# Editorial

Although the "A" Grade's Grand Final clash against Churchlands proved to be a very disappointing climax to the 1981/82 season, the season as a whole can be looked back upon with more than a little satisfaction. The fact that our "A" side finished on top of 2nd Grade, winning the Grade Winners award and earning promotion to 1st Grade, is a credit to coach "ACE" HAYWARD and the competitive side that he led. An indication of their success throughout the season is reflected in the fact that, not since the 1958/59 season has a top Bentley side lost fewer games. The depth of ability in the club is also reflected in the fact that this season our 3 sides won more games altogether than in any of the previous seasons in which we fielded 3 sides. All of this was achieved despite the loss of a number of good players from the previous season. The reasons behind this achievement is two-fold. Firstly the club gained a batch of recruits whose performances were of a high calibre throughout the season. Players such as DAVE GITTUS, RON FERNANDEZ, BOB FIRTH, KEVIN BERICH and CHRIS WHITE particularly stood out. Secondly the training, coaching and selection policies of "ACE" and his assistants instilled a fierce competitive spirit into the club, particularly the top side. Despite criticisms, and these will always occur, "ACES" approach has been fully justified and it is a great pity that his ultimate aim was thwarted by the toss of a coin.

Before closing, let's give a few thoughts to next season. From the "A" Grade's point of view 1982/83 will present the problems that previous Bentley sides have encountered in 1st Grade. One of the main problems is attitude. The players have to believe in their ability to do more than just survive the pressures of top competition, they have to believe that they can win against top competition. To win, and win consistently, in 1st Grade our "A" Grade must maintain an aggressive and enthusiastic approach, they must maintain the bulk of the side that earned them promotion and they need to supplement their playing strength by gaining 2 or 3 quality recruits. All of this represents a very tall order and one that should be shared by as many members as possible. Without suggesting answers, each member should ask himself, "What can I do to help the club in the 1982/83 season?" The benefits of recruiting, positive attitudes and acceptance of responsibility will not only be evident in the performance of our top side, they will filter through and benefit all sides.
