricket Club has ahead of it.

Chairman of Selectors Report

Let me start off with the saying this was a season that did not reach the heights we felt it could. When the committee offered me the Chairperson of Selectors position, we had high hopes but losing over 17 good cricket players across the three top sides had its affects at the selection table. The captains did not have very many options with player selections. Some tried harder than others to drag back players who had played in the past season or sons of players who admirably came to our aid and played for some of the lower grades. I lost count of the number of players Justin Warren found and appreciated Hollywood's never say die approach to selection when chasing up players, and I add many of them were good quality players. I would say Hollywood has used up all his favours for the next 150 years.

The top side led by a quality captain in Laurence Paice and vice captain in Brendon Daye did not have more than a dozen or so players who were up to the rigours of 1st grade cricket. However, players like Wade Mackay stepped up to the mark and proved that we have the talent; we just need to nurture them. This is not to say the third grade or fifth grade sides did not have talented players. The whole club across the grades 3 to the one-day side lacked a number of players who were in good form, or because they were injured struggled to play, some carrying injuries all season. Others had increased their family numbers and home duties, or priorities at work were cutting into their free time, or they had moved, so getting to training was harder, some could only commit to one Saturday at a time, or felt because of their age needed to play in lower grades, or had Uni studies and exams during November.

On the other hand a few players were playing below their ability and the club needs to look at this. The role the Chairperson of Selectors, I feel needs to look across the balance of the team. Going into a game with 7 bowlers with 5 of them who can bat and preferred to bat at 7 or 8 is not a balanced side. I am in total agreement with Justin that a squad needs to be formed for the two top sides and selection be a joint approach with the coaches, the chairperson, and then the captains and if the top side captain is the head coach then so be it. I felt that players were picked on past reputations of 2 or 3 years ago, and not their current form, which did not warrant their selection in the sides they were picked for. We saw three or four players who should have been playing higher and others who were not utilized enough. With all this said we were placed many times just managing to get 11 bodies on the field, and on more than one occasion sides only had 10 men for either the full or half a game.

Another issue I feel needs to be voiced to the playing group who I think felt we just picked the team names out of a hat. Is the amount of time spent selecting teams with email, SMS, phone calls, and meetings. As a side, I recorded the stats on this just for my personal information. Personal over 850 emails from captains and coaches a 170 recorded phone calls to captains and coaches another 85 to non-playing player to ask them to fill in 18 or more selection meetings. I am sure Hollywood's stats would be three times greater. Thankfully, most of us had employers that were understanding. I also strongly think the selection of the Vice captains for all the grades needs to be committee driven appointment. A captain needs to know that his number 2 knows what they have to do and has set jobs before and after the match. Sometimes a vice-captain may be a great bloke but have NO idea of the pressure he can take off the shoulders of the captain who has many tasks to do even before a game starts.

Head Coach & 1st Grade Report

Having played for the Blues in A grade semi finals the previous 3 seasons, it strange to sit here on the verge of the finals and not be training getting ready for war on Saturday. However, of the 20 players that pulled on the Baggy Blue in A grade in 2010/11, not one of them will have their character, commitment or spirit questioned or queried in any way. As a leader, that is all you can ask for.

We worked ourselves into winning positions in all but one game this season. With an extremely tough draw, we had set ourselves to be no worse than 3-3 at Christmas. After a 130 run loss to Balcatta in Round 4, and with the win-loss count at 1-3, a 45 minute 'lay it on the line' discussion took place in the rooms at Jones Paskin. We had to respond, and respond we did by beating Swanbourne and Western Suburbs away from home to keep our season alive. We did it the hard way but we were 3-3 at Christmas.

We took three wickets on the first night. We then took regular wickets on day two and reduced DC 8/100 with 40 runs to play with. The losing streak looked all but over. However, the opposition's tail wagged furiously and, to our disbelief, we now only had six runs to play with and one wicket to get! How did this happen!

