1st Grade Report

We got a brilliant runout on the first night by Ferris and Al Tyler picked up a wicket of the last ball of the day to have them reeling at 2/5 overnight. We fought hard the next day and when Steve Shearing was thrown the ball it was all over for Basendean as Steve bowled Jaffa after Jaffa to have the fine figures of 3/5.

Although it was also a sad day as we did say goodbye to Rhino, actually he said goodbye to us from Adelaide an hour before the game. We did have some fun in the second innings with Fab showing he was good enough to be in the top side and Huddo having a crack at the highest season aggregate by a Bentley A Grader. It was a good season in the end we fought well to finish Mid table and if we keep the core squad together and build on it and have the return of a few familiar faces nothing is out of the question next year. 3rd Grade Report

The 3rd Grade season for 2003/04 resulted in 5 wins and 6 losses with a ladder position of 7th (from 12 teams). In order to reflect on the season the pre-season goals of the team need to be considered. The side expects to make the finals and then ultimately win a Premiership. In reality the team had recently been promoted from 4th to 3rd grade and the pre-season forecast was that it may be a difficult year for the side.

Going into the final fixture against bottom placed Bassendean meant that an outright win would give the side a 'chance' at the finals. An outright loss in the last 10 minutes of the game summed up the character of the side. Never accepting defeat until the very end and risking ladder position for a crack at the flag.

Early narrow loses against strong clubs in Whitfords, Bedford Morley and Applecross hurt us. Our patchy form also meant that we had some big wins against Balcatta and South Perth. An awesome opening bowling performance by Matt Harmer and Tony Magill setup the win against Balcatta and Damian Rickard's aggressive batting set the scene for a big score against South Perth.

After Christmas we reversed close loses into wins. The game against Wembley (eventual premiers) was memorable for the against the odds spirit of the players. Matt Harmer after an uneventful first spell came back to restrict a runaway Wembley batting line-up. A highlight of the game was the late call up of Russell Budd who came out of a form slump to provide a solid backbone to our batting.

The Tuart Hill game was a big run chase which featured an outstanding partnership in the 90's between Damian Rickards and Russell Budd. Fab Fanayan's powerful batting display was also prominent. The match against Doubleview was dominated by Tony Magill with both bat and ball scoring 50 and taking 10 wickets for the match.

A pleasing aspect of the season was the development of several players Tim D'Souza, Sin Soueng, Brad Fleet and Omid Fanayan all proved that they had the ability to play at this level. Dean Scott was another talent that was previously untried in the seconds but proved his worth in this grade. All these players should now set their sights on cementing places in this grade or higher. The latter part of the season saw established players Shaun O'Shea and Jamie George combine to form a formidable bowling combination.

The standout players in 3rd grade would have to be Matt Harmer and Steve Shearing. Matt had a great year opening the bowling and providing reliable batting in the middle order. He was finally rewarded with an 'A grade' promotion. Steve gave our batting much needed stability and was also credited with a place in our 1st side.

There is much more to a season than batting and bowling and many thanks need to go to the senior guys who contributed to the leadership of the side. In particular Glenn Davies who was always there to turn to when I didn't have the answer. Many people contribute to the success of a side: All the guys that played in 3rd grade this season, the spectators, helpers, coaching staff, committee, selectors and the wider BCC community. Thank you all for the support.

We can now feel confident that the step up to 3rd grade is not out of our depth. With a similar level of commitment from the players and support staff they can expect to feature in finals cricket next season.

5th Grade Report

At the end of last season, I said that in 2003/04 there would be no excuses. I am proud to say, that after 13 games and a lot of hard work, we don't need any! 2003/04 will be remembered as a successful year for 5th Grade and success that was well deserved.

It will be remembered for some brilliant individual achievements and some hard fought wins, but for myself, it will be most remembered for the way the team worked together and stayed focused on the season goals. In a season that saw 30 players and 4 Captains we had to adjust to a lot of changes, but with every change we had someone ready to put their hand up to do that bit more.

Our batting was highlighted by 5 hundred's and 8 fifties. Stew Jeffreys 120, Ted Thomas 117, Omo Fanayan 109 and PC Smith 101 no all made their first 100 for Bentley and Fab Fanayan's 117 no was his second (Steve Paice was unlucky not to make his first with 98). We had 7 batsmen make over 200 runs for the season with Omo (339 @ 33.9) and Stew (318 @ 24.4) topping the runscorers. There were 3 hundred and 16 fifty run partnerships, with Omo and Stew's 168 run 3rd wicket stand against Applecross being the biggest and also levelling the association record. Stew and PC's 157 run 5th wicket stand against South Perth and Dez Gascoigne and Brad Fleets 75 run 9th wicket stand against Subi Marist both set new records for 5th Grade.

