The Player's XI started well with runs flowing steadily. Unfortunately wickets kept falling at important periods due to some good bowling and field placements from DT.

There was no shortage of boundaries throughout the day with Hinchcliffe consistently clearing the boundary and a few power hitters from both teams also chiming in. At the close of play the Player's XI fell 10 runs short of the Coaches XI 167 with Hinchcliffe top scoring with 98 and Cam Daw 32 for the Players.

All in all it was a great day with a decent crowd and a water slide for the kids, with a great feel around the club before, during and after the game with most attendees staying to socialise well after.

This match is of most importance to the club as it holds close to our hearts remembering the tragic event the Hewitt family had to endure. And as such raises well needed funds for the Red Nose Foundation. We entered the 2018/2019 with some new faces which in turn gave some of the older players a bit more energy. Firstly new head coach David Taylor added some positivity as well as some class and discipline. The addition of David Taylor with his in depth knowledge of the game helped a lot of guys improve and grow into better players. We acquired Yahya Ali and Awais Mehdi from Applecross who are quality cricketers and helped shaped the season we were about to have.

With our first game rained off against High Wycombe, we headed out to Bassendean in round 2. The deck was very inconsistent and with a bit of rain around, we decided to have a bowl. We restricted them to be all out for 181 after they were 3/99. Awais Mehdi took two key poles and Adam "Chucky" Palumbo bowled very well to helped turn around the innings. We ended up passing their total 7 down with Matt Lockyer the star with the bat with a patient but excellent 62. Laurence Paice and Fab Fanayan chipping in at the end to get us home in a great run chase.

Round 3 saw us at home against reigning premier Swan Athletic. They belted us twice the previous year and we knew we were going to have our work cut out. Swan Athletic won the toss and chose to bat and on a good deck, we did a very good job to restrict them to 160. Palumbo once again led the way with 4/32 bowling himself into exhaustion on a hot day. Ish Khan and Laurence Paice with 2 a piece were pivotal also. Unfortunately we let ourselves down the following Saturday. All out for 155. Consistent Omo Fanayan and Hooves stood up with the bat with 55 and 50 respectively. At one stage we required only 20 to win with 5 wickets in hand only to lose 5/14 and not get there. Nevertheless this was the match I started to realise that we could be a pretty good side and could actually play finals.

Round 4 saw us against Wembley who boast a side chock full of talent. On paper we shouldn't get close to them but as a team we don't care about that. I won the toss and chose to bowl on a batsman's paradise. Their captain was looking at me like an idiot when I decided to bowl. Well about 47 overs later they were all out for 133. We welcomed back Hiten Shah and he delivered like always taking 2/7 and showing why he is still a genius in this comp. Fantastic fielding efforts also from everyone contributed to 3 run outs. It was a great team effort. This time we didn't let ourselves down with the bat and passed their total easily. Tim Horan fantastic with 39no with Omo, Awais and Hooves again all involved to beat Wembley easily. Hiten Shah bombing the spinner on to the roof was a big highlight. We nearly lost outright actually but in the end we took the chocolates and got the hell out of there.

Round 5 we beat Bedford Morley at home in a clinical display. Dismissing them for 177, we chased it 5 down to end up with 280 on the board. Hiten Shah against the chief destroyer with 3/33 off 21 and Fab Fanayan grabbing 5 catches behind the stumps. After being 2/18 at one stage chasing, Omo Fanayan and Matt Lockyear combined for a 74 run partnership to help put us in a good position. Omo ending up with 52. Awais Mehdi and Fab Fanayan ensured the victory with 60 and 56 respectively in a dominant display from the boys. Chucky Palumbo with some icing with a couple of big bombs to help celebrate the victory.

Round 6 we easily accounted for bottom placed Balcatta. The addition of David Taylor into the side for the first time paid dividends as he and Tim Horan guided us to 4/228 after our 40 overs. Horan with a magnificent 90 off 92 and Taylor not out 53 from just 39 balls. It was always too far for Balcatta as they were all out for 170. Palumbo the star with 3/17 and Daniel Cheeseman bowling very well for 2 wickets.

Only one game lost up until the break and we were feeling pretty good about ourselves.

Enter round 7 and Swan Valley. That pretty good feeling quickly changed when we got absolutely pumped. We quickly realised that the hard work we were putting in needed to continue or else this bright start could be all for nothing.