It was then that Brendan Daye, in his 24th consecutive over on a 40-degree day, took the caught and bowled that sent us into pure ecstasy. What a turnaround! 14 days before we failed to defend 246 against a team, that would later be relegated. Then we defend 142 against a team would later play in a semi final. I think those two games summed up our season really well. Our ability to get ourselves into a position of dominance in a match, only to see the hard work of one day overshadowed by the mistakes of the next day. Then, our ability to get ourselves in all kinds of trouble one day against class opposition and look like having no chance of winning, to fighting and scraping for every wicket and every run the next day and pulling off a win for the ages. The joy on all 10 faces after that final wicket against Doubleview is undoubtedly the best moment of our season.

We then went onto win the last game against Bedford Morley in Round 11. Chasing 130 for victory, we again undid our good work with the ball to be in massive trouble with the bat. Needing 11 with one wicket remaining, it was Shaun O'Shea and Hiten Shah who this time provided the last wicket heroics and got us over the line. A fantastic way to finish the season.

The individual highlight for me this year was Michael Bates' hundred against Swan Valley. It is always a privilege for a club like Bentley to gain the services of a brilliant young bloke and a fantastic young English cricketer like Batesy. I hope that he finds his way back to Wyong next season. Brendan Daye also had another sublime season, taking the second most wickets in the competition and averaging over 30 with the bat. His status as the best player in WASTCA has grown every year since he started playing and this year was no exception. His support as Vice Captain was invaluable as well. A brilliant season all round from the Dark Vettori.

Then there was the emergence of some lesser names. The likes of Mick Gilders, Jai Thomas, Brent Walker, Perry Allen, Christopher Bradbury and Wade McKay are foremost in my mind. These guys have proven to the club and themselves that they are more than up to A Grade cricket and their contribution will be needed even more so next season.

The team highlights for me were the wins over Wembley, who beat us in last years Grand Final, in a game where we bowled them out for 160 and passed the score 3 down, and the brilliant win over Doubleview. 8th Grade Report

Season 2010/11 was a rollercoaster ride for the team and I. As a first-year captain, I felt the dizzying heights of victory to the heavy losses and harrowing close defeats left an impact on the team, and hopefully we can develop as a player group and become successful in the near future.

I had the rare privilege of captaining the milestone matches of our club legends. Keith Chapman's long-awaited 200th game, Greg Nairn's 250th, Steve Cairns' 400th and of course Lloyd Dungey's 500th match. All four men are icons of the Bentley Cricket Club and it was an honour to step onto the field with them.

Reflecting on the early part of the season, we lacked the consistency across the board to make a play for the finals. In most games, we were at least a batsman and a bowler short of being competitive. Losing Lloyd to a broken hand in the first game was a devastating blow and sadly replacing him was akin to sticky taping over the cracks of an earthquake. Tim Shakespeare performed well as an all-rounder prior to Christmas, and it was a shame to lose him after the break. Shakey's outstanding performance came in our first win of the season, against Western Suburbs, where not only did he knock over the opposition's best two batsmen in consecutive balls, he also struck a match winning 47.

Culver Chappelle (425 runs @ 53.13) and Lloyd (415 runs @ 59.29, missing the WASTCA average trophy by less than a run) were the mainstays of our batting line-up in the second half of the season and shared in two 100 run partnerships. Personally, I would pay money to watch Culver bat when he is in full flight. Cully and Lloyd both made wonderful centuries and it's hard to split which ton was better. Their consistency was also a highlight with Cully making 51, 56 and 80 to go with his hundred, whilst Lloyd made 72, 71* and 57*. Other batsmen to turn in good performances were Chris Lockyer (63 v Melville), Shakey (56 v Applex), Ben Millett (70 from 60 balls v Melville) and Sindhu Govindu (50 v Swanbourne).

The innings that stand out to me were Jake Lockyer's 9 against Swanbourne where he shared a 69-run stand with Cully, Lloyd Dungey's 4* batting with a broken hand at number eleven in our first win and Brendan Morris' 13 (including two huge sixes in his first game of cricket) against Doubleview-Carine. These innings are memorable for various reasons but all of them put a wide smile on my face and the team was better for each of them. Max Smith's game against Western Suburbs was equally memorable as any performance I have seen. If everyone enjoyed their cricket as much as Max does, it wouldn't matter if we lost every game of the season.

