The club began the 2015/16 season with the aim of consolidating our place in 1st Grade after gaining promotion, improving upon the two premierships we gained from the four sides that had played finals last season and raising the competitiveness of our 8th grade side. The off season saw numerous personnel changes for the club with Fab Fanayan stepping up as Coach and four new captains for the top four sides in Laurence Paice, Jarryd Sibson, Justin Warren and Jay Smith joining One Day captain Steve Shearing.

With Laurence, Justin and Steve having captained sides to premierships previously (and Jay appointing premiership captain Pete Smith as his VC) and Jarryd having experience from his previous stint as captain the club felt under Fab's guidance that we were on track to achieve our aims and build on last seasons success. With the committees and captains support Fab began to reintroduce some of the Bentley values and standards that had slipped over the previous 4-5 seasons, namely the structure of training and the application of players at training.

With the restructuring of the 1st Grade competition resulting in six of the 14 sides facing relegation and the uneven fixturing of one/two games and home/away games our aim of consolidating our position was a tougher proposition than it had been in previous seasons. Overall the performance of A Grade was solid and what could be expected from a side who had gained promotion, after a first round win we struggled to turn good performances into wins and dropped points in some tight games. In the second half of the season we found form and results improved, highlighted by the wins in the last round of the season and first Elimination Final however we were unable to secure our place in 1st Grade after going down in second Elimination Final after a valiant effort.

4th Grade and 6th Grade both had relatively successful seasons by playing finals, with 4th Grade also qualifying for their One Day Final, but unfortunately neither were able to make an impact and were knocked out in the Semi Finals. It should be noted that both these sides were unable to select numerous players due to injury/availability for the last couple of rounds and the finals however both sides will feel that they didn't do justice to their seasons with their finals performances. It was disappointing that neither side was able to replicate their early season form towards the end of the season, particularly after both sides were knocked out of the Semi Final last season, and indicates the increased effort and performance that is required to be successful in finals.

Over the last couple of seasons we have seen that 8th Grade, as the lowest two day side, have trouble selecting a balanced side with players of the required standard. Whilst efforts were made this year to rectify this situation and their overall performance improved it was not to extent we had hoped. First time captain Jay should take satisfaction from the improvements that were made considering the number of changes his side faced week to week. The side showed character in getting up in a couple of tight games and will hopefully be able to continue this improvement with the support of the club.

Unfortunately the One Day side were not able to complete their hat trick of Grand Final victories and despite a late rally in the season fell a win short of playing finals. This season it was decided we would select players who were financial and had attended trained regularly ahead some of the regular One Day squad who aren't able to commit to training. Whilst this provided more opportunities for players on the fringe it limited the sides competitiveness and reduced the enjoyment for the more experienced members of the side. There will always be a balance between giving people a go and selecting a side which allows the team the best chance of success and after 4-5 rounds we softened this approach. The side was again well represented by its core group of 'stalwarts' and is great way for these guys to keep playing and to stay involved.

In summing up it was an underwhelming season in regard to the goals we set as a club and what we achieved although there is some satisfaction to be gained from the numerous challenges that occurred throughout the year and the way club handled them, and there is always next season to make amends.

To finish off I'd like to thank Fab for his efforts as Coach, there are many, many things involved in the role and in his first year he took it all within his stride whilst looking to implement his own ideas. I'd also like to thank the committee (in particular Brian and Greg for your advice throughout the year) and captains (in particular Justin and Jay for your assistance with selections).

Our undermanned bowling attack toiled manfully on the second day with warm weather, flat deck and lightening outfield. After an opening stand of 72 High Wycombe were pegged back by Daysie and Timmy bowling in tandem and when they fell to 5/120 needing nearly 4 an over, things looked promising. Enter Ben O'Brien who blasted a lightening 40 from 16 balls and broke our hearts. Hoovs told the devastated group of lads after that we never chucked it in and should be proud of our efforts. Too right – we never give up no matter what the situation.

It was a season of near misses in a few games like Wembley, Balcatta & Bedford-Morley to name a few, we had our chances to win. Those close losses being wins could have had us on the cusp of finals yet again.