We had a tough and gruelling match against Murdoch Melville in round 8 who also needed to win. In incredibly hot conditions we ended up having a bat first. At 2/1 I thought to myself why did I bat first. But then Tim Horan and Awais Mehdi put on an absolute masterclass with great aggressive batting and taking it back to Murdoch. They put on 74 in quick time and we got ourselves in a position to score 200 but were all out 175 which in the end was a bit disappointing. Horan with 60 and Mehdi with 40. Hiten Shah and Ish Khan opened up and both produced brilliant spells of bowling combining for 16 overs and 3/32. It was the start we needed to hang on and win the match. Awais Mehdi with 2 important wickets and Yahya Ali bowling at the death was superb. The team responded to the poor performance the week before and it was a sign of character.

Rounds 9 and 10 we would have two close losses to Applecross and High Wycombe. Both games we were in the box seat chasing and both games we came up just short. If we were to elevate ourselves from being a good side to a great side then we had to overcome these mental battles of chasing runs when in winning positions.

In the end round 11 against Bassendean became a must win game for the side in order to stay in the top 4. The guys responded sensationally and easily won the match. David Taylor's second game again produced the goods with 69 and 2/34. Omo Fanayan with 37no to help guide us to a very healthy score of 173 in a rain reduced 32 over game. Awais Mehdi continued his stellar season with 3/19 and Ish Khan with 2 early wickets with the new ball yet again. Round 12 topped us off beautifully chasing 163, we passed it 7 down. Hiten Shah with 2/18 off his 8 was brilliant. We got ourselves in a lot of trouble but like most games this year, Awais Mehdi stood up and took the game on and hit a crucial 45. Omo Fanayan continuing his good form made 33 and we got home with 2 balls to spare. With that win it was all decided that we would be playing High Wycombe in a semi-final. Who would have thought that 12 months ago after coming last the season before?

In the end it was a really disappointing result in the Semi as we ended up not rocking up to play and lost to the eventual premiers in High Wycombe quite easily. Rolled for 96, we were out of the game from the get go.

I just want to personally thank firstly David Taylor. You have been a massive positive not only to myself but also to the whole club. You are a fantastic coach but an even better bloke and I am privileged to call you my friend. To Stephen Cairns, Chris Lockyer, Lesley Magill, Vikki Fanayan, Lenny Woodley and Ronny Fernandez, thank you for all the time and effort you put in. You guys don't have to do what you do but you want to and everyone at the club appreciates everything. To all the players that played in 1st grade, thank you for making captaining easy and a joy for me. You guys made every minute of the year out on the field enjoyable for me and I hope everyone had a heap of fun also. Enjoy the off season.

Our second encounter saw us take on Bassendean on another sticky wicket and once again I lost the toss and we found ourselves batting and under pressure, rolled for 55 I thought it couldn't get any worse than the first week but I was wrong, all be it only momentary, to our credit we fought back hard with the ball and dismissed Bassendean for 76, we started the second week in a positive mindset and put 152 on the board giving us a handy lead and half a day's play to try and wrangle an unlikely victory, our bowling attack performed tremendously and we dismissed Basso for 69 in their 2nd innings and won outright, UJ Bhan, Dan Cheeseman, Maunee Solanki, and Mitch Duncan destroyed the opposition and another fantastic knock from Pritchard (74no) capped off a very memorable victory for our side.

The next few games proved to be very frustrating. From a bowling perspective, we put ourselves into good positions though far too consistently an hour's bad cricket allowed our opposition to score heavily and end up hitting 50 or so more runs than they should have, this proved to be the difference between winning and losing these matches. Chris Pritchard once again showed his class and put together a fantastic innings scoring 108 no in our teams total of 182 against a strong Wembley attack. Josh Ericsson, Cam Daw, Maunee Solanki and Alex Jerrard all contributed solid innings of around 50 runs or over in various games leading up to the Christmas break.

Post Christmas we had a few stalwarts return to the club who helped bolster our side adding experience and depth to our batting line up. We took on Swan Valley in a one day match and came away with a tight win after chasing down an honest total of 176, Tom Horan who had been given the job of opening batsmen for the season performed very well compiling a great 36. Tom was thrown in the deep end early in the season when we were struggling with batsmen and in my opinion was one of the really good stories to come out of our year, it was great to see him growing in confidence week by week with both bat and ball and I look forward to seeing him progress further next year. Jai Thomas bolstered our top order and hit a superb 81 against eventual premiers Murdoch Uni/Melville, our batsmen really stood up this fixture falling only 20 short of chasing down 249 in 40 overs which was a fantastic effort and epitomised our fighting spirit. A sensational opening spell from UJ Bhan saw us roll Applecross for 112 in our return to 2 day cricket, UJ achieved the figures of 5/47 from 16 overs and is another young player that took the responsibilities bestowed upon him this season and performed exceptionally well. We fought hard against High Wycombe keeping them to 253 on a very good wicket, Tom Horan bowled brilliantly taking 4/64 from 17 overs, unfortunately we faltered with the bat, that is all apart from Chris Pritchard who compiled a handy 57 and once again added respectability to our total. Our last game saw us take on Bedford Morley in a one day fixture, Dan Cheeseman bowled with good pace and hostility and was very unlucky not to end up with better figures than he did. Cheesy spent a good portion of the season playing in our first grade side and gained in confidence and consistency as the season went on. Jack Duffy hit the ball to all parts of the ground and made a stunning 74, we passed Bedford's score of 155 with the loss of 5 wickets to finish our season with a good win.