Our bowling this year was a little weaker than I would have preferred in most games, although I really enjoyed the responsibility of leading the attack most weeks (28 @ 26.46). Shakey and Sindhu both showed they are capable of higher-grade success while veteran war-horse Greg Nairn (14 @ 18.57) toiled in long spells, often for little reward. Greg is a bowler whom all Bentley bowlers can learn from, and a fierce competitor; he will be sorely missed on and off the field. Ken DeJager's spell against Doubleview in Lloyd's 500th game was a highlight, and he nearly dragged the team across the line. Shakey's opening spells against Tuart Hill and Western Suburbs were as quick as I have seen and Sindhu's 4-17(8) against Swanbourne was the difference between the sides.

Our unsung bowler this season was Jake Lockyer (8 @ 21). More often than not, when I threw Jake the ball he picked up a critical wicket. I often asked Jake to bowl to the oppositions' "slogger" and usually he came out a winner. Every game, no matter what the circumstance, Jake showed character beyond his years and his development was one of my season highlights. He was also the consummate team-man off the field, the club needs more people like the Lockyer family.

Some new (and relatively new) players to the club showed they have the talent to play in higher grades Luke Lovett's unconventional batting style often yielded positive results while his bowling and fielding improved with every game. Sindhu showed ability as an all-rounder with his match winning performance against Swanbourne (50 & 4-17) whilst his brother Sid showed promise as a batsman. Shyam Manthena's spell of 2-1 from eight overs against Balcatta was one of the best spells of accurate bowling I have seen. Scott Hayward showed ability with the bat, ball and in the field and I look forward to watching his development over the next few years.

I have so many people to thank and acknowledge for their support this season. Thank you to my deputies, Cairnsy, Cully and Ken for their help on and off the field this season. Thank you to all the other captains for their support, particularly Hollywood. Congratulations to Lachie and the other eleven man I shared the T20 premiership with, we earned it boys. Thanks to Karen and Chris Lockyer for all their hard work off the field across the season but also for all the drinks, arvo tea and support you have given the team this year. Thank you to Simon Cleary and Greg Nairn for all their administrative support this year and well done on all your statistics work Jules.

Finally thanks to Lloyd for all his support, counsel, runs, catches and run-outs. Congratulations on your 500 games, Dad, I was proud and humbled to captain you on your big day; I have enjoyed every minute we have played together this season and I look forward to playing many more with you next year.

Bentley is the best cricket club in the world to play for and I look forward to seeing you all next season.

Lloyd Dungey 500 Games



Donald "Lloyd" Dungey this season became the first player in WASTCA and Bentley Cricket Club history to play 500 games. He achieved this in the game against Doubleview-Carine in 8th Grade at the Dart Chapman Oval at Bentley on the 19th and 26th of February 2011. Lloyd was interviewed on both the ABC and Sports FM and remembered all the great blokes he had played against and with over his career. During the lead-up other celebrations included a gathering of past and present players at the club. Lloyd commented it was great to catch-up with players and mates he hadn't seen for a few years. He said his main aim was to get a few runs and not to make a duck, which he had done on the celebration of his 400th game. Well he did a little more than that making one of the best hundreds you will see. At the end of the day he was fittingly, 107 not out at the end of the day.

Several of his great mates over many years were out there including Steve Cairns and Greg Nairn. Greg later said it was an honour to be out there when Lloyd scored his 100th run and alongside him on the field for much of his Bentley Career. His very proud son Sheahan was captain of the side 8th Grade Captain and had the opportunity to briefly bat with his father on the day, although he didn't make quite as many as he would like.

Lloyd's record at Bentley began back on the 5th of February 1966 (just over 45 years earlier) in the Bentley 2nd Side against the Navy Side at HMAS Leeuwin. It wasn't the most successful game with the boys being defeated outright. Lloyd did fairly well for a 15 year old 2nd top scoring with 15 in the first dig and 3 no in the 2nd. I'm sure his father Ralph would have been proud to be out there alongside his son in his debut. Lloyd is player number 133 of a now 962 player that have played for the Bentley Blues. He made his 1st side Debut in the 1967/68 season and then went onto play 228 games in the top side, one of Lloyd's many club records.