On a positive note, Hoovs stepped back into the skipper's role and did so admirably. This bloke is an icon of the club and a great leader – always shows great respect to the game, club volunteers & clubmates and opponents as well as umpires and is a great mate to us all. His blow to the head at Balcatta was something that had us all shocked until we realised he was thankfully OK. He made the right decision not to bat again – the risk was not worth it. I cannot thank him enough for making me so welcome in that group.

Our import Elliot Callis proved a popular lad around the place – he embraced everyone in the club and found many a friend, especially the two Saxon boys – he still couldn't pick Tate's wrongun at the end though!!! Good luck in your cricket career Els.

Tim Horan proved a great pickup and a popular lad around the group. His years of experience in professional sport make him a hardnosed competitor and he is always willing to share knowledge.

Our batting was led again by Mr Consistent Omo Fanayan – his 96 again FMP was a brilliant knock and he just loves a contest. His fielding is also dynamic and he won the fielding award by a street again. Support came from Hoovs, Els, Timmy Horan and Fabby at times, along with Daysie and Matty Smith. Coatesy showed in the last game what he can do to sides once he gets his eye in. Hopefully his body holds up next season for him as a vital cog in our batting. The bowling was let superbly by who else? Bentley's own GOAT – Brendan Daye – maybe the WASTCA's Greatest of All Time when he retires from the game. Whether opening the bowling in an undermanned attack and bowling all day or coming on with the older ball, this man is never out of the game. He tore the heart out of FMP and then led the rout of Tuart Hill with 7/31.

Supported by Hiten and the big hearted Shane Saxon, who belied a sore body to run in hard for us and take many handy early wickets. There was also Timmy D'Souza whose ability to bowl in partnership with Daysie v High Wycombe was a factor in helping us back into the game. Daniel Cheeseman is a star of the future also and with plenty of work, I look forward to seeing this lad progress to a first grade regular.

We have the nucleus of a quality side and saw Adam Bartholomew and Peter Burbridge come into the side at times.

We also look forward to the continued improvement of Yagan Walley who can trouble sides with his leggies – he just needs to keep working at it.

On the back of being promoted from 2nd division, the 2015-16 season was an extremely exciting one.

The club strategically recruited Yorkshire batsman Elliot Callis in an attempt to boost our batting lineup and add some youth and professionalism.

We were also fortunate enough to snare competition gun and former Doubleview Carine Club captain Tim Horan after years of discussions, and years of him tormenting our bowling lineup.

These two acquisitions, as well as keeping the nucleus of our 2nd grade premiership side resulted in us being bullish about pressing for a finals appearance, despite the fact that the competition continues to get stronger by the year.

We started with a grinding one day win against Tuart Hill. Some lower order brilliance from Tim D'Souza pushed us to a competitive 132. We then battled in typical fashion in the field to restrict the opposition to 89 and get the season rolling. Wickets were spread between Shah (2/11 off 7) Daye (2/12 off 6) D'Souza (2/22 off 5) and Paice (4/28 off 8). The next 2 games were summed up simply as good bowling performances poor batting performances, failing to chase 118 against Bassendean and 156 against Whitfords in consecutive games. Daye and Burbridge were the standouts with the ball over these games, whilst Horan and Omo Fanayan showed the only real resistance with the bat.

We were then outclassed by eventual premier Murdoch Melville, with Horan and Daye again the standouts. Round 5 saw day 2 washed out against Swan Valley after a strong showing on day one, dismissing them for 222 and us being 2/60 at stumps. Youngster Yagan Walley burst onto the First grade scene, taking 5 wickets in a classic display of leg spin mastery. An absolute clinic from a kid with the cricketing world at his feet

We then blew a golden chance to get back on the winners list. At 2/86, we were cruising to victory over Swan Athletic after they posted 143 in a one day fixture at Wyong. We then lost 8/55 to crumble and lose by 2 runs, A devastating result. Omo again starred with the bat, posting 41. Paice took the bowling honours with 3/17.

The next fixture was one we should have won, and did comprehensively against Curtin Vic Park. Posting 199 from our 40 overs, we were never in any trouble in the field and posted a solid win. Fab Fanayan peeled off a delicious 57no to finish the innings beautifully, whilst wickets were spread.