I look back on this season and I am delighted that I have had the opportunity to be part of this sensational cricket club once again, it was amazing to be reunited with old team mates and to get to know the not so familiar faces, who by seasons end felt like I had been mates with for years. This is testament to our clubs fantastic culture and our shared love of the game. In closing I wish to thank my wife Lisa and my boys Cooper and Jack who put up with everything that a cricket family is subjected to including the Sunday morning moping after a bad day's cricket. Also Leslie Magill, Ron Fernandes, Lenny and Darty, thank you for your home game assistance with drinks and teas and everything else you guys have been involved in, this takes a lot of pressure away from captains and is seriously appreciated by everyone though especially me.

In closing I think I have a lot of room for improvement as far as captaincy is involved though I have had such a rewarding first season at the helm and have learnt as much as I ever have from a year of cricket. Thank you to everyone involved and I look forward to us coming back next year and looking to push deep into finals through all grades.

Bentley played South Perth in one game this year, that being in 6th grade. Some confusion about the uneven fixtures and an anticipated post-Christmas reshuffle meant the Round 2 clash was not officially designated as the "Dave Berry Match," both sides imagined a one-day match would be played after the break. It was not to be but seeing as Bentley won the encounter we retrospectively claim the trophy back for the Blues.

The third side was bolstered by a fourth side bye and a resulting bounty of options at the selectors table. A bright Saturday at George Burnett saw Bentley win the toss and opt to bat with Daquino and Chapman opening the account before Barret had the first wicket at 28 in the 4th over of his 12 over spell. Wickets continued to fall regularly with Michael Beaucasin contributing a composed 21. However, Bentley were in a spot of bother - the top 5 dismissed with 66 runs on the board after 30 overs - a competitive total looked far away.

Enter Amarjit Singh and Don McKeig, Amit opening the arms and employing the horizontal drive with Keg reliable at the other end they put on 59 vital runs in 15 overs before Keg played a regrettable shot to be caught Maltman for 24. Singh continued with his lusty blows before holing out for 58 (7x 4, 2x6) with the score at 160. The remaining batsmen provided token resistance and Bentley were dismissed for a reasonably defendable score of 168 although another 20 would have been a comfort. South Perth openers Barrett and Gossatti had 10 overs to negotiate before stumps, which they did reaching 0/21 at the close.

Some quiet discussions were had midweek between senior team members about our chances of taking ten for 140-ish and the conclusion was it would be doable if bowlers stuck to lines and length and applied pressure in the field. This was the message to the team on the Saturday and bowlers Smith and Bowen delivered first up, Bowen causing all sorts of problems with his movement outside off as the batsmen played and missed every other ball much to the chagrin of a howling cordon. Gosatti looked set and in control on 25 before Smith got one to go through the gate and sent the stumps in all directions, the first wicket a huge sigh of relief with 45 runs on the board after 12 overs bowled for the day. Lockyer on from the other end had Barrett LBW to yet another moon ball, 2/55 and the game was back with the Blues. However South Perth's 3 and 4 in Palmer and Unsworth dug in for the next 20 overs taking them into the nineties and the game looked to be slipping away from Bentley. A change of bowlers was made to immediate effect, Chapman snicking off Palmer for 18, Ahmed at the other end doing the same thing to Unsworth in the next over, 2 for none and then another LBW to Chappy, the score had gone to 5/103 and the game was on an even keel again.

McKeig was the 7th bowler employed, his second ball a rank full toss that was dispatched flat and hard at approximately 2.5m altitude, a great shot which unfortunately for the batsman was hit directly in line with Smith, 6/110. The skipper could sense the endgame was near and returned to the attack to bowl in partnership with the spin of Keg bamboozling batsmen at the other end. Fernandez was yorked shortly thereafter and things had well and truly swung back to Bentley, the card reading 7/118 and the 168 target very far away indeed. 5/22 had been the middle order collapse brought about by Chapman, Ahmed, McKeig and Smith.