An elegant, right-handed batsman, Lloyd played his best cricket through the Club's Golden Years of the 1970's and 1980's. Perhaps his finest knock was when he batted for over 4 hours in the 1985/86 2nd Grade Grand Final, as Bentley chased down Marist Newman's 270 with Lloyd finishing on 59 not out after a partnership of 148 with Matthew Knowles which won the game. During his career Lloyd has featured in 10 grand finals and won 5 Premierships in 2nd, 3rd, 6th 7th and 9th grades the most recent in the 2007/08 7th grade grand final.

Lloyd last year became the second player to pass the 10,000-run mark in the WASTCA, during his 500th game he had amassed 10,441 career runs at an average of 20.97. His top score was 117 against South Perth in 2000/01 season at Maniana. He has made 4 career centuries and 42 half centuries. He doesn't seem to be slowing down considering he amassed 415 runs this season at 59.3 per innings, maybe he's improving with age like a good wine which he has been known to enjoy when a hundred club meeting occurs.

Lloyd has featured in 23 partnerships of over 100 runs including his most recent in his 500th game featuring in a 169-run partnership with Culver Chappelle, this is a 5th Side 3rd wicket record. He has also featured in an additional 97 partnerships of 50 runs or more.

Lloyd holds many club records but in the 1st side his records are numerous including:

- ❖ 1st in games in 1st side with 228
- ❖ 1st in total runs in the 1st side with 4427,
- ❖ 1st in 4s hit in the 1st side with 334,
- ❖ 1st in 6s hit in the 1st side with 30,
- ❖ 1st in 100 run partnerships in the 1st side with 9,
- ❖ Equal 1st in 50 run partnerships in the 1st side with 31,

As a bowler Lloyd is not well known but maybe he should have put his hand up more having taken 42 wickets at an average of 16.57 with a best of 4 for 11 against Claremont at Wyong in the 68/69 season. He took his last wicket only last year having not bowled for many years.

Lloyd has an amazing record on field but just as impressive is his off-field personality, where he displays class, grace and a very rarely seen humbleness spring to mind. He was made a life member of the Bentley Cricket Club in 1976. He is in good company as both his parents are also life members. He was also Club Treasurer for 3 seasons from 1974 to 1977 and has helped around the club on committees, coaching and mentoring many of the club's younger players for many years.

“Cairnsy” has been one of the great personalities and leaders of the Bentley Club. Steve played his 400th game for the Blue boys early in season 2010/11 against Applecross on the 16th of October in the 8th grade side. He is the 3rd player in the history of the club to achieve this milestone. Steve debuted at the start of the 72/73 season in the 2nd side against South Perth at Wyong and is player No 186. Steve played 9 games in the 1st side debuting in 1976/77.

Steve has been an active member of the Bentley Club over his entire career hold down almost every position in the club. When induced as a life member of the club in the 1987/88 season he had spent 11 years of his 16 years at the club in some form of committee position. He has continued to be on committees and to this year has held executive positions of the club including:

- ❖ President in the 1991/92 season,
- ❖ Secretary for 3 seasons from 1981 to 1984
- ❖ Treasurer in the 1978/79

He has captained the 3rd, 4th and 5th sides for 8 seasons totalling 74 games for a win percentage of 46%. He captained the 200/01 9th Grade side to a flag which he often says is one of his proudest Bentley moments. It was given even more importance given this was Steve's 300th game, what a way to celebrate a major milestone.

Steve has played much of his career as a top 3 batsmen. His style is unique but very effective; it has been described in many ways over the years. Words such as “solid”, “stoic” or “dour” have been used but always with “needed”, “essential” and “required”. He has amassed over 6114 runs at an average of 13.23. This total sits him 3rd all time. An interesting record is that he has been LBW on 112 occasion which he will surely say were all very doubtful. His highest of 74 score came in 9th grade in the 2001/02 season Bassendean at Jubilee No 2. He has scored 14 fifties and featured in seven 100 run stands the largest being 132 with Phil Kenrick against Wembley at East Cannington in the 85/86 season. He has also featured in 60 partnerships of over 50 runs.