First game after Christmas was another one day fixture against Doubleview. On a slow ground, we posted a competitive 153 on the back of a clinical 53 from Omo. The Bentley squeeze was then applied by Shah and Daye with the new ball as they combined for 5/28 from 16 overs, Game over. The game also saw the inclusion of young Daniel Cheeeeeeeeeeseman who chipped in with 2 wickets.

Round 9 took us to Scott Reserve for our annual derby v High Wycombe in a 40 over game. Again batting first, we posted 192. Callis with a masterful 60 led the batting from the front. However, we were the walking wounded in the field. 3 injuries and no sub fielders until Sibson entered the game late to give a hamstrung Matty Coates time to hobble from the field. We battled and executed magnificently on the back of 5/22 from club great Brendan Daye. With HW needing a 6 from the last ball to tie, Daisy was feeling sporting and dished up a shin high full toss. It was hit high and long towards mid wicket, where Cheeseman took a calm, well-judged catch to give us the victory. We had won 3 in a row and were starting to build.

We then took on Wembey Districts at Wyong. We fought our way to 7/163 from our 40 overs on the back of another 60 from Elliot. This score ended up being slightly under par, despite another fighting performance, Wembey passed the score in the last over in another tight finish, on the back of a ridiculous 79no from 46 balls from the former test player Suresh Perera.

We then dropped 2 games to Bedford Morley and Balcatta. Wickets were spread between Daye and Paice over these fixtures, whilst Horan top scored with the bat. These losses effectively put a line through our finals aspirations. Without going into detail, we were forced to fight for our place in 1st division by having to finish in the top 7 to guarantee entry, or finish from 8th to 11th in order to play in 'relegation finals'. A ridiculous scenario, but one we simply had to deal with.

The last regular season fixture was against Fremantle at Wyong. An outright result would likely push us to 7th spot and considering Fremantle's form and our recent record against them, we had a chance to pull this off. On a fair cricket wicket, we batted first and amassed 233 with Omo playing one of his best digs, making 96no.

We then rolled Freo on day 2 for 77. A crazy 6/18 from Daye and a solid 3/16 from evergreen Shane Saxon carried the team. We went for the outright and sent them back in. As is very often the case, we couldn't execute as well 2nd time up and the day fizzled out with the opposition 5 down. Boon took another 2 wickets to give him 8 for the day. Sensational from the Dark Vettori.

Our 'Relegation Semi Final' was against Tuart Hill at Wyong. On a grassy wicket, we sent the opposition in and asked them to deal with our attack. They couldn't. Daye was simply unbelievable again with 7/31 to completely embarrass a pretty good batting lineup. A sneaky 2/10 from Solanki finished the innings on 69. After a shaky start with the bat, we settled and passed their score 4 down, and ended day one at 5/130, a comfortable 61 runs in front of the game on the back of a tough 51 from Omo. We were forced to keep playing on day 2 by a desperate and delusional group of cricketers. , and we dealt with that professionally. Fab grinded out 37, and a sensational 51 last wicket stand between Shane Saxon and Rhys Tilbury put the game completely to bed as we were 153 runs in front with 58 overs left in the day. You do the math! It was over, yet we had to go and bowl 10 overs and as a result took another 5 poles, 3 of which went to Daye. That completed a fantastic 2 game streak from Boon netting him a lazy 18 wickets.

We had qualified for the 'Relegation Grand Final' against High Wycombe. Day one was wet, very wet. But in the interest of what was best for our team, we waited for the rain to stop and pushed to get play underway on day one. This made the toss crucial, and it didn't fall our way. We were inserted on a spicy wicket in dark conditions. We stumbled early and were 5/53 with about an hour of play on day one. Coates joined Paice at the crease and the fight was back on. LP took a back seat as Coates counter attacked beautifully. At stumps, we had chiseled our way to 5/98 with 22 overs left to bat on the Sunday. Coatesy departed early for very well made 44 on day 2. Paice followed shortly after for an ugly 31. B Daye then delivered with the bat, peeling off a run a ball 42 to push our score to 189.