However, all was not over as another momentum swing took place with Tierney and Hirsch playing smart cricket getting the innings past 140 as the tension rose. But Tierney went to the well one too many times, looking for cheap runs he was caught Chapman bowled McKeig. 8/144 and the win 25 runs or 2 wickets away Bentley was pumped. Six further runs were added before McKeig ripped one back to remove the stumps of number 10. At the other end Smith into his 19th over of the day was jubilant in celebration with the rest of the team when Lockyer chest marked an aerial cover drive from the final batsman to end the match. South Perth just 17 runs short in a great match that had both teams in the box seat at various stages, another Dave Berry game that had all the hallmarks of a classic and enjoyable game of cricket.

Bentley 7 - South Perth 5.

In sitting back with the team during our last fine session for the year and recalling the season highlights it was easy to remember we had only chalked up the four wins this year. It is a fair reflection on the number of days which we played well and the number of those we didn't that all 7 losses were comprehensive ones and the 4 wins memorable ones. To be frank finals was never a realistic prospect with our form and in those losses we couldn't turn the momentum around once we fell behind early which explains the forgettable margins.

Not to dwell on that, our highlights were:

Round 2 claiming the Chuck Berry match from Amit Singh's swashbuckling 58 in our 168 and Smith's 22 overs eventually rolling South Perth for 153 as they were closing in.

Round 4 bowling Murdoch out for 180 in 68 overs, thanks to some marathon bowling spells of superb consistency and accuracy by Smith, McMulkin and Naz.

Round 5 chasing down Swanbourne's 200 with ease, going past the target 5 down shortly into the last session and accruing 7/274 with Ericson's 78 batting through to tea and McMulkin's 60 supported with partnerships coming through Marlborough and Leng.

Round 7 our only game on turf up at Belridge proving runs on the board is all important. When Stace took a wicket with the first ball of the innings we fired up in defence of 114. He proceeded to carve through the Ocean Ridge batting card and his spell of 6/30 reducing them to 8/55 after 17. A 42 run stand for the 9th wicket saw them within reaching distance but Smith returned to the attack to claim wickets 9 and 10 and the team a 16 run win. On a side note Jason 'Lazarus' Marlborough returned to playing for the side having recovered from an on field heart attack he had way back in round 6.

Round 9 Josh Ericson putting in the what has to be best performance by anyone in a single game for Bentley, making 103 opening the batting with a 122 opening stand alongside Riches and claiming 7/34 from 20.3 overs opening the bowling alongside Duncan an opening partnership that took us to tea at 8/63 from 36 overs against Balcatta as we won by an astonishing 158 runs.

Congratulations to batting trophy winners Josh Ericson 202 @ 40.40 and Jason Marlborough 260 @ 37.14 who were outstanding in their class and consistency with Lloyd's 138 @ 17.25 not to be sniffed at, especially for the oldest bloke in the grade.

The bowling attack was dominated of course by captain's prerogative taking 18 @ 19.50 from 111.4 overs. Other strike bowlers in Ericson, Stace, McMulkin and Duncan were in the team sporadically being up and down from the twos.

Two things I think the third side needs to match up with the others in the grade would firstly be some more experienced ex-turf guys as our opponents were often flush with the type of cricketers that can be momentum-turners. Secondly, lacking one or two full-time spinners noticeably hurt. Again, most of our opponents had the options, there is only so many times you can change bowlers and bring on yet another right arm medium.

Thanks to the auxiliary support from Cam and Lengy on game day with the pre and post-game necessities. Cam at one stage admitting to vacuuming the astro at Centenary the night before, an offense I still maintain should have cost him in fines session. Well done too Lengy for bringing Lazarus to the club, Jason's tactical insights from first slip were valuable input. Thank you to our hard working committee we continue to be one of the better managed and financial clubs in the Association, now we just need a flag.

Rd 3 saw us play our first home game of the season at our new ground Centenary Park against Whitfords, again batting first we were unable to post a dependable score only managing to make 86, Whitfords were 3/50 overnight with Razzle leading the way taking 3/27, Wingy also showing us his skill taking 3/19, we eventually went down in a close one bowling them out for 109, in the second innings Matt Harmer showed us how to do it making a classy 32* to end the day.

Rd 4 saw us play our first of 3 games on turf this season taking on Tuart Hill, losing the toss wasn't the ideal start to the day but Matt Harmer and Ed Daquino got off to a flying start having us at 49 off 13 overs. Then entered Danny Arcaro who put on the best batting display I have ever been a part of making an incomprehensible 205* including a 192 run partnership with fellow one day player Timmy Dsouza who made 63 with Timmy making his highest score on turf and Danny his highest score ever. We finished the day on 6/371 the most runs in an innings ever for the fourth side. It was the only time this season that we batted our full 72 overs in the two day games. Come week 2 we applied the pressure early with Rocket and Lubes turning the screws and having them 2/20 odd at the first drinks. Rocket bowled beautifully all day ending up with the pick of the figures with 2/35 off 16 overs with the rest of the wickets being shared around in a tough slog of a day, we ended up getting the win quite comfortably holding tuart hill to 8/223.