Matthew this year became only the 6th player in the Bentley Cricket Clubs 58 year history to play 250 games joining club Legends Such as Lloyd Dungey, Geoff Farrell, Steve Cairns, Brian Hayward, and Tony Malins. He played that game against Doubleview-Carine in 3rd grade on the 19th and 26th of February 2011.

Matthew has been a higher-grade player for Bentley for much of his career playing a total of 232 games in the top two side (91 games in the 1st side and 138 games in the 2nd side) at the time of his 250th. He can be rightly referred to as one of our great all-rounders.

He made his Debut on the 1st of February 1986 at the tender age of 14 and is player number 361. The game was played against Wembley Downs at Wyong in the game Matthew made 6 runs. He made his A-grade Debut in the following season as 12th Man. He was inducted as a life member of the Club in 2007 having achieved 200 games for the club that season and has won numerous grade batting and bowling prizes including this years Batting and bowling average.

During his a career Matthew has been a Grade captain for 2 seasons from 2001-03 with a winning percentage of 62%. He has featured in 6 Grand Finals and Won 3 Premierships in 1998/99 (2nd), 2006/07 (3rd) and 1997/98 (4th) Grades.

Matthew has made 4,643 career runs at an average of 19.35. His Top score was 102 no against Applecross at Wyong in 2006/07. He has made 2 career 100's and 18 50's. With him winning both the batting aggregate and average for the 3rd grade side this year.

Matthew has featured in 5 hundred run partnerships including a 2nd Side record for the 6th Wicket of 100 undefeated with David Berry in the 2006/07 season against Applecross at Wyong. He has featured in 44 50 runs partnerships.

Matthew holds many a 2nd Side record including 1st in Total Runs with 3146 runs, 1st Total Run-outs with 9, 1st Total 4s with 330, 1st Most 50 Run partnerships with 35, 1st Most 100 Run partnerships with 4,

As a bowler Matthew has taken a total of 233 wickets placing him 18th of all time. He has taken those wickets at an average of 15.72 with a best of 5 for 14 against Melville at Wyong in 2001.02. He has taken 181 of those wickets in the 2nd side ranking him 6th in that grade.

Greg "Grandpa" Nairn played his 250th game for the Bentley Cricket Club in the 8th Grade Side against Western Suburbs at Chinners Reserve in the final round of the 2010/11 season College Park. Greg has declared that this will also be his last game for the club with him announcing his retirement.

Greg Nairn has been one of the most influential members of the Bentley Cricket Club over the past 35 years both on and off the field. He was the club Treasurer for a total of 10 years and President in the 1992/93 season. The ability of the Bentley Cricket Club to remain financial has rested on his wide shoulders on many occasions during his time in this role. Greg was inducted as a life member of the club in 1993.

Greg debuted in the Clubs 3rd Side on the 16th of October 1976 against Wanneroo at Otago and is player number 231. The game was an unusual one in which Bentley lost on 1st innings but came back to win outright on the back of Greg's Bowling taking 6 for 22 in the 2nd Innings and finishing the game with figures of 9 for 39. He must have showed the club something as he then played in the 1st side the very next game against Mossman Park taking 2 for 66 under the Captaincy of Wayne Rieke one of the clubs current coaches. Greg remained a fixture of the Bentley first side for

many years playing a total of 108 games before work commitments took him away for some years. On his return he again took up roles captaining Bentley side and help in official positions on the committee.

Greg has been one of the clubs leading bowlers over many years amassing an amazing bowling records include:

- ❖ Greg Ranks in 7th all time for the best bowling figures in an innings with 8 for 13 taken against Bedford/Morley at Shelley on the 22nd January 2005.
- ❖ He has also taken 10 wickets in a match on 4 occasions with a best being 11 for 75 against Western Suburbs in 2007/08 Season.
- ❖ His most wickets in a season was achieved in 2005/06 season taking 46 wickets in the regular season.

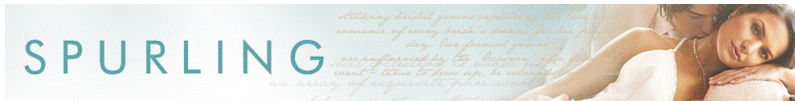
