We also need to have a hard working and committed group as a management committee. To achieve this we will hope to see a full roll up at our A.G.M. on Tuesday May 29th at 7.30 at the Sports Club.

In conclusion, may I thank all members and their friends and families who have given their support over the year. A special thanks also to the committee for their professionalism and enthusiastic work output. Finally, congratulations to all trophy winners.