Rd 5 saw us take on Western Suburbs with the game being moved off turf to synthetic late in the week, welcoming Sibbo and JT into my side for their first games of the season had us in a positive mood, winning the toss and batting we were able to make a competitive total of 177 with Wingy 34 and myself 44*, Western Suburbs were none down overnight and the pressure was on us, coming back on the second week we saw our bowlers take control of the game, Lubes starring with 4/45 off 16.2 and being supported well by Wingy 3/34 off 12 and JT 2/22 off 15 including 9 maidens bowling Western Suburbs out for 140 giving us a strong win.

Rd 6 saw us playing a one dayer against Applecross, with us batting first Freighter started us off well smashing 45, we then lost a bunch of wickets very cheaply with Lubes coming in to save the day and building a great innings of 58* getting us to a very competitive score of 196. Having left Applecross 25 overs to face on day one we ran into an 11A batsmen playing a few grades too low who took to us, smashing an unbeaten 132 which saw Applecross win on day one. Coming back week two we weren't really sure what was going to happen, what happened was the bowlers stood up and took command again seeing us take 7 wickets in the first session with Callum McMulken taking 3/51 off 8.2 overs and Wingy 2/38 off 10 which brought about the declaration at 7/248 looking for the outright. It didn't eventuate for them with Ed Daquino 48* and the skipper making the rookie captains mistake of calling the game at 2/98 not knowing Ed was on 48 and in the middle of a 49 run partnership! Rd10 saw us play our last game on turf against Curtin Vic Park at Kent St. Losing the toss and being sent in on a difficult wicket saw us losing regular wickets and not being able to put on a good partnership. In the end we were bowled out for 143 with myself making 82, CVP were none down having to face 8 overs at the end of the day. Week 2 saw a better looking deck and CVP took full advantage of some loose bowling, batting sensibly all day to take the win ending up on 4/247, Lubes being the only multiple wicket taker having 2/25.

Rd11 was a bye, Rd12 saw us needing to beat top of the ladder Freo Mosman Park and have Western Suburbs loose to Curtin Vic Park if we were to make finals, with the help of the selectors I was able to field a very strong side including priority picks UJ Bhan, Mulks, Josh Ericson and Kieran Smith. Losing the toss we were sent into field, Bhan and Mulks went about doing what they do best bowling tight with UJ not getting the rewards but bowling well 0/38 off 8 and Cal taking 2/20 off his 8 putting us in a strong position with Kizza cleaning up at the end taking 3/21 off 4 keeping Freo Mosman to 7/144. Setting about the run chase Wingy and Ed were sent out with total freedom, Wingy didn't get away and was out early sending Kizz in at 3 he then proceeded to dispatch them to all parts with apparent ease scoring a blistering 67* and Ed a gutsy 39 with Mulks finishing it off in style getting a rapid fire 18* to secure the all-important win. After securing an amazing win against ladder leading Freo Mosman Park we had a nervous wait to see if we had qualified for finals, unfortunately Western Suburbs also had a win seeing us miss out on finals by percentage only.

So all in all I would like to think we had a positive season with everyone contributing throughout, the next step is to combine those performances into one game and do that week in week out which if we continue to train hard I see happening.

With the improvement of the younger guys like Dazzle Rive who became a consistent line and length bowler who took some critical wickets, Bryn Evans while he didn't take a lot of wickets he was most effective in his bowling partnership with Derryn and I was very impressed at his line and length, the rewards will come for you Bryn (3fa in the 3rds Rd12!) just keep working at training. Lastly, Austin Keyte for your first year back you took some big steps in the right direction, going from the quiet guy in the corner until you put the keeping gloves on becoming the team's vocal funny sledger who worked hard at training and improved week in week out with both bat and gloves.

I would also like to thank the committee for giving me the opportunity to captain and by backing me in every step of the way, I did come in late but having the full support from Pritchey and the committee made it easier. To PC and Jay I couldn't have done it without you, your guidance and numerous phone calls to get me a side every week is muchly appreciated.

And lastly to everyone who played in my side this year thank you for embracing the side, I think we were the envy of every club with our arvo teas, your willingness to jump in and help with the setting or packing up and doing umpiring without complaint, all this often without being asked was awesome and made my job a hell of a lot easier