Things were always going to be tough with the ball. The wicket had flattened out to be a sensational batting wicket and we were playing a very good batting side with 3 bowlers of our own. They got away to a flier. We rallied through the spin twins in Daye and D'Souza taking 5 wickets between them, but in the end we had thrown our best punches and were beaten. The clubs fate, in terms of which grade we will be in, is completely unclear and with a bit of luck, we will be playing in the top grade next season. We finished 9th out of 14 sides.

Thank you to Fab and Boon for being able assistants again, and for completing what really is a leadership group that has gelled well for 6 years.

Thanks to Mook for continuing to prod and ask questions about the side and what the next best move was. Your commitment to the role was unquestionable.

To Brian, Darty, Ron, Cairnsy, Gards, Len and Veracs. Thanks for your undying support and all of your help with the one percenters. As I've said in previous seasons, it never goes unappreciated.

And to my family, especially my beautiful wife. Thanks for continuing to come down and support what really has become a family team. The close nature of the group has seen us win premierships and its not until you travel to other grounds with little to no support that you appreciate what we have built. It is something I'm very proud of, and may it long continue as we push into the next phase with new leadership.

Round 2 against Swan Valley was the first 2 day match of the season. With Swan Valley at 3/146 things were not looking good for us, up stepped leg spinner Yagan Walley, hoping to have an impact with the ball this season. Yagan did not disappoint, dragging the game back in our favour taking 6 wickets. Chasing 196, partnerships were going to be key in the run chase. A fast start from Rhys Tilbury and starts from JT and Rich kept us in a strong position but a stand of 68 from Tony Magill and the skipper ensured the win was ours. Tony finishing on 23 and myself on 64.

Next up was Applecross at home in a two day fixture. Applecross were pinned down by some tight bowling which meant we were chasing a lowly 93 for victory. This was once again thanks to another bag from Yagan finishing with 5/23. The chase was never in doubt with Stevie Daye returning to form with 48, a classy 59 from Pritchys and 60 from Steve Paice featuring a barrage of cover drives.

It was the much anticipated match against Fremantle Mosman Park in Round 4 after the semi-final loss from the previous season. After the skipper lost the toss once again a bowlers took control, keeping Freo Mossie to 134. Yagan continuing his form with 3 wickets and JT taking the impressive figures of 2/7 from his 8. In his first 4th grade game for the club Jamey Riches made a valuable 40 opening the batting with JT dominating with 54. Jamey's dad also providing some great support from the sidelines which all the boys loved.

Full of confidence from an undefeated start we travelled to Pat Goodridge to face Wembley. On what is always a fantastic pitch to bat we managed to post 203 from our 40 overs. At 6/74 things were not looking great but thanks to a wonderful partnership of 85 from Tony Magill and Steve Paice we were able to consolidate and then dominate in the final overs. Paicey finishing up with 43, Tony making 57. Some tight bowling thanks to spin twins JT (5 wickets) and Yagan (3 wickets) ensured that Wembley never got close.

Despite having won the first 5 we hadn't come up against a side at the top of the ladder. The match against Subiaco Marist would be our first real test. Disappointingly we didn't bowl well and Subi Marist made 240 from their 72 overs. With plenty of rain the night before the second week, we rocked up on the Saturday to find wet run ups were to delay the start of play. After finally starting around tea time we ended up 3/84 thanks mainly to Stevie Daye's 40no against a quality bowling line up. So a draw it was.

Round 7 and another test against 2nd placed Doubleview Carine at Monyash. Another batting collapse and we found ourselves at the precarious position of 6/55. However as we had all season we rallied and thanks to Pritchys 52 and Lubes 36, we were able to post a healthy 187. A poor start with the ball and some disappointing fielding meant things were going to be tough. Despite taking it to deep in the match we suffered our first loss of the season.

We wanted to lift and respond after a disappointing loss and against Swan Valley at Wyong we did just that. Tony Magill's 54no the highlight as we posted 174. Swan Valley were never in the hunt and were bowled out for 56. Cheesy finding form taking 3 early poles and Timmy D'Souza with 3 wickets were the main destroyers.

