SEASON SUMMARY - NUMBER 1 SIDE

With a pre-season objective being to blood new and younger players, 1990/91 was regarded as a year for rebuilding and assessing our longer term needs. All this aside, Bentley can regard themselves unfortunate not to have finished higher up the ladder. The opening fixture against M.N.O.B. (a side Bentley would have fancied their chances against) was abandoned and the match against Victoria Park (who subsequently played in the finals) saw Bentley go down by 1 run after a controversy over scorebooks that did not agree. Other games slipped through the side's grasp such as the Girrawheen one-day fixture when the opposition recovered from 6-26 and 7-45 to make 134 and win by 7 runs.
