EDITORIAL

Looking back on the 1988/89 season, one cannot help feeling a certain amount of disappointment and concern.

From an on-field point of view, just 3 wins between our top 2 sides can give no satisfaction, whilst the 3rd side's successes in the latter half of the season were, in part, gained at the expense of our 2nd side. This mediocre playing record, combined with the fact that our playing strength still comprises a high ratio of players who, whilst still making valuable contributions, are past their prime, gives real cause for concern. However, there is a light on the horizon which, if nurtured, should see a resurgence in our Club's playing performances. During the season, no fewer than 19 players made their debut for the Club. And although a number were in the 'fill-in' category and others fell by the way, a significant number made more than a little impression. Sharing the title of 'recruits of the year' were ALAN LINES and GARY BEZANT who headed the top side's bowling and batting figures respectively. New ball bowlers JOHN MULLALLY and JAMIE WANLESS also have big futures ahead of them and can play a part in Bentley's future. STEVE TAGLIAFERRI is another new face who has a lot to offer in the coming seasons and it is hoped that we can retain the services of ROD BLACK, a spin bowler of real ability. The younger recruits also give us much to enthuse over. There can be no doubting the enormous potential of MIKE and MARK WARREN and TONY and SIMON MAGILL. All are still at the development stage of their careers but they represent the playing future of Bentley. We must also continue to encourage our other younger players such as RAY BAND, MATT HARMER and DAVE FOX as they too have many seasons ahead of them. Next season we must retain these new faces as well as attract others so that competition for places in our 3 sides becomes fiercer. A more long-term investment for the future was made with the re-introduction of a Bentley Junior side. Although at the Under 13 level and a long way from senior ranks we must continue to keep these young players in close contact with the Club. An enormous vote of thanks must go to all who helped with these youngsters, particularly PHIL KENRICK and LLOYD DUNGEY. From the social aspect, the Committee worked very hard on a number of functions but found it difficult to attract numbers. This was a real worry to those behind these functions and it is apparent that we will need to come up with events having more universal appeal as a successful social side to a club does wonders for team spirit.

Yes, 1988/89 was a disappointment, but the Club has the personnel and the resources to lift the Club in 1989/90.

In closing I would like to thank each and every member of the Committee for their tremendous efforts throughout the season, all the members for their support, and congratulations to all the trophy winners.

SEASON SUMMARY - NUMBER 1 SIDE

Bentley's top side experienced a season of frustration and finished 10th in 2nd Grade after winning just 2 games. Generally the batting appeared somewhat brittle with a number of players appearing to survive on reputation rather than form. Newcomer GARY BEZANT was clearly the outstanding contributor with the bat and BRIAN HAYWARD and PETER QUARTERMAINE made a number of solid scores to give substance to the upper order. Of the remainder, ALAN LINES consistently was among the runs in the lower order and perhaps his hard hitting style could have earnt a permanent middle order berth, BILL SKUTHORP more often than not reached double figures after plenty of grit and application but never really went on with it, and MARK LUKAN showed promise after being promoted from the 4th Grade. The bowling attack bore little resemblance to the line-up of the previous 2 seasons. Unfortunately it was a case of a new look but the same result. ALAN LINES was consistently the most penetrating bowler, spinner ROD BLACK did extremely well mid-season and GREG NAIRN was the best of the rest. As a rule the fielding was of a good standard with 'keeper BRIAN HAYWARD showing the way, despite being denied the opportunities to show his fine catching ability.

SEASON SUMMARY - NUMBER 2 SIDE

If we face the cold, hard facts, the Bentley 'B' side recorded their worst win/loss result in over 15 years. There were many contributing factors that led to this situation, not the least of which was a lack of stability within the team, with players being required for the sides both above and below. The leading lights with the bat were GRAHAM DICKERSON (until his departure), GREG DICKERSON (in just 7 games) and PHIL ROBERTS (despite his somewhat erratic form). Of the rest there were some isolated individual efforts but too little to mould a regular batting line-up around. The bowling too lacked depth, particularly after the loss of GRAHAM DICKERSON, and it was left to spinners JOHN WILLIAMS and PHIL KENRICK to head the wicket takers. There were some fine fielding performers with GREG DICKERSON and RAY BAND narrowly taking the honours over 'keeper BRUCE NAPIER.

RECORD CHECK

1988/89 saw quite a deal of activity in terms of individual players achieving personal landmarks.

Stalwart GREG DICKERSON chalked up his 100th game whilst BRUCE NAPIER, BILL SKUTHORP, MAL DICKERSON and RON FERNANDEZ all played their 50 th games.

With the bat PHIL ROBERTS became the 10th Bentley player to score 3 000 runs for the club. JOHN WILLIAMS and TONY MALINS both passed the 2 000 run mark and IAN DICKERSON passed 1 000 runs.

Veterans TONY MALINS and GEORGE WOODHEAD both achieved bowling milestones during the season when they took their 700th and 500th wickets respectively. These tallies are only surpassed by the living legend GEOFF FARRALL.

1989/90 should see a similar amount of action.

The most significant achievement should be made by BRIAN HAYWARD when he plays his 200th game for Bentley, a marvelous milestone only passed by 4 other members. PHIL KENRICK and JOHN WILLIAMS should make the 3rd game of the season a memorable one, for they both are just 3 games shy of their 150th appearance for the Club. GREG NAIRN is 8 games away from reaching 100 games whilst CHRIS LOCKYER (46) and JOHN FORD (45) are poised to play their 50th games.

With the bat RON FERNANDEZ and MAL DICKERSON should score their 1 000 runs for the club. Other players would need quite outstanding efforts to reach their next targets so I won't put the hex on them by pointing them out.

With the ball BILL SKUTHORP and IAN DICKERSON could well both take their 100th victims.