After the Christmas break we once again faced Wembley in a one dayer, this time at Wyong. A team batting effort saw us finish at 185 from our 40. Matty Smith top scoring with 45. It was a tight tussle in the field as the game always looked like it would go down to the wire. The defining play in the match would go to Matty Smith. Needing something to turn the game in our favour Smithy produced a great fielding effort at long off throwing down the stumps and running out Wembley's top scorer. Wembley finishing on 176 meant that we had once again got the W.

Against an Applecross side languishing near the bottom, we wanted to make sure we continued to show our credentials. Batting first Applecross were bowled out for 77 with Josh Erricson showing he can play at this level taking 3 wickets along with JT's 3 also. Never in doubt, we chased down the Applecross total giving us another win.

Another test against a top 4 side this time, back to Subi Marist for a one dayer. Some tight bowling restricted Subi Marist to 121 in a slightly rain affected match. Another collapse in our chase and we found ourselves slump to 6/46 then to 9/95. Needing 27 still to win numbers 10 and 11, Timmy D'Souza and Matt Harmer set about knocking them over. The Subi Marist sledging soon stopped as it was apparent that these two batsmen were no mugs and would not give their wickets up easily. A vital partnership ensued and with the last over starting we needed just a solitary single

to win. Matty Harmer decided to make it even more interesting, unable to score off the first 5 balls Matty laid bat on ball and scrambled through for the winning run and the celebrations were brilliant. One of the best wins I have been a part of and really showed what being a member of this great club is all about.

Another top of the table clash against Doubleview Carine in a one dayer after rain forced day 1 to be abandoned. Once again we lost wickets early and scrambled to 143 thanks to 33no from a right handed Leigh Martin and 38no from Matt Harmer. We were never in the game once we started with the ball. A disappointing effort all round meant our second loss in the season, both coming from the same side. An open discussion was held in the change rooms to ensure a performance like that was not seen again.

Back to 2 day cricket and we were up against Ocean Ridge at Wyong. Posting 174 with 51 to Pritchey we would need to bowl well to win the game. 5 wickets to Mauneek Solanki and it looked like we would get the W. With one wicket needed Ocean Ridge required 41 runs. Unfortunately a last wicket stand developed and we lost what seemed to be a certain win.

After winning 7 of our 8 one day matches we had qualified to play in the one day grand final against Ocean Ridge. After our initial GF was called off because of the associations Heat Policy we came back 3 weeks later in front of a great home crowd. Being sent in to bat we were quite happy with the result. With a somewhat slow start we never really got going and lost wickets at fairly regular intervals. A defiant and damaging 39 from 26 balls from Tony Magill swelled the total to 150 and ensured the momentum was with us. We started poorly with the ball and were never in the game with Ocean Ridge proving too good chasing down the runs in the 38th over. A disappointing grand final loss and perhaps the occasion got the better of us, we would need to rectify this with another 2day finals series beckoning. A final round match up against Fremantle Mosman Park would serve as the perfect tune up for a semi-final. With Daniel Cheeseman back in the side he showed just how damaging he can be, ripping through the top order taking 5/21 and bowling them out for 85. The runs were knocked off on the same day and second spot on the ladder was ours.

Finishing in the top 2 we wrongly assumed we would get a home semi-final, with the association once again ensuring we play away. Within our group we wanted to redeem ourselves from our previous semi-final the year before. Losing the toss we were in the field and needing a massive performance from our bowlers. An early breakthrough to Cheese was the start we were after but at 1/85 the momentum was well and truly with Wembley. Up stepped Tim D'Souza bowling 28 overs straight and dragging us back in to the match finishing with 5/67. Timmy bleeds blue and it was fantastic to see him deliver on the big stage. The other notable bowling performance was from Steve Paice, who probably didn't see himself needing to bowl, ended up bowling 12 overs to a 7-2 field and taking 2/23. Wembley finishing on 180. Partnerships were going to be key and we just could not produce the goods. We ended up on 107 in what was to be another disappointing finals exit.

In looking back at the season, I think we missed another opportunity. After a dominant first half of the season we never quite reached the same heights in the second half. We can be proud of making a one day GF and the two day finals but ultimately we came up short. As captain it was fantastic to see someone like Cheesy go up to the ones and perform very well. Jamey Riches and Josh Ericson showed at various stages that they are more than capable of playing turf cricket. Hopefully we can keep the core together next year and add to the talent we already have.

