

FROM THE PRESIDENT

Season 98/99 has seen Bentley establish itself as a "Champion Club" in the competition.

This is most fitting considering our achievements in:

- * Fielding our top 3 sides in the Grand Final
- * Our top two sides winning Premierships
- * "Grade Premiers" in our top two teams
- * Promotion to 1st and 3rd grades
- * The Club's continued high rating in "The Champion Club" award

This season saw the best ever performance by our "A" team in 13 years and congratulations to "Buddy" and the boys for winning the flag. Brilliantly led by Buddy, they have been the trendsetters winning 9 qualifying games to finish on top of the ladder, the fact that two players in this side won Association trophies (Shane Paap for best batting and Matt Harmer for best fielding) reflects the tremendous depth and talent in this team. The performance of Scott Vallow, both with bat and ball, deserves special mention. He was unlucky to miss out on the Association bowling trophy. Solid contributions from other senior members in Dave Berry, Tony Magill, Serge Perrozzi and Ken Dawson are also acknowledged.

Congratulations to captain Glenn Davies and the rest of our 4th Grade side on winning back to back Premierships. Clearly they were the best side in that grade, finishing the qualifying rounds on top of the ladder. The talent in that team augers well for next season and provides the depth required to support the top side.

The performance of both these teams reflects the intensive planning, preparation and training which commenced back in May '98. The professionalism and dedication of our coaching committee, Steve Shearing, Dave Berry (Chairman of Selectors) and Brian Hayward (Cricket Manager) must be recognised and applauded.

All in all, the 98/99 season was a tremendous year for the Club. Personally it has been challenging, tragic and most rewarding. As President, I am very proud of our Club and it's achievements. I look forward to seeing you all in August and earlier for those involved in pre-season training.

PREMIERS & GRADE WINNERS

This concludes another successful season for the 4th Grade. As reigning premiers the side looked forward to season 98/99 with great expectations, back to back premierships being the seasons main objective. Of course, this is made easier by finishing in first or second spot on the ladder, so a top two finish was another priority, we know very well what happens to the teams that finish 3rd and 4th when the rain comes in semi final week (and it always rains in semi finals).

This season had many highlights. The first highlight for the season occurred in the first game of the season against Kalamunda, both Ken Dawson and Justin Chandler scored 69 runs which was to be the highest score made by a 4th Grade player this season. The brilliant performance by the left handers enabled them to share a 4th wicket partnership of 142. After this game Ken was promoted to 2nd Grade for the remainder of the season.

The next highlight came in the following game but this time with the ball. Mark Lukan mesmerised the Melville batsmen with a sensational display of swing bowling. Mark finished this game with the figures of 7 for 37 from 12 overs, 5 of these wickets came in his first 4 overs. This wasn't a once only performance, Mark also had a fantastic game against Bedford Morley in which he took 6 for 39 from 11 overs including 5 maidens. This was another great performance from Mark, at one stage Bedford Morley were cruising at 1/56, 20 overs later they were all out for 103.

There were many milestones this season, but none came close to the 300th game for Brian Hayward. This was a must win game for this team, all the players were aware of the performances and work Brian has done for this Club over the 30 years of his involvement. There was no way the team was going to let Brian down. At 7/86 chasing 103 a win wasn't guaranteed but a fine 29 run partnership by vice captain Kirk Spencer and captain Glenn Davies enabled the team to get across the line, and allow Brian to celebrate his milestone in style.

There were numerous team highlights for this team, the outright win against Thomlie after losing on the first innings was probably a minor one. The game against Nedlands when Shahid Ghauri pushed the last ball straight to mid on and raced through for an impossible single to win the game outright was the most exciting game of the year. Sid had been run out twice in previous games trying to do the same thing. Finishing minor Premiers was also a great team effort.

Obviously the greatest high for this team was winning BACK TO BACK PREMIERSHIPS. With the rain once again doing the right thing and washing out the semi final, the team entered its third Grand Final in a row. For the second season in a row this team saved its best batting performance of the season for the last game of the season, an unbeatable 9/306. Vice Captain Kirk Spencer top scored with 59 and shared a 90 run 8th wicket stand with Captain Glenn Davies (52 no). Damien Rickards (52) and Justin Chandler (43) also shared a fantastic 4th wicket stand of 77.

With a score of 306 Vic Park were never in the hunt against the quality Bentley attack. Vic Park were all out for 184. all the bowlers were superb with K.Spencer, M.Dickerson, A.McLevie and A.Brown taking two wickets each, C.Rickards and J.Chandler chipped in with a wicket each. The fielding was again of the highest standard, as it has been all year.
