E D I T O R I A L

To continue our areas of progress and success, and to improve our performance in other areas (most notably on field), we need to begin our 1990/91 planning at an early stage. We also need to have a hard working and committed group as a management committee. To achieve this we will hope to see a full roll up at our A.G.M. on Tuesday May 29th at 7.30 at the Sports Club.

In conclusion, may I thank all members and their friends and families who have given their support over the year. A special thanks also to the committee for their professionalism and enthusiastic work output. Finally, congratulations to all trophy winners.

SEASON SUMMARY - NUMBER 2 SIDE

Bentley's 'B' side could consider themselves unlucky to miss out on a berth in the finals by just 0.2 of a point. A number of factors could have contributed to this ill fortune, including the slow Wyong outfield, but in the final analysis it was 2 close losses early in the season that the side ultimately paid for. Although the batting line up varied from game to game, the side consistently batted through the bulk of the available overs. Stand out performances came from RON FERNANDEZ and newcomer TIM SHEPHERD, PHIL KENRICK turned in some gritty performances and LLOYD DUNGEY, STEVE CAIRNS and MARK LUKAN were solid contributors. Surprisingly no bowler took over 20 wickets, "A" Grade duties preventing MARK LUKAN and BRIAN WILLIAMS achieving this. TONY MALINS bowled economically and CRAIG MUNRO impressed before leaving. The fielding was very ordinary early in the season but improved during the year. CHRIS LOCKYER was a live-wire in the field and MATT HARMER showed promise with the gloves.

ACHIEVEMENTS

GAMES: This season saw BRIAN HAYWARD play his 200th game, PHIL KENRICK and JOHN WILLIAMS their 150th games, GREG NAIRN his 100th and CHRIS LOCKYER and JOHN FORD their 50th games.

Next season could see TONY MALINS play his 250th game and PETER QUARTERMAINE his 150th.

RUNS: This season saw RON FERNANDEZ score his 1000th run for the Club and BRENDAN KELLY score the 23rd century for Bentley (setting a new record highest individual score in the 'C' team).

Next season should see BRIAN HAYWARD become only the 3rd Bentley player to pass the 4000 run mark. PHIL KENRICK could become the 12th player to score 3000 runs.

WICKETS: This season JOHN WILLIAMS and 'ACE' HAYWARD took their 250th wickets for Bentley. In doing so they joined just 6 others to have achieved this figure. The WILLIAMS twins, JOHN and BRIAN also grabbed 7 wicket hauls. TONY MALINS took the 16th hat trick for Bentley.

Next season could see cousins IAN and GREG DICKERSON taking their 100th wickets; but the remarkable achievement within reach is **1250 wickets for GEOFF FARRALL.**