I would like to thank the club and the committee for another great year. Thank you to the first grade skipper Laurence Paice, your advice and help all year is always appreciated. Thanks to Fab in his first year as the club coach and Geoff as chairman of selectors your support was always welcomed. To Holly, thanks for being so understanding when I took your players at the last minute, you are a true club man who always puts the club first. To my vice captains Jai and Stevie, I could not have done the job without you guys. Your help on and off the field was incredible. To everyone else in my side thank you for all your efforts. We didn't achieve what we all would have liked but we should look back with pride in our performances.

It was pleasing too, to see new cricketers playing debuting this season. Sammy Kaseke started preseason with almost nothing and took his first catch and had his first bowl before the season was out. For these guys it's all about experience and getting games under the belt, improvement will come I guarantee it. Others like Dean O'Brien, Nick Small, Rob Chasland and the Syed's were occasional appearances but work and university commitments kept them out for many Saturdays unfortunately.

It was also a unique pleasure to play alongside PC and Kieran for most games. Dad was an invaluable VC for field setting and turned out to be one hell of a bowler, taking home the bowling trophy miles ahead of the rest. He bowled us to victory in our second highly controversial one dayer against Ocean Ridge, returning 3/26 after dismissing the batsmen that should have seen them home easily. Kieran again showed what grade he could be playing, dispatching more boundaries than anyone else this year and hitting two fifties: a 64 (when 6 of his fellow bats fell for ducks) and 83 (in 54 balls). Our best bat, bowler and keeper could easily have been picked in the other grades and I thank them, my fellow captains and the chairman of selectors for allowing them to stay in 8's and form the all-important 'core' of the team.

This is the second season in a row now that Bentley's 4th XI has been uncompetitive and I feel that a demotion next season will not be a great improvement to our prospects. With the future of this team being debated and the ageing player group becoming a concern I encourage all members to attend the AGM. The Committee needs your ideas and input now more than ever.

David “Chuck” Berry Memorial Game Report

The 9th Annual Chuck Berry match was played out for season 2015/16 in the only grade that Bentley and South Perth share, 8th grade.

The second one dayer these sides played for the year proved to be a more scintillating affair than the first, when South Perth easily chased down the meager 103 Bentley had set back in November.

The selections process for Bentley was exhausting, calling up 6 of the One Day team, including captain Shearing. Daquino, the Smith trio and Dungey made up the rest.

On a powerfully hot afternoon Bentley won the toss and elected to bat first.

Daquino fell early but then the experience of Shearing and Welsh combined for a 79 run stand that saw the run rate rocket along and be in a strong position at drinks, 2/93.

However, South Perth turned the game completely after drinks as Reynolds engineered a middle-order collapse. Just 8 overs after drinks Bentley were reduced to 7/106. Wickets fell until the 34th over before captain Smith and De Jager put on a 26 run stand for the last wicket, batting out the 40 overs to set the target at 153 for victory.

The weather was playing tricks as a strong front moved in front of the sun shortly after the commencement of the South Perth run chase. These much cooler and humid conditions favoured the swing bowling of K Smith and Saxon, a double wicket maiden from the former bringing South Perth to 3/25 off the first 10 overs. Despite the threatening rain South Perth held nerve and the experienced Furnivall steadied the ship as newcomer Darragh proved that he won't play 8th grade much longer, hitting 9 boundaries in his unbeaten 50 to see South Perth home with overs to spare.

Or so we thought, when 5 minutes after the end of match South Perth announced that both score books added up to 150, three runs short of victory. The umpires decided the only remedy was to set up the stumps and re-take the field. Given the nature of the match and the good spirit in which it was played, Bentley agreed with minimum fuss and it was quite a sight as half-dressed players, some minus shoes and others possibly hiding a can took to the field for the last balls to be bowled. Two balls was all it took for victory to be re-assured and the match was finally over.

South Perth were presented the trophy after 3 years of Bentley victories and the Bentley Club president was quick to remind all that the overall tally still stood 5-4 in Bentley's favour. The deserving Chuck Berry medalist was Reynolds of South Perth, finishing with figures of 4/13 from 8 overs.