Our bowlers changed quite regularly this season, with 22 of the 30 players being required to bowl at some stage. Jamie George (29 @ 6.1) played only 6 games for the year and is an outstanding asset in 5th Grade. Jamie took 10 wickets against South Perth, including his first 7 wicket innings for the club and his 6/18 in the grand final was the best performance in the clubs history. Brad Fleet (21 @ 13.0) and Dez Gascoigne (18 @ 12.7) were the backbone of our attack and both did great jobs throughout the season. Beags McLevie (13 @ 12.1), Sin Seoung (11 @ 11.7) and Dean Scott (10 @ 13.1) were the other bowlers to take over 10 wickets for the year.

5th Grade fielding was of a high standard all season. Behind the stumps John DiPerna got back to his best by the New Year break and the team seemed to lift with him every game after that. John gloved a number of quality catches over the season, but in my opinion his stumping for our first wicket in the semi final was his best dismissal. Our three "classic" catches during the finals, Chris Pritchard in the semi and Beags and Omo's in the grand, will surely be remembered, but the most pleasing thing for myself was that both sets of umpires for the finals commented on how good our fielding was. To hear this from umpires who had spent the year in 1st and 2nd Grade was a credit to the team.

The finals campaign was very special and something I will never forget. Our come from behind semi final victory against High Wycombe showed our character and to destroy a quality side like Applecross in the grand final, well I put that down to our commitment and focus and when push came to shove, Applecross just weren't up to it. If we had a player of the finals, it was our keeper-batsman John DiPerna. John played a part in 9 of the 20 dismissals (7 catches, 1 stumping and 1 run out) and made 47 off 39 balls being dismissed only once.

Thank you to everyone who made this year possible. We put a lot of hard work in and we deserved everything we got out of it. Congratulations to Greg and 7th Grade for a good season, lets make sure we continue to build on our depth and we'll make it two next year. Thanks to Jamie, Dez and especially PC for the job you did when sharing the captaincy with me and to the committee, coaches and Glenn Davies for your help and support. To Brian, you've been there every step of the way and I can't thank you enough for everything you've done.

Let the next challenge begin!

This team won 10 of 12 games throughout the season, finished deserved minor premiers and sat atop the ladder for all but the first game of the season. We were not inundated with stars, but comprised of blokes who all contributed to the teams success at varying stages of the season. We did not rely on the performances of a handful of players which, to me, is the sign of a good team. Although we came up short in the final, this was not from a lack of self belief or lack of desperation – this was the anomaly that can occur in a format that pits two teams against one another in a winner take all result. On the day, we weren't quite good enough but we will use this heartbreak to fire us to better things in the season to come.

On reflection, we were not a high scoring team (only passing 200 once when we made 341 against Subiaco Marist) but that is more a reflection of our ability to dismiss teams cheaply rather than our inability to make team. In this regard, two games stand out – the first against Applecross when we chased 167 and the second against Doubleview when we chased 132. These were not big scores but after being in trouble on both occasions, we were good enough to get across the line in both matches. This reflected well on the depth of our side rather than the performances of a couple of individuals. However, it would be remiss of me not to mention some brilliant individual performances during the season that included Jamie Hendry's maiden century for the Club (140 vs Subiaco Marist), Chris Scott's coming of age as an opening batsman (307 runs for the season including scores of 63no, 62no and his memorable 48 in the final), Gino Terriaca's 70no against Doubleview, Darren Third's 280 runs for the season, Ted Thomas's 84 that propelled him into higher grade cricket and Greg Sheppard's contribution throughout the majority of the season.

There is no doubt that our bowling and fielding skills were the main reason for our success this season. Opposition teams only passed 150 on 3 occasions and we dismissed opposition sides for less than 100 on no fewer than 6 occasions. To me, this was a fantastic effort that set us up for the season we had. There were some outstanding individual performances during the season which included Darren Third taking 34 wickets (best of 6/39), Jamie Hendry taking 23 wickets (best of 4/20) and Greg Naim taking 40 wickets (best of 7/14 and 7/24, including two 10 wicket matches). Other meritorious performances were also achieved by Gino Terriaca and Marc Kinch. From a fielding perspective, the outstanding performers were Geoff Dart, Gino Terriaca and Chris Scott.

All in all, a successful season that left us all with a bad taste in our mouths after losing the grand final. My special thanks to all of the 30 players who played in my team this year – your contributions were important and valuable and appreciated by everyone else. Thanks also to Greg Dart for his support, Mrs Sheppard for her assistance with scoring duties and to the many wives and girlfriends who assisted by preparing afternoon teas during the season.

I look forward to seeing all of you back next season when we will go that one step further.
